1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Initiation of Dumping Investigation (PVC Cling Film), Amendment No. 1 and shall be read with and be part of the notice given for the Secretary of Commerce entitled "Initiation of Dumping Investigation", dated 28 April 1992, and published in the *Gazette* of 30 April 1992 at page 1225, (in this notice referred to as "the principal notice").

2. Description of goods amended—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the words "Polyvinyl chloride cling film with a thickness not exceeding 0.25 mm in varying lengths and exceeding 20 cm in width" and inserting the words "Polyvinyl chloride (PVC) cling film, of gauges between 7 and 32 microns, and a width of 195 millimetres or more."
