Summary of Bills Presented

This section contains a précis of all bills presented to the House this week. Not all bills presented are introduced. The introduction of a bill requires the agreement of the House.

Government Bills*Electoral Reform*

Makes a number of miscellaneous amendments to the Electoral Act 1993, the Privacy Act 1993 and the Citizens Initiated Referenda Act 1993.

The amendments to the Electoral Act 1993 relate to the following areas:

- Membership of the Electoral Commission and its powers in relation to the registration of political parties;
- Functions of Returning Officers;
- Powers of the Representation Commission;
- Timeframe for receipt of an application to register as an elector after writ day;
- Procedures for objections to registration as an elector;
- Supply of information about electors;
- Use of dormant files;
- List seat vacancies, list candidates' expenditure restrictions and advertising both for list candidates and generally;
- Order of the ballot paper;
- Designation of polling places;
- Special voting provisions for electors in remote areas; and
- Appointment of scrutineers.

The amendments to the Privacy Act 1993 are consequential on the repeal of the Electoral Act 1956 and the enactment of the Electoral Act 1993.

The amendments to the Citizens Initiated Referenda Act 1993 replace the definition of "eligible elector" and transfer responsibility for determining whether the Act's advertising requirements have been complied with to the Chief Electoral Officer.

(Hon. D A M Graham/Referred to Electoral Law Committee).

Financial Transactions Reporting

Companion measure to the money laundering offences created in the Crimes Amendment Bill (No. 2) 1994. Facilitates enforcement of Proceeds of Crimes Act 1991. Satisfies New Zealand's international obligations as a member of the Financial Action Task Force on Money Laundering.

- Requires financial institutions to:
 - Verify the identity of customers;
 - Report suspicious transactions to the Police; and
- Keep records of customers and transactions for at least 5 years.
- Defines "financial institutions" as:
 - Banks, building societies, friendly societies, credit unions, life insurance agencies sharebrokers, casinos, the TAB, trustees, administration managers, investment managers of superannuation schemes, managers of unit trusts, real estate agents, lawyers, accountants;
 - Anyone whose business consists of borrowing, loaning or investing money, administering or managing funds, acting as a trustee, providing financial services that involve the transfer or exchange of funds.
- Requires anyone entering or leaving New Zealand carrying cash exceeding the prescribed threshold to report this to Customs officials; and
- Commences on 1 January 1996, with the offences commencing on 1 July 1996.

(Hon. D A M Graham/Referred to Justice and Law Reform Committee).

Banking Law Reform

Repeals the Banking Act 1982 and amends the Evidence Act 1908, the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1989, and the Cheques Act 1960. Provides for three significant changes to banking law:

- A non-transferable cheque is introduced, payable only to the account of the payee named on the cheque;
- "Truncation" is permitted for the clearance of cheques, allowing banks to pay cheques on the basis of information received electronically; and
- Certain administrative requirements on banks are removed.

(Rt. Hon. W F Birch/Referred to Finance and Expenditure Committee).

Health and Disability Services Amendment

Amends the Health and Disability Services Act 1993.

The main purpose of the bill is to abolish the Public Health Commission as from 1 July 1995, and to transfer the functions of the Commission relating to public health to the Ministry of Health and to regional health authorities. Consequential amendments are made to the principal Act and certain other enactments.

Amends section 6 (1) of the principal Act, which provides for the National Advisory Committee on Core Health and Disability Support Services. The principal function of the committee is to advise the Minister of Health on the kinds, and relative priorities, of personal health services and disability services that should, in the committee's opinion, be publicly funded. The amendment extends that function to include public health services.

Environment Amendment

Amends the Environment Act 1986.

The purpose of the bill is to give effect to recommendations of the Finance and Expenditure Committee on the Inquiry into Officers of Parliament relating to the Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment, and to make consequential changes to the provisions relating to the office and staff of the Commissioner following changes made in the state sector.

Provides for the appointment of a Deputy Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment. The provisions of the Environment Act 1986 relating to the Parliamentary Commissioner apply, with the necessary modifications, to the Deputy Commissioner. In addition provision is made for the functions of the Deputy Commissioner. The Deputy Commissioner, subject to the control of the Parliamentary Commissioner, has all the functions, duties, and powers of the Commissioner.

(Hon. Simon Upton/Referred to Planning and Development Committee).

Crown Pastoral Land

Amends the Land Act 1948. The main provisions are:

- Modifies provisions equivalent to those in the Land Act 1948, making it impossible to grant new pastoral leases except as a consequence of a subdivision of an existing pastoral lease;
- Enables the review of existing tenures under pastoral leases and pastoral occupation licences with a view to restoring some pastoral land to full Crown ownership and control;
- Amends the Land Act 1948 so as to make clear that where land is disposed of, or a new lease or licence is granted for it, the new title, lease, or licence comes not only subject to existing encumbrances, etc., but also with the benefit of existing covenants and appurtenant encumbrances over other land.

The Fisheries (Cheltenham Beach Shellfish Closed Season) Notice 1995 (No. 5407)

Pursuant to section 85 of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries, after consultation with the Director-General of Conservation, the NZ Fishing Industry Board and the Treaty of Waitangi Fisheries Commission, pursuant to sections 85 and 86 of the Fisheries Act 1983, hereby gives the following notice.

1. Title and commencement—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Cheltenham Beach Shellfish Closed Season)

Notice 1995 and shall come into force on the 23rd day of April 1995.

2. Interpretation—In this term, the term:

“Shellfish” has the meaning given in the Fisheries Act 1983;

“Cheltenham Beach Shellfish Area” means all those waters lying within an area bounded by a line commencing at Takapuna Head (at 36° 48.95'S and 174° 48.5'E); thence proceeding generally in a south easterly direction to the eastern most point of North Head (at 36° 49.3'S and 174° 49.7'E); thence generally in a northerly direction along the mean high-water mark to the point of commencement.”

3. Closed season for shellfish determined—There is hereby determined to be a closed season for the taking of all shellfish within the Cheltenham Beach Shellfish Area

not withdraw are annexed to this report along with a transcript of the evidence presented to the enquiry.

Conclusions

The creation of these proposed Taiapure fisheries were generally supported by the recreational and commercial fishing interests. The noted exception was M. Hansen who saw his livelihood as a commercial fisherman being endangered. In respect of this aspect of his objection if he conclusively established pecuniary loss he would be justified particularly as the legislation does not allow or provide compensation for commercial fishermen suffering loss because a taiapure fishery is established. This is a matter that legislation should address rather than this report.

Moving to the public in general, again there appears to be support excepting M. J. Appleyard whose objecting to boundary definition as advertised in the statutory notices and gazetting may upon investigation be proven justified; his general objection goes to the very legislation rather than to the proposal, before this inquiry, Mr Hansen expressed similar sentiments in alleging discrimination in the legislation.

A more valid objection is the definition of estuarine and littoral coastal waters; these unless clarified by legislation will prove to be fruitful area for future objectors not to mention the legal profession.

Of concern to this inquiry is the failure in the legislation in providing proper servicing of the Inquiry; but for the generosity of the registrar Maori Land Court, Takitimu, in providing clerical and administrative support the inquiry may never have got off the ground, as it is not the province of the Judge to provide this back up. I compare this to the Waitangi Tribunal where Maori Land Court Judges are often presiding in claims hearings; it is clear that the Tribunal is charged with provision of all necessary support services.

The evidence is such that if the Minister intends recommending a Taiapure fishery as sought nothing before this inquiry should inhibit that course of action; as well there is no justification for any recommendations amending the proposal.

Primary Recommendation

That the Minister take no action as a result of the objections and submissions made to this Tribunal.

Ancillary Recommendations

(1) That the legal boundaries already published be checked for accuracy taking into account the submission of Mr M. J. Appleyard.

(2) That the Taiapure Fisheries legislation be re-visited with particular emphasis on the following:

(a) a definition of estuarine and littoral coastal water

(b) clarification of the role of the Registrar and staff of the Maori Land Court. There must be provision in the legislation for the servicing of the Inquiry

(c) the compensation by the Crown of persons who can prove pecuniary loss because of the creation of a Taiapure fishery.
