### **Fisheries Act 1983**

## Fisheries (Bycatch Trade-Off) Notice (No. 4) 1991, (No. 5115)

Pursuant to section 282G of the Fisheries Act 1983, and delegation made pursuant to section 41 of the State Sector Act 1988, the Director (Operations), MAF Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

#### Notice

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Bycatch Trade-off) Notice (No. 4) 1991.

(2) This notice shall come into effect on the 1st day of October 1991.

#### 2. Interpretation—In this notice:

(a) Any reference to Quota Management Area means the appropriate Quota Management Area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches and Catch History) Notice 1986\*; and

(b) Target species and bycatch species are specified by way of fishstock codes, being Fishstock Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†.

**3.** Offering a lease of quota in lieu of paying deemed value—As from the date this notice comes into effect, any commercial fisherman who could be required under section 28zD of the Fisheries Act 1983 to pay the deemed value of any fish that is specified as a bycatch species in this notice, may offer the Director-General a lease or sublease of the right to

take fish, being fish that are specified in this notice as a target species in relation to that bycatch species, as specified in the tables below. The ratios, as specified, are the amounts of target species which may, in lieu of such payments, be accepted by way of lease or sub-lease in relation to the amount of the bycatch species for which the offer of quota is made, e.g., if a fisher could be required to pay deemed value for 1 tonne of GUR1 and wishes to offer a lease of SCH1 then the amount that can be offered is 1 tonne  $\times 0.88 = 0.88$  tonnes of SCH1.

## British Settlements Act 1887

### Appointment of Officer of Government of Ross Dependency

CATHERINE A. TIZARD, Governor-General

WHEREAS, by an Order in Council dated the 30th day of July 1923\*, made under the British Settlements Act 1887 of the United Kingdom Parliament, the Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of New Zealand for the time being (hereinafter called the Governor) was appointed to be the Governor of the Ross Dependency, and all the powers and authorities which by the said order were given and granted to the Governor for the time being of the Dependency were thereby vested in the Governor:

And whereas the Governor was thereby further authorised and empowered to make all such rules and regulations as might lawfully be made by Her Majesty's authority for the peace, order, and good government of the Dependency:

And whereas, by regulations made by the Governor on the 14th day of November 1923t, it was enacted that all persons appointed by the Governor for the time being of the Dependency should have such power and authority as might be granted them in due course of law, and might be empowered to do such things as might be necessary or desirable to ensure that the laws in force in the Dependency are duly observed and complied with in every respect, and to do all things necessary or expedient for the peace, order, and good government of the Dependency, and to safeguard and preserve Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty over and in respect of the Dependency:

And whereas it is expedient that the person hereinafter named be appointed an officer of the Government of the Dependency:

Now, therefore, I, Dame Catherine Anne Tizard, the Governor-General of New Zealand, and as such the Governor of the Ross Dependency, hereby appoint

Kerry Robert Paterson, Esquire

as an officer of the Government of the Dependency for the period beginning with the 1st day of October 1991 and ending with the close of the 31st day of October 1992 or such earlier date as he shall leave the Dependency:

And I hereby confer on the said Kerry Robert Paterson while he holds office all the powers and authorities that may be exercised in New Zealand by a Justice of the Peace, and also all the powers and authorities that may be exercised by a Coroner:

The said Kerry Robert Paterson to exercise his functions at such places within the Dependency as may be directed by the officer for the time being appointed as an officer of the Government of the Dependency in whom is vested the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws and regulations in force in the Dependency.

As witness the hand of Her Excellency the Governor-General as the Governor of the Ross Dependency, this 23rd day of September 1991.

## **Medicines** Act 1981

## **Classification of Medicines**

### Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967

#### Local Water Conservation (Mangatainoka River) Notice 1991

Pursuant to section 20H (c) of the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, and a direction from the Planning Tribunal to make a local water conservation notice in respect of the Mangatainoka River, the council hereby makes a notice as directed by the Planning Tribunal as follows:

#### 1. Title and Commencement

1.1 This order may be cited as the Local Water Conservation (Mangatainoka River) Notice 1991.

1.2 This order shall come into force on the date of its notification in the Gazette.

#### 2. Interpretation:

"Act" means the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967.

"River" means the Mangatainoka River itself from its source (approximate map reference NZMS 260 sheet S25:217-546) to its confluence with the Tiraumea River (approximate map reference NZMS 260 sheet T24:554-871), together with all its tributaries, including the Makakahi River.

"Water channel" means any part of the river channel that contains water that is either flowing or ponded at that time.

### 3. Characteristics and Features to be Protected:

It is hereby declared that the Mangatainoka River includes a recreational fishery of regional significance.

#### 4. Right to Dam Not to be Granted:

A right to dam the full flow of the Mangatainoka River or its tributaries, the Makakahi River (and its Bruce Stream tributary), the Mangaroa, Mangamaire, Makotukutuku, Mangaraupiu Streams and an unnamed tributary entering the Mangatainoka River at map reference NZMS 260 sheet T25:368-654 shall not be granted under section 21 of the Act.

#### 5. Water Rights:

5.1 A water right under section 21 of the Act may not be granted by the regional council and a general authorisation under section 22 of the Act may not be made by the regional council in respect of the river if the combined effect of the grant or authorisation and of existing rights would have a significant adverse effect on the feature identified in clause 3.

5.2 Notwithstanding anything in this notice, it shall be lawful for water rights to be granted, and general authorisations to be made, in respect of the river for the purposes of:

a. research into, and enhancement of, fisheries habitats; or

- b. mitigation of the effects of flooding and erosion throughout the catchment under the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941; or
- c. the maintenance of roads, bridges, and other public utilities; or
- d the extraction of gravel, provided no such extraction takes place in the water channel of the river, and the water quality requirements of clauses 5 (4) are met.

5.3 Nothing in this notice shall limit the effect of the second proviso to section 21 (1) of the Act relating to the use of water for domestic needs, for the needs of animals, and for or in connection with fire fighting purposes.

5.4 In granting any rights under section 21 of the Act or making a general authorisation under section 22 of the Act, the regional council shall ensure that after reasonable mixing:

- a. the natural water temperature of the river shall not be changed by more than 3 degrees Celsius;
- b. the acidity or alkalinity of the water as measured by the ph shall be within the natural range and shall not be changed by more than 1.0 unit;
- c. the water shall not be so tainted or contain toxic substances so as to be unsuitable for consumption by farm animals;
- d. the water shall not emit an objectionable odour;
- e. there shall be no adverse effect on the aquatic community attributable to pollutants;
- f. aquatic organisms shall not be rendered unsuitable for human consumption by accumulation of excessive concentrations of pollutants;
- g. the natural colour and clarity of the waters shall not be changed to a conspicuous extent;
- h. there shall be no visible oil or grease films or conspicuous floating or suspended waste materials;
- i. the oxygen content in solution in the river shall not be reduced below 6 milligrams per litre; and
- j. there shall be no undesirable biological growths attributable to pollutants.

5.5 Nothing in this order shall prevent the granting of any water right or general authorisation which would have the

effect of renewing any water right or general authorisation that is current on the commencement of this order. R. A. BARRETT, General Manager.

#### STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES ۱.

The ASB Bank Community Trust ("the Trust") was formed on 30 May 1988 through the creation of a trust deed in compliance with the Trustee Banks Restructuring Act 1988. Under the terms of the trust deed the Trust was settled with 60 million \$1 fully paid ordinary shares in ASB Bank Limited representing 100% of the issued capital. Subsequently 45 million shares were sold in 1989 to the Commonwealth Bank of Australia.

#### GENERAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The measurement basis adopted is that of historical cost adjusted for the revaluation of certain assets Reliance is placed on the fact that the Trust is a going concern. Accrual accounting is used to match income and expenditure.

#### PARTICULAR ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Ra Bank is stated as the balance in the bank account rather than the balance as per the cash book. Investments

Investments in shares are valued at the net tangible asset backing as disclosed in the latest published accounts. Any revaluation difference is transferred direct to an investment revaluation reserve. Fixed Assets

Fixed Assets were valued at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciatio Office equipment and furniture were depreciated on a diminishing value basis

Taxa Taxation includes both current and deferred tax. Deferred tax is calculated using the liability method.

Dividends

Dividends are recognised as income when they are received by the Trust, and include imputation tax credits if any.

Donations are accounted for as they are distributed or committed to be distributed to eligible organisations as approved by the Trustees except that where donations approved are payable over a number of accounting periods the future donations payable are accounted for in the year in which they are paid. **Changes in Accounting Policies** 

Changes in Accounting Policies The accounting policy for disclosure of bank balances has been changed (refer Bank note above). The effect is to increase the bank account and committed donations by \$120,733. The comparatives have been adjusted accordingly, increasing bank and committed grants by \$33,010.

#### 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The ASB Charitable Trust ("the Trust") was formed on 31 May 1989 through the creation of a trust deed by the ASB Bank Community Trust

#### GENERAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The measurement basis adopted is that of historical cost adjusted for the revaluation of certain assets. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Trust is a going concern. Accrual accounting is used to match income and expenditure.

#### PARTICULAR ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Bank

Bank is stated as the balance in the bank account rather than the balance as per the cash book.

#### Investments

Investments are stated at market value. Any unrealised gains or losses are recognised in income and expenditure for the period. Investment transactions are recorded by the Fund Managers on a settlement date basis. Unsettled transactions

#### are disclosed in the Notes as commitments.

Foreign Currencies All amounts denonimated in foreign currencies are converted to New Zealand dollars at balance date and all

realised and unrealised gains and losses are recognised in income and expenditure for the period. Currency Hedges

All hedging contracts are revalued using the New Zealand dollar rate at balance date and all realised and unrealised gains and losses are recognised in income and expenditure for the period.

#### d Assets

Fixed Assets are valued at cost less accumulated depreciation Depreciatio

Depreciation is provided over the useful life of the assets

#### De ations

Donations are accounted for as they are distributed or committed to be distributed to eligible orga approved by the Trustees. Where donations approved are payable over a number of accounting periods the future donations payable are accounted for in the year in which they are paid.

#### Taxati

The Trust has been accorded tax exempt status in New Zealand and Australia but is liable to taxation on investment income in some other overseas countries. Tax on overseas income is accounted for as a reduction of that income.

#### Dividends

Dividends are recognised as income when they are received by the Trust and exclude imputation tax credits.

nce Reserve **Capital Mai** Transfers to the Capital Maintenance Reserve from the Unallocated Surplus are made at the discretion of the Trustees

#### **Changes in Accounting Policies**

The accounting policy for disclosure of bank balances has been changed (refer Bank note above). The effect is to increase the Bank account and committed donations by \$601,804. The comparatives have been adjusted accordingly, increasing bank and committed grants by \$48,699.
