# The Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice (No. 5210)

Pursuant to section 85 of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries, after consultation with the Director-General of Conservation and the Fishing Industry Board pursuant to sections 85 and 86 of the Fisheries Act 1983, hereby gives the following notice.

#### Notice

- 1. Interpretation—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice and shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1993.
- **2.** Interpretation—In this notice, the term:
  - "Rock Lobster" means those fish on which the scientific names are *Jasus edwardsii* (commonly known as the spiny or red rock lobster) and *Jasus verreauxi* (commonly known as the packhorse or green rock lobster).
  - "Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery" means the rock lobster fishery bounded by all that area of New Zealand fisheries waters enclosed by a line commencing at a point 40° 25′ S and 178° W on the outer limits of the exclusive economic zone; then proceeding along the outer limits of the zone to a position 51° 50′ S and 174° 35′ E; then proceeding in a straight line to a position 50° 55′ S and 173° 50′ E; then proceeding along the outer limits of the

zone to a position 48° 15′ S and 174° E; then proceeding in a straight line to the point of commencement.

3. Closed season of rock lobster determined—There is hereby determined to be a closed season for rock lobster in the Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery commencing on the 1st day of March 1993 and expiring with the 30th day of April 1993, both days inclusive.

# **Water Recreation Regulations 1979**

## The Water Recreation (Motueka & Takaka Rivers) Notice 1993

I, Thomas Edwin Law, Senior Advisory Officer (Harbours Management), pursuant to the Water Recreation Regulations 1979\* and in exercise of powers delegated to me pursuant to section 28 of the State Sector Act 1988, hereby give the following notice:

#### Notice

- 1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Water Recreation (Motueka & Takaka Rivers) Notice 1993.
- (b) This notice shall come into force 28 days after publication in the *New Zealand Gazette* and shall remain in force until revoked by further notice in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, regulations 7 (1) (a), 7 (1) (b) and 7 (2) of the Water Recreation Regulations 1979 shall not apply to the areas specified in the First Schedule.
- 3. The Water Recreation (Motueka River) Notice 1983† is hereby revoked.

## First Schedule

Firstly, all the waters of the Motueka River from the Tapawera Road Bridge to the State Highway 60 Road Bridge at Motueka.

Secondly, all the waters of the Takaka River from its source to the State Highway 60 Road Bridge at Waitapu when the water level exceeds 2.1 metres at Kotinga Bridge.

#### Second Schedule

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this notice, no person who is permitted by any such provision to propel or navigate a small craft at a speed through the water exceeding 5 knots shall do so in any manner that is likely to endanger or unduly annoy any person who is, in, on, or using the waters or fishing, or undertaking any recreational activity in the vicinity of the small craft.
- 2. All persons in charge of a vessel shall adhere to and keep the provisions of all Acts and regulations not specifically exempted by this notice.
- 3. A suitable notice as may be approved by the Section Officer (Harbours Management), Christchurch, shall be erected at the sites deemed necessary by the Section Officer (Harbours Management).

# Definitions of Fish and Game Region Boundaries Notice 1990—Amendment No. 3

Pursuant to section 26A (1) (c) (i) of the Conservation Act 1987 (as inserted by section 17 of the Conservation Law Reform Act 1990), I, Denis Marshall, Minister of Conservation, hereby amend the "Definitions of Fish and Game Regions Boundaries Notice 1990", published in the New Zealand Gazette of 24 May 1990, on page 1861.

- 1. This amending notice may be cited as the Definitions of Fish and Game Regions Boundaries Notice 1990, Amendment No. 3, and it shall be read together with and deemed part of the Definitions of Fish and Game Regions Boundaries Notice 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal notice").
- 2. This amending notice shall come into force on 1 March 1993.
- 3. Paragraph two in the principal notice defining the Auckland/Waikato Fish and Game Region (previously named Waikato Fish and Game Region in paragraph two of the principal notice but renamed by the amending notice "Name Changes for Fish and Game Regions" published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 29 August 1991, No. 129 on page 2786) is amended by deleting the reference to S.O. Plan 58494 and substituting the following reference: "S.O. Plan 59437".
- 4. Explanatory Note: The boundary amendment places the Firth of Thames within the Auckland/Waikato Fish and Game Region.

# **Nursing Council of New Zealand**

## **Nurses Act 1977**

Order of the Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of Kingsley Kin-Lit Kung, Registered Psychiatric Nurse

In exercise of its powers under sections 42 (1) (b), 42 (2) (a), 42 (9), 42 (3), 23 (2) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand after due inquiry on 29 October 1992, found Kingsley Kin-Lit Kung to have been quilty of professional misconduct and ordered that his name be

removed from the Register of Psychiatric Nurses and that 2 years be the time after which he may apply to have his name restored to the Register. Council also ordered that he return all certificates and badges issued to him by the Nursing Council, that he pay \$3,900.00 or actual costs incurred (whichever is the lesser) toward the costs and expenses of and incidental to the inquiry by the council, that a notice stating the effect of these orders be published in the *Gazette*, and the *New Zealand Nursing Journal*.
