**The Methodist Church Property Trust Amendment Bill****Notice to Introduce Bill**

Notice is hereby given of the intention of the Methodist Church of New Zealand to apply for leave to introduce into the House of Representatives a private bill to be named The Methodist Church Property Trust Amendment Bill.
