- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 8) 1995.

Refined Sugar from Belgium, Denmark, Germany, Malaysia, the Netherlands and Thailand.

Plasterboard from Thailand.

Lead Acid Batteries from Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore and Taiwan.

Certain Non-Leather Women's Footwear from China.
