AUSTRALIA/NEW ZEALAND CLOSER ECONOMIC RELATIONS TRADE AGREEMENT RULES OF ORIGIN - DETERMINATION OF IMPORTED MATERIAL NOTICE 1992 - 4

In terms of Regulation 70(b)(iii) of the Customs Regulations 1968, 'Goods Wholly Manufactured in Australia', the following materials have been determined:

Methazole Technical

This determination is effective from 15 June 1992 Dated at Wellington this 22nd day of September 1992

CUSTOMS EXCHANGE RATES NOTICE (NO. 20) 1992

Pursuant to section 143 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to him by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 20) 1992.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 19th day of October 1992.

2. Exchange rates - Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation - The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 19) 1992, published in the New Zealand Gazette, Customs Edition No. 152, dated 22 September 1992, on page 3152 is hereby revoked.
