Hamilton Parsonage Site Amendment Bill

Notice to Introduce Bill

Animals Act 1967

Movement Control Notice Issued Under Section 13A, Animals Act (Notice No. 5243)

For the purpose of controlling the movement of all bivalve molluscs which may be harbouring a harmful organism, pursuant to section 13A of the Animals Act 1967, I hereby prohibit all movement of bivalve molluscs, for the purpose of relaying into other waters, from the Movement Control Areas described in the Schedule hereto for a period of 30 days from the day this notice comes into effect.

This notice shall come into effect on the date of publication in the Gazette.

Schedule

The Movement Control Areas are:

1. North Island

All that area of land and water bounded:

- (a) By the outer limit of the territorial sea as defined by section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977 heading in a northerly direction from a point on the territorial sea at 40° 56.4'S and 174° 35.4'E around the coast of the North Island to a point on the territorial sea at 41° 27.6'S and 174° 26.0'E; and
- (b) By a straight line from 41° 27.6′S and 174° 26.0′E in a northerly direction to the point of commencement at a point 40° 56.4'S and 174° 35.4'E.

2. Chatham Islands

All that area of land and water bounded by the outer limit of the territorial sea as defined by section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977 that surrounds the Chatham Islands.

3. South Island

All that area of land and water bounded:

- (a) By the outer limit of the territorial sea as defined by section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977 heading in a southerly direction from a point on the territorial sea 41° 27.6'S and 174° 26.0'E around the coast of the South Island to a point on the territorial sea at 40° 56.4'S and 174° 35.4'E; and
- (b) By a straight line from 40° 56.4'S and 174° 35.4'E in a southerly direction to the point of commencement at a point 41° 27.6'S and 174° 26.0'E.

Fishing Prohibited in Certain Waters Within the **Taupo District**

Pursuant to section 26ZL (1) (c) of the Conservation Act 1987, I, Murray Hosking, Deputy Director-General of Conservation, pursuant to a written delegation from the Director-General of Conservation, hereby give notice that, in addition to those Taupo District waters in which the taking of trout is prohibited, as set out in regulation 3 (1) of the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, no person shall take trout in any of the following waters in the Taupo District:

- 1. The Te Whaiau Stream.
- 2. The Waipehi Stream.
- 3. The Waitotara Stream.

This notice has the effect of amending the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Part 1, regulation 3 (1), and unless this notice is amended or revoked, it shall continue in force until the date on which an amendment to the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, affecting regulation 3 (1), comes into force.

The notice shall come into effect on 1 July 1993.

Pursuant to section 8 of the Local Authority Reorganisation (Property Transfers) Act 1990, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

Order

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Local Government (Mosgiel Borough Council Property) Reorganisation Order 1993.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Interpretation—In this order:

"Trust" means the Mosgiel Borough Commemorative Trust created by a trust deed dated the 7th day of August 1990, which replaced an original deed dated the 3rd day of October 1989.

"Liable property" means the sum of \$29,130, which the former Mosgiel Borough Council endowed in the trustees of the Trust, and any interest earned on this sum from the date of creation of the Trust until the date of transfer in accordance with this order.

- 3. Vesting of property—(1) The liable property, less the amount of \$4,000 which the Trust granted to the Mosgiel Abilities Resource Centre, is hereby vested in the Dunedin City Council, freed of all trusts and encumbrances.
- (2) The trustees of the Trust shall forthwith take such steps as are necessary to transfer the liable property, less the amount of \$4,000 referred to in subclause (1) of this clause, to The Dunedin City Council.
 - (3) The Mosgiel Abilities Resource Centre shall not be

required to repay the \$4,000 it received by way of a grant from the Trust, and may use that money in furtherance of its objectives.

Exemption of ATV's from Motor Vehicle Equipment and Inspection Requirements When Registered Exempt Class A Vehicle

Pursuant to regulation 90 of the Traffic Regulations 1976 and pursuant to the powers delegated to me by the Secretary for Transport, I, Hugh Cameron Matheson, Senior Automotive Engineer, hereby exempt from the requirements of regulations 84 (6) and 85 (1) of the said regulations the class of vehicle specified in the Schedule hereunder subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule.

Schedule

The class of vehicle is an all terrain vehicle (ATV) which complies with the following descriptions:

- 1. A special purpose motor vehicle which has three or more wheels, is principally designed for off-road use, and
 - (i) has a gross vehicle mass of less than 1000 kilograms, and
 - (ii) has an engine cylinder capacity exceeding 50 millilitres, and
 - (iii) may be fitted with motorcycle controls and equipment.
 - 2. Conditions
 - (i) The ATV is used on a road which is not a public highway and qualifies for an exemption from registration and licensing fees in accordance with Part II of the First Schedule to the Transport (Vehicle and Driver Registration and Licensing) Act 1986 (Registered in EA category—Exempt Class A Licence Label).
 - (ii) When operated on any road/public highway the operator shall ensure the vehicle complies with those parts of the following regulations which pertain to a motor cycle; regulations 62, clause 3A, 68, 69, 70, 77, 80, 81, 82A and 83 of the Traffic Regulations 1976. The brake system shall also include an efficient locking device for parking purposes.
 - (iii) When operated on any road/public highway during the hours of darkness, the lighting requirement specified in regulation 37, clause 8 of the Traffic Regulations 1976 shall be complied with.
 - (iv) The ATV must not be operated at a speed exceeding 30 kilometres per hour on any road/public highway.

Schedule

The class of vehicle is an all terrain vehicle (ATV) which complies with the following descriptions:

- 1. A special purpose motor vehicle which has three or more wheels, is principally designed for off-road use, and
 - (i) has a gross vehicle mass of less than 1000 kilograms, and
 - (ii) has an engine cylinder capacity exceeding 50 millilitres, and
 - (iii) may be fitted with motorcycle controls and equipment.
 - 2. Conditions
 - (i) The ATV must be owned by a farmer for farm purposes thus qualifying as a farm vehicle in accordance with the First Schedule to the Motor Spirits Duty Refund Regulations 1978 (Registered in EB category—Exempt Class B Licence Label).
 - (ii) When operated on any road/public highway during the hours of daylight, the operator shall ensure the vehicle complies with those parts of the following regulations which pertain to a motor cycle. Regulations 62, clause 3A, 68, 69, 70 clause 4 and 5, 71 clauses 1 and 2, 76 clause 1 and the second paragraph to clause 2, 77, 80, 81, 82A and 83 of the Traffic Regulations 1976.
 - (iii) When operated on any road/public highway during the hours of darkness, the operator shall ensure the vehicle complies with, in addition to conditions in (ii), those parts in regulations 58, 59, 60, 62 clause 1, and 63 which pertain to a motor cycle.
 - (iv) When the driver's arm signals are obscured, the operator shall ensure the vehicle complies with regulations 61 and 63, which pertain to a motor cycle.
 - (v) When auxiliary lamps are fitted, the operator shall ensure the respective requirement in regulation 65 are complied with.
 - (vi) If a windscreen is fitted, the requirements in regulation73 must be complied with which pertain to a motor cycle.
 - (vii) The ATV must not be operated at a speed exceeding 30 kilometres per hour on any road/public highway.

The current owners of the land, New Zealand Railways Corporation, have applied to the Waitangi Tribunal to have these memorials removed. This has been done under section 8D of the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975.

The application by New Zealand Railways Corporation states that these lands are covered by an agreement with Ngati Whatua o Orakei Maori Trust Board and the Ngati Paoa

Whanau Trust Board, and arrangements involving representatives of the Ngaitai and Waiohua tribal groups, the Manukau Maori Trust Board and Te Runanga o Ngati Whatua Trust Board. These arrangements provide for the withdrawal of claims to all surplus lands owned by New Zealand Railways Corporation in central Auckland, and for the payment by the Crown to Ngati Whatua whanui of an "on account" settlement of \$4 million and to Ngati Paoa of a settlement of \$1 million.
