Animals Act 1967

Movement Control Notice Issued Under Section 13A, Animals Act 1967 (Notice No. 5215)

For the purpose of controlling the movement of all bivalve molluscs which may be harbouring a harmful organism, pursuant to section 13A of the Animals Act 1967, I hereby prohibit all movement of bivalve molluscs from the Movement Control Area described in the Schedule hereto for a period of 30 days from the date of publication of this notice in the New Zealand Gazette.

The Movement Control Area is that area of land and water bounded:

- (a) by the outer limit of the Territorial Sea as defined by section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977 heading in a northerly direction from a point on the Territorial Sea at 40° 56.4′S 174° 35.4′E around the coast of the North Island to a point on the Territorial Sea at 41° 27.6′S 174° 26.0′E; and
- (b) by a straight line from 41° 27.6′S 174° 26.0′E in a northerly direction to the point of commencement at a point 40° 56.4′S 174° 35.4′E.

Fisheries Act 1983

The Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice (No. 2) (No. 5211)

Pursuant to section 85 of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries, after consultation with the Director-General of Conservation and the Fishing Industry Board, pursuant to sections 85 and 86 of the Fisheries Act 1983, hereby gives the following notice.

Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice (No. 2) and shall come into force on the 15th day of March 1993.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice the term:
- "Rock Lobster" means those fish on which the scientific names are Jasus edwardsii (commonly known as the spiny or red rock lobster) and Jasus verreauxi (commonly known as the packhorse or green rock lobster).
- "Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery" means the rock lobster fishery bounded by all that area of New Zealand's

fisheries waters enclosed by a line commencing at a point $40^{\circ}\ 25'\ S$ and $178^{\circ}\ W$ on the outer limits of the exclusive economic zone; then proceeding along the outer limits of the zone to a position $51^{\circ}\ 50'\ S$ and $174^{\circ}\ 35'\ E$; then proceeding in a straight line to a position $50^{\circ}\ 55'\ S$ and $173^{\circ}\ 50'\ E$; then proceeding along the outer limits of the zone to a position $48^{\circ}\ 15'\ S$ and $174^{\circ}\ E$; then proceeding in a straight line to the point of commencement.

- 3. Closed season of rock lobster determined—There is hereby determined to be a closed season for rock lobster in the Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery commencing on the 15th day of March 1993 and expiring with the 14th day of May 1993, both days inclusive.
- **4. Revocations**—The Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice (No. 5210) published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on 28 January 1993, Issue No. 11, at page 190, is hereby revoked.

Preliminary Determination: Home Brew Beer Kits From the United Kingdom

Pursuant to section 12 (1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby give notice that I have made a preliminary determination on the basis of the information made available during the investigation that there is reasonable cause to believe that home brew beer kits listed in the Schedule to this notice, sourced from the United Kingdom and imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand, are goods in respect of which I may direct the imposition of an antidumping duty in accordance with section 14 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988.

Pursuant to section 12 (3) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, I hereby give notice of a provisional direction, in accordance with section 16 (1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, that payment, in respect of the said goods, of anti-dumping duty described in the Schedule to this notice, shall be secured by the Collector of Customs in accordance with part IX of the Customs Act 1966, on those goods entered for home consumption on or after the 28th day of January 1993.
