- reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
 - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

RULES OF ORIGIN - DETERMINATION OF IMPORTED MATERIALS

NOTICE 1995/2

In terms of Regulation 70A(1)(b)(iii) of the Customs Regulations 1968, "Goods Wholly Manufactured in Australia", the following material has been determined:

FABRIC, non-woven, spunbonded, composed of 100% high density polyethylene fibres, having ALL of the following:

- (a) thickness NOT less than 80 micron and NOT exceeding 340 micron;
- (b) weight NOT less than 50gsm and NOT greater than 115gsm;
- (c) tensile strength NOT less than 100 N/2.54cm machine direction (MD) and NOT less than 126 N/2.54cm cross direction (XD);
- (d) elongation NOT less than 15% machine direction (MD) and NOT less than 17% cross direction (XD).

This determination is effective from 25 May 1995

CUSTOMS EXCHANGE RATES NOTICE (NO. 13) 1995

Pursuant to section 143 of the Customs Act 1966, the Comptroller of Customs, in accordance with the power delegated to him by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement - (1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 13) 1995.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 26th day of June 1995.
2. Exchange rates - Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.
3. Revocation - The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 12) 1995, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, Customs Edition No. 54, dated 6 June 1995, on page 1385 is hereby revoked.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Termination of Dumping Investigation: Leather Jackets and Coats From Pakistan

Pursuant to section 11(1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, and section 21 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Amendment Act 1994, I hereby give notice of the termination of the dumping investigation in respect of a dumping complaint lodged by the New Zealand industry producing leather jackets and coats against imports of leather jackets and coats from Pakistan, as described in the Notice of Initiation of Dumping Investigation of 21 December 1994 (*New Zealand Gazette*, 12 January 1995, No. 1, page 53).

I am satisfied, as a result of investigations carried out, that the goods from Pakistan which were under investigation are not goods in respect of which a determination may be made under the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, in that there is insufficient evidence of dumping and injury to justify proceeding with the investigation.
