Pursuant to sections 146 and 155 of the Education Act 1989, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice:

Together with the use of te reo Maori as the principal language of instruction the following aims, purposes and objectives constitute the character of Te Kura Kaupapa Maori O Kaikohe:

- (i) A commitment to preserve and maintain the taonga, culture and heritage of tupuna and to guarantee the survival of te reo Maori.
- (ii) An obligation to ensure that mokopuna from kohanga reo will develop fluency in te reo Maori, and will receive instruction in tikanga Maori, arts and crafts, and genealogy with an understanding of the significance of taha wairua.
- (iii) To create an environment in which self-esteem, discipline and respect embrace the mokopuna and instil in them the desire to strive for excellence.
- (iv) To encourage, motivate, and excite children to learn and to develop skills for the future.
- 5. Constitution of the Board of Trustees—The board of trustees of Te Kura Kaupapa Maori O Kaikohe shall comprise:
 - (a) Five people appointed by the Minister;
 - (b) The principal, or principal designate;
 - (c) Not more than four persons co-opted by the board.
