Private Member's Bill

Parliamentary Privilege

The bill seeks to place parliamentary privilege on a clear statutory basis and includes protections to safeguard the rights of ordinary New Zealanders.

The following changes are proposed:

- defining what is involved in contempt of Parliament
- abolishing the power of Parliament to imprison or fine
- providing that where punishment by way of fine or imprisonment is contemplated for the offence of contempt of Parliament the matter is to be decided by the High Court rather than Parliament
- defining "proceedings in Parliament"
- abolishing the narrow freedom from arrest which MPs have at present
- reaffirming the freedom of speech and debate in Parliament but creating safeguards against its abuse by
 - requiring members who make assertions in the House of impropriety, breach of duty, dishonesty or criminal conduct to first notify the Speaker and satisfy him or her that they have grounds for making the assertion
 - providing that failure by a member to comply with the notice procedure constitutes a breach of privilege, and that the person adversely affected by such a breach has the right to be heard by the Privileges Committee
 - providing the person against whom the assertion is made with a right of reply
- making provision for select committees of Parliament to follow the rules of natural justice
- abolishing the power of Parliament to expel members
- repeal of the Legislature Act 1908

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act

Revocation of Notice Imposing Anti-Dumping Duty in Respect of PVC Cling Film from Korea and Taiwan

In accordance with section 14 (4) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, the Minister of Commerce gives the following notice.

Notice

1. Title—(1) This notice may be cited as the Revocation of Notice Imposing Anti-Dumping Duty in Respect of PVC Cling Film from Korea and Taiwan.

(2) This notice shall come into effect on the day after the date on which it is published in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

2. Revocation of notice imposing duty—The notice given by the Minister of Commerce entitled "Final Determination and Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty: PVC Cling Film From Korea and Taiwan" dated 23 September 1992 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 1 October 1992 ("the principal notice") is hereby revoked and the duties imposed by the principal notice shall cease to be payable.

3. Reason for revocation—The reason for the revocation of the principal notice is:

(a) In relation to PVC Cling Film imported from Korea, a review of the continued need for the imposition of anti-dumping duty was carried out and has found that no importations from Korea of the goods described in the principal notice have occurred since the imposition of anti-dumping duties. No future importations from this source are foreseen. No material injury is therefore being caused or is threatened to any New Zealand industry by the importation from Korea of the PVC cling film described in the principal notice, and therefore no anti-dumping duty is necessary to counteract the injurious effect of dumping.

(b) In relation to PVC Cling Film imported from Taiwan, a review of the continued need for the imposition of anti-dumping duty was carried out and has found that dumping is no longer occurring, and is unlikely to recur. No material injury is therefore being caused or is threatened to the New Zealand industry by the importation from Taiwan of the PVC cling film described in the principal notice, and therefore no anti-dumping duty is necessary to counteract the injurious effects of dumping.
