- 2. Approved laboratories—The laboratories specified in the first column of the Schedule to this notice are hereby approved as approved laboratories for the purposes of the Medicines Act 1981.
- 3. Analysts in charge—For each of the approved laboratories specified in the first column of the Schedule to this notice, the person specified opposite the name of that approved laboratory in the second column of that Schedule is hereby designated as the analyst in charge of that laboratory.
