Animal Remedies Act 1967

Licenses Issued Under the Animal Remedies Act 1967 (Notice No. 5131; Ag. 154)

Pursuant to sections 21 (6), 26A and 28 (3) of the Animal Remedies Act 1967, the Registrar of the Animal Remedies Board hereby gives notice that licenses have been issued, reissued or revoked in the Schedules hereto;

- 1. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule I are new licenses issued, not subject to conditions.
- 2. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule II are new licenses issued subject to conditions:
- (a) That the remedy shall not be sold to any other person other than a Veterinary Surgeon, or a Dealer or otherwise than pursuant to the prescription of a Veterinary Surgeon; and
- (b) That the remedy shall not be used otherwise than by or under the supervision of a Veterinary Surgeon.
- 3. The remedies listed in Schedule III are provisionally licensed subject to the conditions shown in respect of them.
- 4. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule IV are licenses which have lapsed or have been withdrawn by the licensee.

Order of the Council in Disciplinary Session Order in Respect of Briar Lyn Polley Registered Psychiatric Nurse

In exercise of its powers under sections 42 (1) (a); 42 (2) (a); 42 (9); 42 (3); 23 (2) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand after due inquiry on the 3rd day of December 1991, ordered that the name of Briar Lyn

Polley be removed from the Register of Psychiatric Nurses. Council declined to fix a time after which she may apply to have her name restored to the Register. Council also ordered that she return all certificates and badges issued to her by the Nursing Council; that she pay \$2,000 or actual costs incurred (whichever is the lesser) toward the cost and expenses of and incidental to the inquiry by the Council; that a notice stating the effect of these orders be published in the Gazette, and the New Zealand Nursing Journal.
