  - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a 4 copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above
- Any submission not supported by the information required in the paragraphs above will be considered invalid. 5
