- 3 All submissions objecting to a request for the withdrawal of a concession must include:
- reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
 - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.
- 5 Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will be considered invalid.

CUSTOMS EXCHANGE RATES NOTICE (NO. 16) 1993

Pursuant to section 143 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to him by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 16) 1993.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 23rd day of August 1993.

2. Exchange rates - Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation - The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 15) 1993, published in the New Zealand Gazette, Customs Edition No. 112, dated 27 July 1993, on page 2155 is hereby revoked.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Notice of Review of Undertaking on Primary Cell Batteries From Korea

I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby give notice that I shall review the need for the continuation of the undertaking in relation to the dumping of the goods described in the Schedule to this notice. The undertaking was accepted by the Minister of Commerce by notice, dated 11 June 1992, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 25 June 1992, page 2169, pursuant to section 15 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988.

The reason for the review being undertaken is that the sole manufacturer is to cease manufacturing the goods in New Zealand from September.
