 - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Review of Undertaking in Respect of Alloy Wheels From Australia

By notice dated 18 March 1991, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 21 March 1991 (at page 964), the Minister of Commerce accepted an undertaking under section 15 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, in respect of the goods described in the Schedule to this notice. Having reviewed the continued need for the undertaking pursuant to section 15 (7) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, the Minister of Commerce has decided that the undertaking shall remain in force. The brief reason for the decision is that if the undertaking was to be removed, the domestic industry would suffer material injury as a result of the importation of subsidised goods.
