Summary of Bills Introduced

Citizenship Amendment Bill

Amends the Citizenship Act 1977.

The main changes to the principal Act contained in the bill are—

- (a) The tightening of the provision of the Act relating to the circumstances in which children adopted overseas by New Zealand citizens automatically become New Zealand citizens. Only children under the age of 13 years at the date of the overseas adoption will automatically become entitled to New Zealand citizenship;
- (b) An amendment to section 8 of the principal Act to make it clear that an intention to leave the country temporarily will not be a bar to the grant of citizenship;
- (c) The introduction of new rules relating to the grant of citizenship to the spouses of New Zealanders. The main effect of the new rules is that most applicants will be required—
 - (i) To have been ordinarily resident in New Zealand throughout the 2-year period before the date of application; and
 - (ii) To be entitled to be in New Zealand indefinitely;
- (d) Miscellaneous minor amendments to update the principal Act.

Education Amendment (No. 5) Bill

Inserts into the Education Act 1989 a new *Part VIII*A. The Part replaces section 91 of that Act, which provides for the direct central payment by the Crown of the salaries of teachers employed at schools whose Boards do not receive grants in respect of teacher salaries.

Otago Foundation Trust Board Bill

Private bill seeking to consolidate two previous amendments to the Otago Foundation Trust Board Act 1962 and to repeal that Act; to update the Board's powers and procedures in accordance with developments in general trustee law and recent commercial practice; to provide for the better administration of the funds of the Board; and to state more adequately the roles and functions of the Board and the Presbyterian Synod of Otago and Southland.

Fisheries Act 1983

Fisheries (Bycatch Trade-Off) Notice 1992 (No. 5167)

Pursuant to section 282G of the Fisheries Act 1983, and delegation made pursuant to section 41 of the State Sector Act 1988, the Deputy Group Director, MAF Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

Notice

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Bycatch Trade-off) Notice 1992.
- (2) This notice shall come into effect on the 31st day of July 1992, and shall expire on the 30th day of September 1992.

2. Interpretation—In this notice:

(a) Any reference to Quota Management Area means the appropriate Quota Management Area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches and Catch History) Notice 1986*;

(b) Target species and bycatch species are specified by way of fishstock codes, being Fishstock Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†; and

(c) Methods are specified by way of method codes, being Method Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†.

3. Offering a lease of quota in lieu of paying deemed value—As from the date this notice comes into effect, any commercial fisherman who could be required under section 28ZD of the Fisheries Act 1983 to pay the deemed value of any fish that is specified as a bycatch species in this notice, may offer the Director-General a lease or sublease of the right to take fish, being fish that are specified in this notice as a target species in relation to that bycatch species, as specified in the tables below. The ratios, as specified, are the amounts of target species which may, in lieu of such payments, be accepted by way of lease or sub-lease in relation to the amount of the bycatch species for which the offer of quota is made, e.g., if a fisher could be required to pay deemed value for 1 tonne of TRE1 and wishes to offer a lease of SCH1 then the amount that can be offered is 1 tonne \times 1.23 = 1.23 tonnes of SCH1. The bycatch species must have been taken while fishing for the target species using the method or any of the methods specified.

Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: Lead Acid Batteries from Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore and Taiwan: Amendment No. 2

Pursuant to section 14 (3A) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Minister of Commerce gives the following notice of reassessment of the amount of anti-dumping duty.

Notice

1. Title—(1) This notice may be cited as the Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: Lead Acid Batteries from Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore and Taiwan: Amendment No. 2, and shall be read with and be part of the notice given for the Minister of Commerce entitled "Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: Lead Acid Batteries from Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore and Taiwan" (hereinafter referred to as the "principal notice"), as amended by the notice given by the Minister of Commerce entitled "Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: Lead Acid Batteries from Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore and Taiwan: Amendment No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as "Amendment No. 1")".

(2) This notice shall take effect from 1 August 1992.

2. Second Schedule to the principal notice substituted—The principal notice (as so amended) is hereby amended by omitting the Second Schedule and substituting the new Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Consequential revocation—Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

The Representation Commission hereby gives notice that it proposes to make a division of New Zealand into 95 General electoral districts and 4 Maori electoral districts in accordance

with sections 16 and 23 of the Electoral Act 1956 and to classify districts for the purposes of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977. The following information is supplied pursuant to section 18 of the Electoral Act 1956 and for the assistance of the public:

1. From and including 30 July 1992, the public may inspect, without charge, at the places listed in the Schedule hereto:

(a) a description of the boundaries of the proposed districts, including maps thereof; and

(b) a summary, in respect of each proposed district, of the reasons why the boundaries described are being proposed; and

Within those allowances the Commission in forming General electoral districts is required by law to give due consideration to the existing boundaries of electoral districts, to community of interest, to facilities of communications, and to topographical features. In forming the Maori electoral districts the Commission is required by law to give due consideration to the existing boundaries of the Maori electoral districts, to community of interest among the Maori people generally and members of Maori tribes, to facilities of communications, and to topographical features.

Objectors to electoral boundaries are requested to relate the grounds of their objections, and the precise changes suggested by them, to those statutory considerations.

5. Where objection is taken to different proposals of the Commission a separate objection should be filed in respect of each proposal.

6. The Commission requests objectors to indicate if they wish to speak briefly to their objections before meetings of the Commission to be held at Wellington, Christchurch, Auckland and Dunedin in early October 1992. Full details of each objection must be in writing. Whether or not an objector is heard, his or her written objection will be fully considered. However late objections cannot be considered.
