Securities Amendment Act 1988

The Authorised Futures Dealers Notice 1994 (No. 4)

Pursuant to section 38 of the Securities Amendment Act 1988, the Securities Commission gives the following notice:

Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as The Authorised Futures Dealers Notice 1994 (No. 4).
- (2) This notice shall come into force the day after the date of its publication in the New Zealand Gazette.
- 2. Interpretation—(1) In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "the Act" means the Securities Amendment Act 1988:
 - "the Company" means Electricity Market Company Limited:
- (2) Any term or expression which is not defined in this notice, but that is defined in the Act has the meaning given to it by that Act.

- 3. Electricity Market Company Limited authorised to carry on business of dealing in futures contracts—(1) The company is hereby authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts of a specified class, namely, electricity supply hedge contracts.
- (2) The authorisation referred to in subclause (1) of this clause is subject to the conditions that—
 - (a) the company deals in futures contracts on behalf of no person other than a person who is a party to a physical supply contract with Electricity Corporation of New Zealand Limited; and
 - (b) the Company has undertaken to the Securities Commission that prior to 31 March 1995, it will provide to the Securities Commission a written report on all material aspects of the business undertaken by it pursuant to this authorisation.
