Animal Remedies Act 1967

Licenses Issued Under the Animal Remedies Act 1967 (Notice No. 5170; Ag. 154)

Pursuant to sections 21 (6), 26A and 28 (3) of the Animal Remedies Act 1967, The Registrar of the Animal Remedies Board hereby gives notice that licenses have been issued, reissued or revoked in the Schedules hereto;

1. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule I are new licenses issued, not declared to be Prescription Animal Remedies.
2. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule II are new licenses which have been declared to be Prescription Animal Remedies and may be administered to an animal only:
 - in the case of PAR Class I
 - (i) by a veterinary surgeon;
 - (ii) or under and in accordance with the authority or prescription of a veterinary surgeon
 - in the case of PAR Class II
 - (i) by a veterinary surgeon;
 - (ii) or in the presence and under the direct control of a veterinary surgeon
 - in the case of PAR Class III: By a veterinary surgeon.
3. The remedies listed in Schedule III are provisionally licensed subject to the conditions shown in respect of them.
4. The licenses for remedies listed in Schedule IV are licenses which have lapsed or have been withdrawn by the licensee.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty; Certain Men's Footwear from China, Indonesia, Korea, Taiwan and Thailand

Pursuant to section 13 (1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby give notice that I have made a final determination that the goods specified in the First Schedule to this notice (hereinafter referred to as "the subject goods") imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand, are goods in respect of which I may direct the imposition of anti-dumping duty in accordance with section 14 of the Act.

I hereby give notice that I am satisfied in relation to the importation into New Zealand of the goods that:

- The subject goods are being dumped; and
- By reason thereof material injury to the New Zealand men's footwear industry has been and is being caused;

and state that section 14 of the Act applies to the subject goods, and that there shall be charged, collected and paid on demand of the Collector anti-dumping duty on the subject goods. The anti-dumping duty shall be at the appropriate amount specified in the Second Schedule to this notice in relation to the type, source and supplier of the shoe.

First Schedule

Description of Goods Subject to This Notice

Country of Origin: China, Indonesia, Korea, Taiwan and Thailand.

Description of Goods: Men's shoes (including unisex shoes), including sports casual shoes but **EXCLUDING** the following categories:

- Men's and boy's shoes, size 4 and below.
- Sports footwear:
 - footwear which is designed for a sporting activity and has, or has provision for the attachment of spikes, sprigs, stops, clips, bars or the like;
 - skating boots, ski boots and cross-country ski footwear, wrestling boots, boxing boots and cycling shoes.
- Sandals and similar open-toed footwear with straps across the instep.
- Slippers.
- Footwear with upper straps or thongs assembled to the sole by means of plugs.
- Footwear incorporating a protective metal toe cap.
- Footwear with outer soles of leather.
- Footwear made on a base or platform of wood.
- Footwear containing woolskin.
- Thong type products.
- Industrial safety toe type.
- Diving boots.
- Waterproof footwear with outer soles and uppers of rubber or of plastics, the uppers of which are neither fixed to the sole nor assembled by stitching, riveting, nailing, screwing, plugging or similar processes.

Second Schedule

Amount of Anti-Dumping Duty

The amount of anti-dumping duty to be paid in respect of the above goods shall be the amount by which the normal value (VFD equivalent) exceeds the value for duty of the subject goods when entered for home consumption. The normal value (VFD equivalent) is the normal value determined in accordance with section 5 of the Act plus any amounts deductible from the purchase price of the goods in accordance with section 4 (1) (a) of the Act for the purposes of determining the export price in accordance with section 4 of the Act.

The anti-dumping duty shall apply in respect of all subject goods imported into New Zealand from 15 June 1992, this being the date of provisional direction given pursuant to section 16 of the Act.
