  - the range of alternative goods made locally;
  - the grounds on which objection is made (including reasons why the local product is a suitable alternative);
  - present and potential output;
  - details of factory cost in terms of materials, labour, overheads, including the proportion of domestic and imported content.
- All submissions objecting to a request for the withdrawal of a concession must include:
  - reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
    - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce where the application was lodged quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will be considered invalid.
