## Summary of Bills Introduced

### *Arms Amendment*

This bill seeks to amend the Arms Act 1983 to provide stricter controls on the importation and possession of military style semi-automatic firearms. Weapons of this type are to be designated as a separate class of firearms for which permits must be obtained before they are to be imported or owned. Permits which are required for the importation of the firearms or parts thereof, are non-transferable and will expire 12 months after the date of issue. Importers of such weapons will provide the Police with samples of the firearms to which the permit relates. Illegally imported firearms or restricted weapons can be seized by the Police.

The bill seeks to enable holders of firearms licences to apply for an endorsement permitting that person to possess a military style semi-automatic firearm. Members of the Police in determining the application are to be satisfied that the applicant is a fit and proper person to be in possession of that type of weapon. The endorsement may be subject to conditions.

Under this bill, new applicants for firearms licences and for military style semi-automatic firearms endorsements will have to provide photographs to be affixed to their licences. Also, the Commissioner of Police is able to call in firearms licences so that photographs of holders may be affixed either to those licences or to replacement licences.

Provisions in the principal Act dealing with the issue of permits to procure pistols and restricted weapons and the removal of such weapons from New Zealand are extended to military style semi-automatic firearms.

The bill seeks to make it an offence to be in possession of a firearm or airgun when not holding a licence. Also, the provisions in the principal Act which make unlawful possession of a pistol or restricted weapon an offence are to be extended to the unlawful possession of a military style semi-automatic firearm.

### *Auckland City Council (Rates Relief) Empowering*

The object of this Local Bill is to provide temporary relief from rates increases for ratepayers aged 65 years and over living in the Auckland City Council district.

### *White Island Marine Protected Area*

The purpose of this Private Member's Bill is to restrict the use of certain fishing methods in the vicinity of White Island and Volkner Rocks in order to ensure the continued availability of fish species which are especially sought after by recreational fishers in this area, or which are of interest for non-extractive purposes, and to prevent conflict between different types of fishing methods.

The area affected by this bill is the land, water and seabed 1.5 nautical miles around White Island and around Volkner Rocks.

The bill would make it an offence to use nets, long lines, trawl lines, Danish seine nets and purse seine nets.

**Determination as a Specified Importer**

Notice is hereby given that I, Alexander Hugh McPhail, Manager, Trade Remedies Group, Ministry of Commerce, acting pursuant to section 3A (2) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 and under delegated authority from the Secretary of Commerce, have determined that South Pacific Tyres N.Z. Limited, a New Zealand producer of new pneumatic radial ply tyres of a kind used on motor cars (including station wagons) for the replacement market, which is also an importer of like goods, is a 'specified importer'.

The brief reasons for this determination being made are that having regard to the nature and extent of the importations of the allegedly dumped goods including the value, quantity, frequency and purpose of the importations, the Secretary is satisfied that South Pacific Tyres N.Z. Limited should not be excluded from being treated as a New Zealand producer for the purposes of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988.

**Education****Education Act 1989****Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi 1991**

Pursuant to sections 146 and 155 of the Education Act 1989 (as amended by section 14 of the Education Amendment Act 1989), the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

**Notice**

1. This notice may be cited as the Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi.
2. This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
3. I hereby establish at Glasgow Street, Wanganui, a primary school called Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi and I hereby designate the school as a Kura Kaupapa Maori.
4. Aims and objectives of Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi:

Together with the use of Te Reo Maori as the principal language of instruction the following aims, purposes and objectives constitute the character of Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi.

- (i) To ensure the survival and revival of the Maori language.
- (ii) To provide educational excellence and to prepare pupils to become active bilingual and bicultural citizens of Aotearoa.
- (iii) To ensure that the philosophy and organisation of the kura is Maori based.
- (iv) To enhance the "mana" and "matauranga" of Maori people by providing total immersion education in the Maori language.

5. Constitution of the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees of Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Atihau-nui-a-Paparangi shall comprise:

- (a) 5 people appointed by the Minister; and
- (b) The principal or principal designate; and
- (c) Not more than 4 persons co-opted by the Board.

    - (a) 5 people appointed by the Minister; and
    - (b) The principal or principal designate; and

#### Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977

##### Kaingaroa Rural Fire District Notice 1991

Pursuant to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977, the National Rural Fire Authority hereby makes the following notice.

#### Notice

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Kaingaroa Rural Fire District Notice 1991.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after its notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

2. In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, "the Act" means the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977; "the Committee" means the Kaingaroa Rural Fire Committee; "the District" means the Kaingaroa Rural Fire District.

3. This notice revokes and is in substitution for the Kaingaroa Rural Fire District Notice 1948 (a) and all amendments thereto.

##### *Constitution of the Kaingaroa Rural Fire District*

4. The areas specified in the Schedule to this notice are hereby constituted and declared to be a rural fire district to be known as the Kaingaroa Rural Fire District.

5. The Kaingaroa Rural Fire District shall be administered for the purpose of the Act by a rural fire committee known as the Kaingaroa Rural Fire Committee.

6. The Committee shall consist of thirteen members as follows:

(1) Six persons appointed by the Forestry Corporation of New Zealand Limited, in writing, signed on behalf of that company by one director and the secretary thereof; and

(2) One person appointed by the Tasman Forestry Limited, in writing, signed on behalf of that company by one director and the secretary thereof; and

(3) One person appointed by the Rotorua District Council, in writing, signed on behalf of the Council by the Chief Executive and the secretary thereof; and

(4) One person appointed, in writing, by the Chief Executive of the New Zealand Fire Service; and

(5) One person appointed, in writing, by the Director-General of the Department of Conservation; and

(6) One person appointed by P.F. Olsen and Company Limited, in writing, signed on behalf of that company by one director and the secretary thereof; and

(7) One person appointed, in writing, by the Secretary of the Ministry of Forestry; and

(8) One person appointed by the Federated Farmers of New Zealand Incorporated, in writing, signed by the Chairman and secretary thereof.

7. The period between the 1st day of October in any one year and the 30th day of April in the following year (both days inclusive) is hereby declared to be a restricted fire season in the district.
