Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery Suspension) Notice (No. 1) 1992 (Notice No. 5154)

Pursuant to section 47 of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries (acting on the recommendation of the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries, and after informing the Fisheries Authority and the Fishing Industry Board) hereby gives the following notice:

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery Suspension) Notice (No. 1) 1992.
 - (2) This notice shall come into effect on 29 May 1992.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice:
 - (1) The term "Foveaux Strait dredge oyster fishery" means the oyster fishery in Foveaux Strait as declared to be a controlled fishery in the Controlled Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery) Notice 1979.*
 - (2) Any reference to licences, means licences granted by the Fisheries Authority pursuant to section 33 of the Fisheries Act 1983 in respect of the Foveaux Strait dredge oyster fishery.
- **3. Extension of Suspension**—The restrictions on all licences imposed by the Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery Suspension) Notice (No. 4) 1991 dated 12 December

1991 (New Zealand Gazette, 16 January 1992, No. 2, page 8) is hereby extended until 27 August 1992.

4. The continued closure of the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery is necessary to minimise the collapse of the dredge oyster stocks due to mortality induced by the *Bonamia* parasite.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Final Determination: Passenger Radial Tyres from Japan, Korea and Taiwan

Pursuant to section 13 (1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby give notice that I have made a final determination that the goods specified in the Schedule to this notice, and imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand, are not goods in respect of which I may direct the imposition of anti-dumping duty in accordance with section 14 of the Act.

The brief reasons for this determination are that, in most cases, the imports were not dumped, and for those that were dumped, the consequent impact of them upon the New Zealand industry did not amount to material injury in terms of the Act.
