Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Initiation of Dumping Investigation: Reinforcing Steel Bar From India

Notice is hereby given that I, Alexander Hugh McPhail, Manager, Trade Remedies Group, Ministry of Commerce,

acting pursuant to section 10 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, and under delegated authority from the Secretary of Commerce, have initiated an investigation to determine both the existence and effect of alleged dumping of the goods listed in the Schedule to this notice, being satisfied that sufficient evidence has been provided that:

- (a) The goods imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand are being dumped; and
- (b) By reason thereof material injury to an industry has been or is being caused, or is threatened.

Fair Trading Act 1986

The Unsafe Goods (Toy Guns) Notice 1992

Pursuant to section 31 of the Fair Trading Act 1986, the Minister of Consumer Affairs gives the following notice.

Notice

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Unsafe Goods (Toy Guns) Notice 1992.

2. Certain toy guns that fire projectiles declared to be unsafe goods—The goods described in the Schedule to this notice are declared to be unsafe goods.

Schedule

(a) Toy guns of the type commonly known as "Spy Gun".

(b) Toy guns of the type commonly known as "Secret Cap Pistol" that do not have a blocking plug securely affixed into the end of the barrel preventing the emission of projectiles, particles or other objects from the barrel.

(c) Toy guns of the type commonly known as "Super Cap Gun" that do not have a blocking plug securely affixed into the end of the barrel preventing the emission of projectiles, particles or other objects from the barrel.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the notice but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice declares toy guns capable of the emission of projectiles, particles or other objects from the barrel, intended for use as toys for children, to be unsafe goods under section 31 of the Fair Trading Act 1986. The toy guns to which this notice applies are commonly known as "Spy Gun", "Secret Cap Pistol" and "Super Cap Gun".

Under section 31 (2) of the Act, unless it is sooner revoked, the notice remains in force for a period of 18 months after the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

It is an offence under the Fair Trading Act 1986 to supply, or offer to supply, or advertise to supply, goods which are declared to be unsafe goods.

Section 33 of that Act prohibits the importation of such goods into New Zealand.

The Waikato District Council (Validation of Rates) Order 1992

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 21st day of September 1992

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Whereas—

- (a) Section 52 (1) of the Rating Act 1967 and section 110 (1) of the Rating Powers Act 1988 require not less than 14 days' public notice of the intention to make rates; and
- (b) The public notice of intention in respect of rates for the 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 rating years given by the Raglan County Council gave notice of the intention to levy certain rates but not of the intention to make those rates; and
- (c) The public notice of intention in respect of rates for the 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 rating years given by the Ngaruawahia Borough Council gave notice of the intention to levy certain rates but not of the intention to make those rates; and
- (d) The public notice of intention in respect of rates for the 1990/91 and 1991/92 rating years given by the Waikato District Council gave notice of the intention to levy certain rates but not of the intention to make those rates; and
- (e) Section 53 of the Rating Act 1967 and section 111 of the Rating Powers Act 1988 require rates to be made by a resolution to make specified rates; and
- (f) In respect of the 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 rating years, the Raglan County Council resolved to levy certain rates but not to make those rates; and
- (g) In respect of the 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 rating years, the Ngaruawahia Borough Council resolved to levy certain rates but not to make those rates; and
- (h) In respect of the 1990/91 rating year, the Waikato District Council resolved to levy certain rates but not to make those rates; and
- (i) Section 5 (1) of the Local Government Reform (Transitional Provisions) Act 1990 requires not less than 14 days' public notice of the intention to adopt the transitional rating procedure; and
- (j) The Waikato District Council gave only 13 days' public notice of its intention to adopt the transitional rating procedure before resolving to adopt the said procedure on 15 May 1990; and
- (k) It is desirable to validate the said rates notwithstanding that public notice was not properly given and the rating resolutions were not correctly phrased:

Now therefore, pursuant to section 170 of the Rating Act 1967 and section 205 of the Rating Powers Act 1988, He

Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

Order

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Waikato District Council (Validation of Rates) Order 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. Validation of rates—(1) The making and levying by the Raglan County Council of the rates for the rating years 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 referred to in the Preamble to this order are hereby validated notwithstanding that the public notices and the rating resolutions were incorrectly worded.

(2) The making and levying by the Ngaruawahia Borough Council of the rates for the rating years 1987/88, 1988/89 and 1989/90 referred to in the Preamble to this order are hereby validated notwithstanding that the public notices and the rating resolutions were incorrectly worded.

(3) The making and levying by the Waikato District Council of the rates for the rating years 1990/91 and 1991/92 referred to in the Preamble to this order are hereby validated notwithstanding that the public notices and the rating resolutions were incorrectly worded.

(4) The adoption of the transitional rating procedure by the Waikato District Council on the 15th day of May 1990 is

hereby validated notwithstanding that insufficient public notice was given of the intention to adopt that procedure.

3. Existing rights not affected—Nothing in this order shall be construed as affecting the rights of any party under any judgment or order of any court given or made before the date of commencement of this order.

Animals Act 1967

Area Movement Control: Tuberculosis (Notice No. 5177)

Pursuant to section 13A of the Animals Act 1967, I require that all cattle or deer 12 months of age or older being moved from a place in a designated Movement Control Area to any other place, shall be accompanied by a signed and dated document by the owner or his/her agent stating:

- (i) that within 90 days prior to the date of movement the animals have undergone a test approved by the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries for tuberculosis, carried out by an inspector or veterinarian, with negative results and;
- (ii) in respect of tuberculosis, the status assigned in writing by an inspector to the herd of origin as at the date of the statement.

In exceptional circumstances only, an owner may apply to an inspector for a variation from this requirement. If granted, the inspector's permission shall be in writing and that document shall accompany animals being moved instead of the owner's statement.

Note: Any inspector may seize any animal that is moved in

contravention of this restriction and may require it to be returned to the property of origin or any other place the Chief Veterinary Officer may designate; and no compensation shall be payable in respect thereof.

All costs and expenses of and attendant upon any such seizure, returning or re-direction shall be borne by the owner thereof and shall be recoverable from him/her as a debt due to the Crown.

Reason for this Notice

The first requirement is imposed to reduce the risk of tuberculosis being spread to other herds or areas by movement of domestic livestock.

The second requirement is to enable buyers or occupiers of the place of receipt to be informed as to the status of the herd of origin of the animals.

Designated Areas

The following Movement Control Areas are designated:

The Central North Island Movement Control Area

The "Movement Control Area" is all that land encompassed by the following peripheral line:

From the outlet of the Waikato River at Lake Taupo north along State Highway 1 to the Atiamuri Bridge. From Atiamuri Bridge along the western bank of the Waikato River to the Waipapa Dam. From the Waipapa Dam north on the Waipapa Road to Huirimu Road. Along Huirimu Road to Aotearoa

Road, along Aotearoa Road north to Wharepapa Road. Following Wharepapa Road west to Panetapu and from Panetapu south along Bailey Road onto Hingaia Road south to Wharepungua Road. West along Wharepungua Road to the junction with Mangatutu Road. South west down Mangatutu Road to junction with Paewhenua East Road. South along Paewhenua Road continuing on along Chindie Road to junction with Tauraroa Road. West along Tauraroa Road to Toa Bridge. From Toa Bridge North west along Waipa River to NZMS 1 Grid Reference N74 81659490 3rd Edition 1974, from there in a straight line south to the Road junction of Waipa River Road and Barber Road. South along Barber Road, continuing as Rangitoto Road to the Rangitoto Road Block Road East intersection and then in a straight line to NZMS 1 Grid Reference N83 74206870 2nd Edition 1982, from there along State Highway 30 to its junction with Waimiha Mangapehi Road onto Waimiha Ongarue Road to its junction with State Highway 4 to Taumarunui. (The Movement Control Area will also include all the farm properties that are adjacent to the western side of the line from Mangapehi to Taumarunui on the Waimiha Road—State Highway 4 section of the line).

From Taumarunui west along River Road to junction with Saddler Road, from there in a straight line South East to the Wanganui River. Then following eastern most bank of Wanganui River south to Pipiriki. From Pipiriki east along the Pipiriki Raetihi Road to the Raetihi junction of State Highway 4 and State Highway 49. Then moves south down State Highway 4 to the junction with Oruakukura Road east along the Oruakukura Road to INFOMAP 262-6 Grid Reference 71761870 2nd Edition 1987, from there in a straight line south-south west to Trig 778 (see INFOMAP 262-2 Grid Square 7118) from there in a straight line south to NZMS 1 Grid Reference N131 715230 (on Field Tracks Road) 1st Edition 1969, from there along Fields Track Road eastward to Colliers Bridge then continues north along the Whangaehu River to the junction with the hydroelectricity viaduct, east along the hydroelectricity viaduct to its junction with State Highway 1 then south along State Highway 1 through Waiouru till the junction of State Highway 1 with Te Moehau Road. From there east down the northern bank of the Mangahaoata Stream to its junction with the Rangitikei River then following the east bank of the Rangitikei River South to its junction with the Whakaurekou River. From there east in a straight line to Trig 4334 (Potae) then north-north east in a straight line to Trig 1089 then in a straight line to its junction with the Ngaruroro River. From that junction follow the west bank of the Ngaruroro River north to NZMS 1 N113 Grid Reference 638813 3rd Edition 1981. From there north west to Trig 4513 (Pikiawatea) from there in a straight line to Mission Point on Lake Taupo. From there north along the eastern shore of Lake Taupo to the Waikato River outlet.

Downstream along the eastern bank of Kaitawa Creek to its junction with Te Aupapa Road. North west along Te Aupapa Road to Kaitawa. South west from Kaitawa in a direct line to the end of Rock Road and then south west in a direct line to Rongamai. From Rongamai, south west along the Mangaone Valley Road to Central Mangaone Road. North west along Central Mangaone Road to State Highway 2. South along State Highway 2 to North Road and then west along North Road to its junction with Nireaha-Hukanui Road. From this junction north west in a direct line to Kakariki, then west north west in a direct line to the Opp/W Trig. From the Opp/W Trig in a general south westerly direction following the boundary of the Tararua Forest Park to Featherston. From Featherston to Pakuratahi Forks at Kaitoke following the boundary of the Tararua Forest Park. From Pakuratahi Forks north west in a direct line to Saddle Trig (Akatarawa Saddle). From Saddle Trig west in a direct line to the Maungakawa Trig then following the Wharemauku Stream downstream to the Coast at Raumati Beach south along the coast to Plimmerton. From Plimmerton south east following the Plimmerton-Pauatahanui Road to Pauatahanui. From Pauatahanui south east following the Pauatahanui-Haywards Road to Hutt Road at Haywards. South along the Hutt Road to the Petone foreshore. From the Petone foreshore following the coastline to Pencarrow Head, to Turakirae Head, to Cape Palliser, to Castlepoint to the Akitio River Mouth.

Waipawa Endemic Area

From the south side of the Otane township follow Stock Road to State Highway 2 and Argyll Road. Follow the Argyll Road to the junction of Argyll Road and College Road. Follow College Road to the north east Boundary of Section 3, Block III, Waipukurau Survey District, then north west to Section 5, Block III, Waipukurau Survey District and north west along that boundary to the Mangatahi Stream and along the farm road leading to Te Onepu Road. Follow Te Onepu Road in a northerly direction to the junction with the north east boundary of part Section 4, Block XIV, Maraekakaho Survey District, then westerly along the northern boundary to Section 1, S.O. 10098, then north east to its northern boundary. Proceed westerly along the northern boundary to the Manganuku Stream and follow it to the junction with Mangamate Stream. Follow the Mangamate Stream in a westerly direction to State Highway 50 then follow State Highway 50 in a southerly direction to the junction with Kereru Road. Follow the Kereru Road to Glenselwyn Road, then Glenselwyn Road until it meets Poporangi Road. Follow Poporangi Road to Allen Road and follow Allen Road to a point approximately 0.3 km north of Shunt Road, then down the east boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 21615 and Section 3, Block XI, Wakarara Survey District in a southerly direction to the Mangamauka Stream. Follow the north side of the stream in a north west direction to Allen Road and then across part of the Wakarara Range to the southern most part of the forestry road known as the Wakarara Road. Proceed in a south west direction to the Makaroro River and follow the Makaroro River south easterly until its confluence with the Waipawa River. Then join the Whakaroro Road and follow it in a south easterly direction until it meets State Highway 50. Follow State Highway 50 in a south west direction until it meets the Tuki Tuki River then follow the Tuki Tuki River to the junction with the Kahahakuri Stream. Follow a north east line across farmland crossing Lindsay Road and follow the south side of Lindsay Road to a point marked Caringill on Info Map 260 V22, then in an easterly direction to cross State Highway 2 at Trig AI (157m) to join Tapairu Road at the east boundary, Section 21, Block XI, Waipukurau Survey District. Follow Tapairu Road to Trig XXVII A (154m) and follow a south east

line to the Tuki Tuki River. Proceed south east to the confluence with the Waipawa River and then downstream to a point approximately 2.2 km from the confluence. Follow a north west line to the junction of the Pourere Road and an unnamed road leading to a quarry, and then follow that unnamed road to the old bed of the Waipawa River. Follow the old bed of the Waipawa River to the end of Homewood Road. Follow Homewood Road to Racecourse Road and proceed east to White Road and follow White Road to the Southern Border of the Otane township.

The South Island Movement Control Areas

1. Clarence/Waiiau Endemic Area—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line from the Flaxbourne River mouth to State Highway 1, then along a straight line north west to the Upton Downs Road/Richmond Brook Road junction then in a straight line west to Mount William, then south west to Mount Upton, then south west to Colonel Gully Stream/Medway River junction then upstream on the west bank Medway River to the Deep Stream Junction, then along a straight line south west to Conical Hill, then direct line north west to where the Awatere Valley Road crosses the Awatere River, follow Awatere River north east up to Burr Stream Junction, then in a direct line north west to Mount Hall then in a straight line south west to where the Clarence River enters the north end of Lake Tennyson then west to Trig 6973 Mount Princess, then on a Grid Bearing of 270 degrees until you intersect the Waiiau River then south down the east bank of the Waiiau River to its junction with Henry River, then west up the south bank of the Henry River to its junction with Anne River from there south to Trig 5920 Rokeby from there south to Trig 5944 Maritana then south to Trig 5587 Saint Andrew from there south to Trig 7826 Handyside. Then south to Trig 4680 Frozen Hill, then in a straight line south west to Mount Skedaddle then south west to Trig 5350 La Grippe. South to Trig 4240 Sunny Knob from there to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S60 836450 2nd Edition 1978. From there to south west to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S60 797468 west to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S60 751446 on the Hurunui River. From there south along the east bank of the Hurunui River until the junction with the Hurunui River South Branch then west along the south bank of the Hurunui River South Branch till the junction with Woolshed Stream from there south west to Trig 6116 Esk Head. From there south east to Trig 5854 then south to Trig 5754. From there south to Trig 5604 Black Rock then south to Trig 5891 from there south to Trig 5816 then south west to Trig 4213 Springhill. From there south east to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S67 701129 3rd Edition 1982 (on Lees Valley Road) south west on Lees Valley Road until NZMS 1 Grid Reference S67 683106 3rd Edition (Stream Intersection) then east to Trig 3280 Retreat Hill from there in a straight line to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S67 714076 (on Okuku Stream) then to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S67 802025, then east to junction of Kowhai Stream and Taaffes Glen Road. From there south to junction with Grey River then north along west bank of Grey River to NZMS 1 Grid Reference S67 893003 from there south west to Northern most point of Loburn and Kowhai Road (Loburn and Kowhai is one Road) then north east along closed road to junction of Western Branch/South Branch of Kowhai River, down South Branch east to Holdsworth Road and north along Holdsworth Road to Dalbey Road/Brodies Road junction, north west along Brodies Road to Onepunga Road, north along Onepunga Road until the junction with Kowhai River then in a straight line north to the junction of McKays Road and Waipara River then north on the west bank of the Waipara River, then up the North Branch to Heathstock Road/Murrays Road junction, north along Murrays Road to Lake Sumner Road, west to Powers Road then direct line north The Peaks Village Settlement. From there in a straight line north until you intersect the Hurunui River then east down the north bank of Hurunui River to the Hurunui River Bridge then north along State Highway 1 to Macmillan Road, then east along

Macmillan Road to the Waiiau River then down the Waiiau River to the coast.

But excluding the area enclosed by a line running from the Conway River mouth to State Highway 1, then along State Highway 1 to Oaro; and excluding the area enclosed by a line running from the Kowhai River Mouth, up the true left bank of the Kowhai River to Kowhai River/Floodgate Creek junction, up Floodgate Creek to Mount Fyffe, then along Seaward Kaikoura Range to McIntosh Nob, then in a direct line east to Miller Stream/Clarence River junction, down the true right bank of Clarence River to Mole Hill, then down Deadman Stream to the coast.

2. West Coast Endemic Area—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from Kahurangi Point, then south east in a direct line to Mount Arthur then in a direct line south west to Nugget Knob, then in a direct line south to the Owen River/Buller River junction, then following the true right bank of the Buller River down to Lyell Bridge, then south to Mount Wynn then direct line south east to Creighton Peak then south to Rahu Saddle, then west to Mount Haast then direct line south west to Mount Puttick, then direct line north west to Mount Gore, a direct line south west to Mount Harata, then south east to Mount Rameses, then in a direct line south to Nancey-Tass Saddle, then east to Mount Hochstetter, then in a direct line north east to Mount Novaro then in a direct line east to Mount Barron at the Main Divide, then down the Main Divide to Mount Isabel then west along the Bowring Range to the Toaroha River/Kokatahi River junction, then down true left bank of Kokatahi River to the junction with the Hokitika River, then down true right bank of the Hokitika River to the coast.

3. Coastal and Central Otago Endemic Areas—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from Kurow River/Waitaki River junction, up Kurow River to Grayson Peak then a direct line east to Danseys Pass, a direct line south to Kakanui Peak, a direct line south east to Beaconed Trig B, south east to Mount Stalker then a direct line south east to Conical Peak, down South Branch Waianakarua River, a straight line south east to Razorback Trig, then along Horse Range to State Highway 1/Shag Point Road junction, then follow State Highway 1 south to Evansdale, south along Jones Road, then south west along Wright Road to Double Hill Trig, then a direct line south west to Swampy Summit No. 2 Trig, then south east to Millners Road/Waironga Road junction, then west along Tirohanga Road to Outram, a direct line west to Woodside, then a direct line south to Berwick, south east along Henley-Berwick Road to the Taieri River, down to true left bank of the Taieri River to its mouth, then south along the coast to the mouth of the Matau Branch of the Clutha River, up the true left bank of the Clutha River to Kaitangata, north along the Kaitangata-Lovells Flat Road to Burnside, then in a direct line west of the State Highway 1/Stoney Creek-Hillend Road junction, then in a direct line north west to Hillend, then in a direct line north to Johnstone then in a direct line west to Tuapeka Mouth, then along the east bank of the Clutha River the mouth of the Minzion Burn, then up the east bank of the Minzion Burn to the Mt Teviot Trig 977 and from there in a straight line north until you intersect the Lake Onslow-Teviot Road then north east along Lake Onslow-Teviot Road to the dam at Lake Onslow, then down true right bank of the Teviot River to its intersection with Bridge Huts Road, then in a straight line north west to Cave Creek then down Cave Creek to Lake Roxburgh, up the eastern side of Lake Roxburgh and the true left bank of the Clutha River to the mouth of the Manuhierikia River, from there north east to Galloway following Tucker Hill Road, then along the Crawford Hills Road and Poolburn-Moa Creek Road to Rutherford Lane, then east along Rutherford Land and Sullivans Road, then north east along Jones Road and Boundary Road, then north west along Boundary Road to Ida Valley-Omakau Road, then north west to its intersection with Auripo Road, then south west along Auripo Road to its

junction with the Idaburn, then down the Idaburn to its junction with the Manuherikia River, then up the Manuherikia River to its junction with State Highway 85, then south west along State Highway 85 to Becks then west along Loop Road, Becks School Road, Glassford Road and Wallington Road to Devonshire Road, then south west along Devonshire Road to the junction with Moutere-Dispute Spur Road then in a straight line south west to the Works Water Race at the end of Waikerikeri Valley Road, then following the Works Water Race south west to the Clyde Dam, then up the eastern side of Lake Dunstan and the true left bank of the Clutha River to the mouth of the Lindis River and following the Lindis River upstream to its junction with the Cluden Stream, then in a direct line north west to Phillips Road/State Highway 8 junction, south west along Phillips Road and then Deep Creek Road to its junction with State Highway 8A, then in a straight line west to the Clutha River junction with Poison Creek, then up the true left bank of the Clutha River to the bridge at Luggate, then north along the Luggate-Hawea Flat Road to the junction with Hawea Back Road, then north along Hawea Back Road to Lake Hawea then along the eastern side of Lake Hawea to the outlet of Timaru River then up the true left bank of the Timaru River to Mount Martha then in a direct line north east to headwaters of Birch Creek then down the true right bank of Birch Creek to its junction with the Ahuriri River then direct line north to Mount Huxley then a direct line east to the junction of the South and North Branches of the Temple Stream, then down the true right bank of the Temple Stream to Lake Ohau, then along the western side of Lake Ohau to the outlet of the Ohau River, then down the true right bank of the Lakes Benmore, Avimore, Waitaki and the Waitaki River to the outlet of the Kurow River; and those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from the neck of Lake Hawea south along the western side of Lake Hawea to Lake Hawea township, then down the true right bank of the Hawea River to its junction with the Clutha River, north along the true left bank of the Clutha River to its outlet at Lake Wanaka, then north along the eastern side of Lake Wanaka to the neck of Lake Hawea at State Highway 6; but excluding those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from junction of State Highway 85 and Highfield-Wedderburn Road south west along the Highfield-Wedderburn Road, south along Puketoi-Highfield Road, south along Puketoi Runs Road, north east along Puketoi-Patearoa Road to Patearoa, then north east along Patearoa-Waipiata Road to junction with Hamilton Road, then north along Hamilton Road to Waipiata-Patearoa Road, then in a direct line north east to the junction of the Kyeburn and Taieri River, then up the Kyeburn to Naseby-Kyeburn Diggings Road, then west along Naseby-Kyeburn Diggings Road to Naseby, then in a line north west then south west around the Naseby State Forest, then direct line west to the junction of State Highway 85 and Highfield-Wedderburn Road.

4. *Pisa Endemic Area*—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from Mount Pisa Station entrance on State Highway 6, north along State Highway 6 to the Lockar burn bridge, then up the true right bank of the Lockar burn to Lake McKay then direct line south west to Mount Pisa then direct line south west to Queensbury Hill, south to Mount Allen then direct line south to Crown Range Road at Crown Range Pass, then west along Crown Range Road to East Burn Station Road, then direct line south to the bridge crossing the Kawarau River then down the true left bank of the Kawarau River to the Roaring Meg then in a direct line east to Mount Michael then in a direct line north east to Mount Pisa Station entrance on State Highway 6.

5. *Catlins Enemic Area*—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from Pounawea to State Highway 92, then north along State Highway 92 to Grays Road then in a direct line west to Clinton, then west along the Mataura-Clinton Road to the Otago/Southland Regional

Government boundary, then south along the Regional Government boundary to the coast.

6. *Western Southland Endemic Area*—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running west from Trig 2758 Beaumont Hill to the NZMS 1 Grid Reference S159 905742 2nd Edition then south west to the Clifden-Blackmount Road at Grassy Creek. South along Clifden-Blackmount Road to Warakei then direct line south east to Run Road and east along Struan Road to State Highway 96. East along State Highway 96 to the eastern boundary of W J Wallace, then direct line north east to north eastern boundary of Gowan Hills Station, then direct line north to Beaumont Hill.

7. *Taringatura Endemic Area*—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from Affleck Road/Avondale Road junction, east along Avondale Road to Hamilton Burn Road, south east along Hamilton Burn Road to Dipton Stream bridge. Down Dipton Stream to Lang Road bridge, south along Lang Road and McDonald Road to Breakneck Road. West to Rocky Peak then west to northern boundary of W J Mackintosh. Monamore Road and along Monamore Road to Avondale Road, west to Aparima River at Affleck Road. North along Affleck Road to the junction with Avondale Road.

8. *Hokonui Endemic Area*—Those properties within an area enclosed by a line running from the intersection of Retreat Croydon Road and Kelvin Reaby Road, north west along the Retreat Croydon Road, Otapiri Manderville Road and Waimea Valley Road to the Dipton Balfour Road, then south east along this road to the intersection with Ben Callum Road.

From this intersection south to junction with Otapiri Stream then follow the Otapiri Stream south along the east bank until it intersects with Shand Road from there east on Shand Road then east onto Lora Garger Road till the junction with the Makarewa River, then east on the north bank of the Makarewa River to Scott Road bridge then east along Scott Road to Jewitt Road and Murchison Road to State Highway 96. East along State Highway 96 to Miller Road, then north east along Miller Road, Duthie Road, Copland Road and Kelvin Reaby Road to the Retreat Croydon Road/Kelvin Reaby Road intersection.
