Pursuant to sections 21 (6) 26A and 28 (3) of the Animal Remedies Act 1967, the Registrar of the Animal Remedies hereby gives notice that licenses have been issued, reissued or revoked in the Schedules hereto;

Direction to Director-General of Social Welfare

In the matter of the section 5 (2) of the Social Security Act 1964.

To: The Director-General of Social Welfare.

I, Jennifer Mary Shipley, Minister of Social Welfare, hereby give you the following direction, pursuant to section 5 (2) of the Social Security Act 1964 ("the Act"):

1. This direction applies to any person of or over the age of 55 years who:

(a) Is in receipt of unemployment benefit under section 58 of the Act;

or

(b) Is in receipt of emergency benefit under section 61 of the Act paid instead of unemployment benefit; and

(c) Has been in receipt of benefit continuously for a period of not less than 26 weeks since he or she attained the age of 55 years.

2. In respect of any person to whom this direction applies, you are to accept, for the purposes of section 58 (1) (c) of the Act, as sufficient evidence that the person has taken reasonable steps to obtain suitable work:

(a) A statement of intent by the person that he or she will continue to seek suitable work; and

(b) In respect of any review of an unemployment benefit, a statement by the person (in the absence of evidence to the contrary) that he or she has taken steps to obtain suitable work in accordance with that statement of intent.

3. For the purposes of this direction, a person shall be accepted as being continuously in receipt of benefit where the period of receipt of benefit is broken by a period of temporary employment (within the meaning of the Act), but the period of temporary employment shall not be taken into account in calculating the period of receipt of benefit.

4. In this direction, unless the context otherwise requires, "benefit" means an unemployment benefit under section 58 of the Act, an emergency benefit paid instead of unemployment benefit under section 61 of the Act, or a sickness benefit under section 54 of the Act.

5. This direction shall take effect on the 1st day of April 1992.

and I FURTHER DIRECT that from the date this direction takes effect, unemployment benefit under section 58 of the Act applied for by, or paid to, any person of or over the age of 55 years, shall be known as "the 55+ Benefit".

(i) Prescribe information that is to be deemed to be relevant for the purposes of section 27 (1) of the Building Act 1991.

(j) Prescribe transitional provisions in respect of existing buildings for which compliance schedules are to be issued.

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to sections 24 (1) and 28 of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

Order

1. Title—This order may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises (Landcorp Management Services Limited Vesting Order No. 19) Order 1992.

2. Application—(1) This order applies to all the land described in the Schedule to this order, saving and excepting—

(a) The bed of any lake whose bed has an area of 8 hectares or more;

(b) The bed of any river whose bed has an average width of 3 metres or more;

(c) Any land covered and uncovered by the flow and ebb of the tide at mean spring tides.

(2) In subclause (1) of this clause, the terms "bed", "lake" and "river" have the meanings assigned to them by section 2 (1) of the Resource Management Act 1992.

3. Approval and vesting—Subject to section 24 of the Conservation Act 1987, the land to which this order applies—

(a) Is hereby approved for the purposes of section 24 (1) (b) of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986; and

(b) On the 26th day of March 1992, shall vest for an estate in fee simple in Landcorp Management Services Limited (a company duly incorporated under the Companies Act 1955, having its registered office at Wellington, and being a State enterprise within the meaning of section 29 (1) of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986),—

(i) Together with the appurtenant rights (if any) described in the Schedule to this order; but

(ii) Subject to the rights, interests and encumbrances (if any), to which it is described in the Schedule to this order as being subject.

4. Consequential amendment—The Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises (Landcorp Management Services Limited Vesting Order No. 8) Order 1991 is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the following items:
