- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Notice of Review of Need for Continued Imposition of Anti-dumping Duty on Certain Types of Plasterboard from Thailand

I hereby give notice that, pursuant to section 14 (5) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, I have initiated a review of the need for the continued imposition of anti-dumping duty on the goods described in the Schedule to this notice. Anti-dumping duty was imposed on these goods in a notice dated 21 March 1989, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 11 January 1990; amended in a notice dated 1 March 1990 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 8 March 1990; and reassessed duty was imposed in a notice dated 9 April 1991, published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 18 April 1991.

Thailand.

Description of Goods

Plasterboard, being standard or foil-backed plasterboard having nominal dimensions of 9 mm or 9.5 mm thickness by 1200 mm width by 2400 mm to 3600 mm length.
