#### Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

##### Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: Certain Non-Leather Women's Footwear From China

Pursuant to section 13 (1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby give notice that I have made a final determination that the goods specified in the First Schedule to this notice (hereinafter referred to as "the subject goods") imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand, are goods in respect of which I may direct the imposition of anti-dumping duty in accordance with section 14 of the Act.

I hereby give notice that I am satisfied in relation to the importation into New Zealand of the subject goods that:

- (a) The subject goods are being dumped; and
- (b) By reason thereof material injury to the New Zealand women's footwear industry has been caused—

and state that section 14 of the Act applies to the subject goods, and that there shall be charged, collected and paid on demand of the collector anti-dumping duty on the subject goods. The anti-dumping duty shall be the appropriate amount specified in the Second Schedule to this notice in relation to the type, source and supplier of the shoe.

#### First Schedule

*Country of Origin:* People's Republic of China.

*Description of Goods Subject to Final Measures:*

Women's footwear with outer soles and uppers of rubber or plastic\* but EXCLUDING:

- Women's and girls' shoes size 4 and below;
- Waterproof footwear;
- Sports footwear including footwear which has the appearance of footwear designed for sports use;
- Footwear with upper straps or thongs assembled to the sole by means of plugs;
- Footwear covering the ankle;
- Footwear incorporating a protective metal toe cap;
- Footwear with outer soles and uppers moulded in one piece from PVC or another plastic material or from rubber;
- Slippers.

\*The expression "rubber or plastic" includes any textile material visibly coated or covered externally with one or both of those materials.

The goods are currently classified under Tariff Item and Statistical Key 6402.99.19.09F of the Tariff of New Zealand, which classification is provided for convenience and Customs purposes only, the written description being dispositive.

**Second Schedule****Amount of Anti-Dumping Duty**

The amount of duty to be paid in respect of the above goods shall be the amount by which the Normal Value (VFD Equivalent) exceeds the value for duty of the above goods when entered for home consumption.

Where the goods imported are imported directly from an exporter who is a direct supplier\*, the amount of the Normal Value shall be that (VFD Equivalent) amount set out in the column headed "Direct Suppliers". Where the goods are imported from any other exporters, the applicable amount of the Normal Value (VFD Equivalent) shall be the amount set out in the column headed "Other Suppliers".

This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Franklin District) Notice No. 2, 1992.

The notice headed The Traffic (Franklin District) Notice No. 1, 1992, which appeared in the *New Zealand Gazette* on 9 July 1992, No. 105, page 2379, is amended as indicated in the Schedules hereto.

The areas specified in the First Schedule are declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

The roads specified in the Second Schedule are declared to be 70 kilometre an hour speed limit areas pursuant to regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976.

So much of the Traffic (Franklin District) Notice No. 1, 1992, signed on the 6th day of July 1992\*, which relates to roads in the Schedules below, issued pursuant to section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976, is revoked.

### New Zealand Game Industry Board

#### Game Industry Board Regulations 1985

##### Game Industry Levy

Pursuant to regulation 17 (3) of the Game Industry Board Regulations 1985, notice is given that the Game Industry Board hereby fixes the rates of game industry levy (which levy rates are exclusive of goods and services tax imposed by the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985) as follows:

(a) On each deer slaughtered in deer slaughtering premises, 28 cents per kilogram hot clean carcass weight after removal of condemned parts;

(b) On each killed game deer carcass received at a game packing house, zero cents per kilogram cold clean carcass weight after removal of condemned parts;

(c) On each piece of antler from fallow deer received at a game packing house for processing or packing, 100 cents per kilogram green weight; and

(d) On each piece of antler from deer other than fallow deer received at a game packing house for processing or packing, 450 cents per kilogram green weight.

The levies on antler will be payable on all antler but may be

debated by the board in the case of hard antler sold through designated pools where it is assessed by accredited graders.

A nil rate of levy will apply to any farmed deer or killed game deer carcasses which are wholly condemned for any reason following slaughter or receipt in to a game packing house.

No levy shall be payable in respect of any one farmed deer carcass or killed game deer carcass or piece or antler more than once.

These rates of levy will come into effect from and inclusive of the 1st day of October 1992 and apply during the 1992-93 game season and subsequently until such time as new levy rates are fixed and come into force.

Pursuant to regulation 17A (1) notice is given that the Game Industry Board hereby fixes the rate of additional levy payable in respect of failure to pay, or late payment of, amounts of board levy payable on or after the 1st day of October 1992 at 10.0 per cent of the amount of levy unpaid.

This additional levy for failure to pay or late payment may be applied by the board at a rate of 10 per cent on the outstanding balance following expiration of the period within which payment is required to be received by the board, and shall be payable by the proprietor of the deer slaughtering premises or game packing house concerned.
