 - (iv) The maintenance of the law and justice, including the prevention, investigation, and detection of offences, and the right to a fair trial.

The disclosure of information relating to such conduct or activity (in the bill called "public interest information") is generally known as "whistleblowing".

Traffic Regulations 1976

Exemption of Certain Vehicles Owned by Specified Airline Companies From Particular Equipment Requirements While Used on Specified Roads

Pursuant to regulation 90 of the Traffic Regulations 1976, and pursuant to the powers delegated to me by an instrument of delegation dated the 20th day of August 1993, I, Hugh Cameron Matheson, Senior Automotive Engineer, hereby exempt the classes of vehicle specified in Schedule One from the requirements of regulations 58 to 64 (inclusive), regulations 68-76 (inclusive), regulations 78, 81, 82 and 83B and regulations 84-87 (inclusive) of the Traffic Regulations 1976 subject to the conditions specified in Schedule Two.

The notices of exemption published in the *New Zealand Gazette*: No. 101, page 2146, 1990 and No. 102, page 2835, 1986 are hereby revoked.

Schedule One

Tractors owned by Air New Zealand Ltd, Ansett New Zealand Ltd and Mount Cook Group Limited (Airline Division) together with any trailer or trolley while drawn by such tractors.

Schedule Two

1. This exemption applies to the specified classes of vehicles when they are being used within the airport and roads within the airport area.

2. **Maintenance**—All tractors, trailers, and trolleys must be regularly maintained. A record of this periodic maintenance must be kept and made available to Land Transport Safety Authority officers on request.

3. Lights—

Tractors—must be fitted with:

(a) one or more revolving or flashing amber light fitted as high as practicable behind the driver, visible in all directions, that is used at all times when operating, and

(b) an efficient audible warning device.

Tractors, trailers, and trollies must be fitted with:

(a) two forward facing side lamps, white in colour, and

(b) one rearward facing lamp, red in colour.

The above lamps must be visible from at least 100 metres in normal atmospheric conditions and must be used on any road during the hours of darkness.

4. Brakes on tractors—

(a) *Service brake*—the service brake must be capable of stopping any combination of fully laden trailers or trolleys specified in paragraph 6 within a distance of 7 metres from a speed of 15 km/h without assistance from the compression of the engine.

(b) *Parking brake*—the parking brake must be capable of stopping any combination of fully laden trailers or trolleys specified in paragraph 6 within a distance of 18 metres from a speed of 15 km/h without assistance from the compression of the engine, or be capable of holding the whole combination of vehicles fully laden at rest on a grade 1 in 5.

5. Reflectors—

All trailers and trolleys must be fitted with:

(a) (i) approved red or amber reflective materials along the sides of the vehicle, or

(ii) three red or amber approved reflectors evenly spaced along the sides of the vehicle; and

(b) (i) red or amber reflective materials across the full width of the rear tray, or

(ii) two approved red reflectors, one either side of the rear tray. The approved reflectors may be fitted as well as the reflective materials.

All tractors must be fitted with at least two approved red reflectors, one either side of the rear tray.

6. Towing—

Tractors must tow no more than a rake of either:

(a) Six fully loaded container trailers;

(b) Six fully loaded baggage trolleys;

(c) Three fully loaded cargo or flat top trailers; or

(d) Six unloaded cargo or flat top trailers on any road;

Every fully loaded cargo or flat top trailer exceeding 2000 kgs must have a safety chain fitted that is securely

connected while being towed. These chains shall have a minimum breaking load of 20 tonnes.

7. Operational speeds—

The speed of any tractor, trailer or trolley shall not exceed 15 km/h on any road.

During the period under review the trust has provided financial assistance to a wide range of community groups in Canterbury, Marlborough and Nelson. In addition to responding to applications for assistance the trust has initiated several new projects of benefit to community groups.

Review of Results and Financial Position of the Trust:

The trust distributed over \$3.7 million by way of donations to community groups during the last 12 months. The trust's investment in Trust Bank New Zealand Limited continues to be very profitable and has enabled the trust to expand its charitable work while maintaining a sound financial position.

Notes to the Financial Statement for the Year Ended 31 March 1994

1. Statement of Accounting Policies

General Accounting Policies

The following general accounting policies have been adopted in the preparation of the financial statements.

- (i) The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost, except for the revaluation of investments. Reliance is placed on the fact that the trust is a going concern.
- (ii) The matching of revenue earned and expenses incurred using accrual accounting concepts.

Specific Accounting Policies

Depreciation—Depreciation has been charged in the financial statements using rates which will write off the cost of assets less their estimated residual value over their estimated economic lives. The depreciation rates used are:

Plant and equipment	20 percent cp
Motor vehicles	20 percent cp
Computer	20 percent cp

Fixed Assets—Fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Investments—Investments are shown at market value. Unrealised gains or losses from holding investments are transferred directly to the revaluation reserve. Realised gains or losses on subsequent disposal of investments are transferred from the revaluation reserve direct to the capital fund.

Donations—Donations are accounted for on an accruals basis.

Dividend Income—Dividend income from Trust Bank New Zealand Limited is included in the income and expenditure statement when it is received.

Taxation—For taxation purposes the trust is deemed to be a charitable organisation. Its income is not subject to taxation.

Goods and Services Tax—The trust is not registered for G.S.T. purposes and therefore the financial statements have been prepared on a G.S.T. inclusive basis.

Changes in Accounting Policies—The trust now values investments at market value and records the movement directly to the revaluation reserve, and accounts for donations on an accrual basis. Previously Trust Bank New Zealand Limited shares were valued at cost. Unrealised gains or losses on other investments were recorded in the income and expenditure statement. Donations were accounted for on a cash basis. All other policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in the previous year. The net effect of these changes in policy has been to increase the surplus for the current year by \$224,951,819 (1993 increase of \$78,334).

The Trust Bank New Zealand Limited shares are valued at the market price of \$2.30 on 31 March 1994. On 16 May 1994 the market price was \$2.01.

During the year Trust Bank New Zealand Limited made a bonus issue of 1:1 and then split nominal value to 50 cents.

During the year the trust transferred 119 998 000 shares to Community Trust Nominees Limited (CTN) which holds the shares as bare trustee. Altogether CTN holds 337 654 000 Trust Bank New Zealand Limited shares as bare trustee for various community trusts through their investments in Community Trusts Investments Limited (CTI). CTN has a share capital of \$100 consisting of 100 \$1 shares, and is wholly owned by CTI. CTI has a share capital of 100 000 1 cent shares of which the trust owns 35 539. At balance date the share capital of CTN and CTI were unpaid.

As part of the Trust Bank New Zealand share float the trust sold 10 000 000 of their shares, realising a capital gain (after brokerage) of \$16,417,852.

3. Donations

The names of persons and organisations to whom distributions of income have been made by the trust under section 21 of the Trustee Banks Restructuring Act 1988 during the financial year and the amounts distributed are shown in the appendix to the financial statements.
