School Crossing Point Trial

Pursuant to section 78 of the Transport Act 1962, the Land Transport Safety Authority of New Zealand authorises the erection installation and maintenance of the signs and road markings as described in Diagram 1 of the Schedule for use as experimental signs and markings in substitution for the pedestrian crossing signs and markings specified in the Traffic Regulations 1976, subject to the terms and conditions described in the Schedule, and for the purposes of evaluating the use of the said signs and markings. This substitution shall be called the School Crossing Point Trial.

Schedule

1. Locations approved:

The following locations shall be those approved for use in the School Crossing Point Trial.

(a) Christchurch City

- State Highway 75 at the intersection with Larsens Road

(b) Hastings District

- Windsor Avenue: at a point more or less 20 metres southwesterly generally of Howard Street

(c) Nelson City

- Vanguard Street: at a point more or less 50 metres northerly generally of Franklyn Street.

2. Duration of the Trial

The period of the School Crossing Point Trial shall start after the 15th day of September 1995 and shall end on the 31st day of August 1997 unless gazetted otherwise and shall cover all signs, and markings as specified in Diagram 1.

3. Equipment and layout of trial sites

The signs specified in Diagram 1 shall be those specified in the Traffic Regulations 1976 and the Manual of Sign and Markings : 1993. A special P2 type children flag sign with a black symbol on a fluorescent orange/red background is to be used adjacent to the crossing point.

Two white poles shall be erected on each approach to the School Crossing Point as specified in Diagram 1.

All crossing points are to be supervised by an adult during the time of the trial, and all signs, and flags are to be removed from the site(s) when the school patrol is not operating.

Any person operating as a school patrol or school warden at a school crossing point specified under this notice shall be equipped with the approved uniform as set out in the School Traffic Safety Team Manual.

4. Equivalent signs and markings

For the purpose of the School Crossing Point Trial, the crossing point definition lines, the P2 flag (fluorescent orange/red background with black children symbol) and the limit line and centre markings as laid out in Diagram 1 shall be the equivalent of the pedestrian crossing for the purpose of section 91 (3) (a) of the Traffic Regulations 1976 and diagram No. 1 in the Third Schedule to the regulations PROVIDED that the foregoing shall not apply unless one or both of the special P2 type flags is mounted on the support post and the crossing point definition lines and limit line markings are in place.

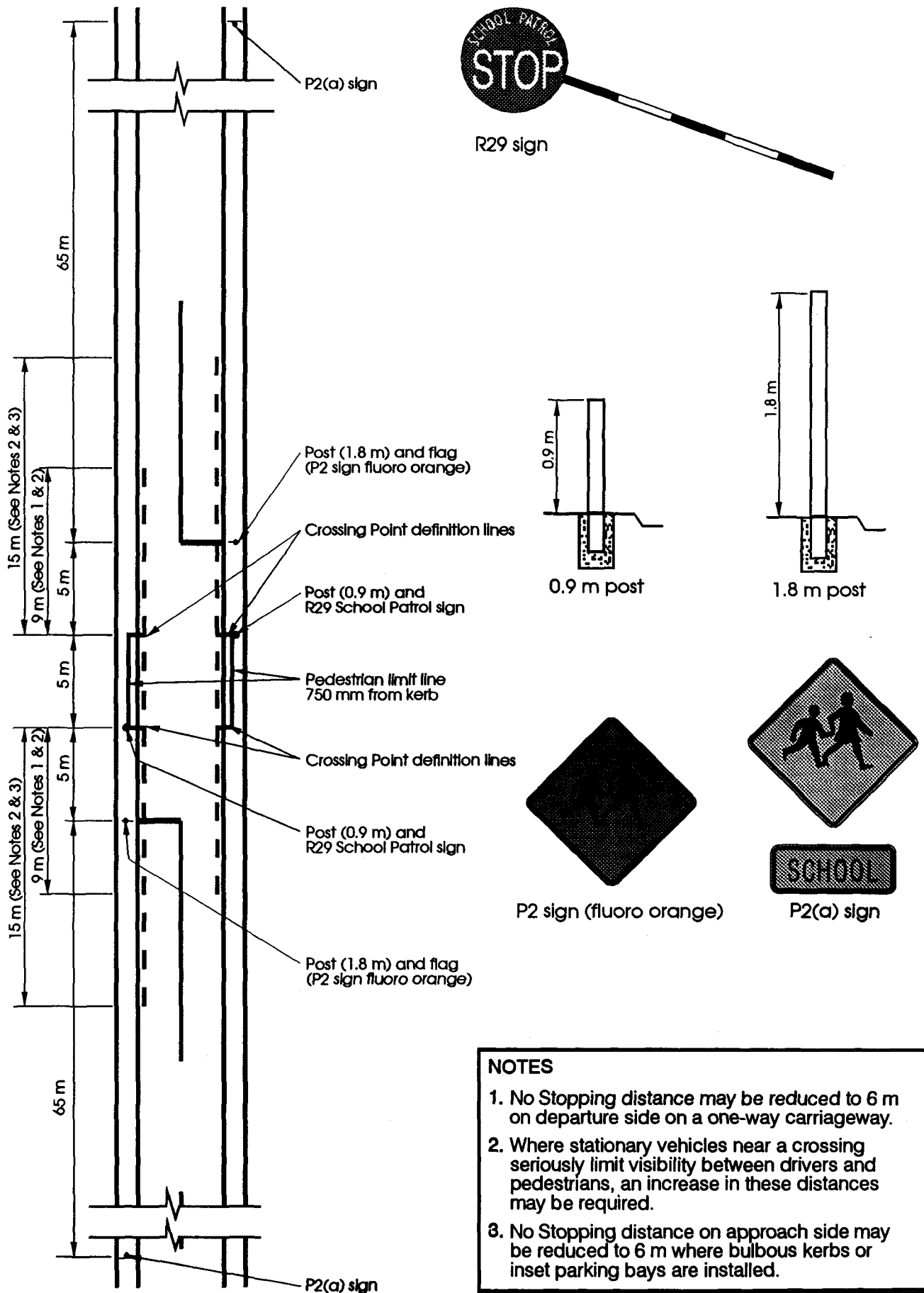

NOTES

1. No Stopping distance may be reduced to 6 m on departure side on a one-way carriageway.
2. Where stationary vehicles near a crossing seriously limit visibility between drivers and pedestrians, an increase in these distances may be required.
3. No Stopping distance on approach side may be reduced to 6 m where bulbous kerbs or inset parking bays are installed.

Casino Control Act 1990

Rules of Casino Table Games for the Christchurch Casino, Amendment No. 1

Pursuant to section 63 of the Casino Control Act 1990, the Casino Control Authority on 12 September 1995 resolved that Division VIII of the Rules of Casino Table Games approved to be conducted and played in the licensed casino at 30–38 Victoria Street, Christchurch, as set out in the Supplement dated Monday, 31 October 1994 to the *New Zealand Gazette* of Thursday, 27 October 1994, be amended as set out below.

1.0 Commencement

These amendments shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

2.0 Table Layout and Equipment

2.1 Rule 2.3 of this division is hereby amended by omitting sub-paragraph (c) and substituting the following:

- “(c) for wagers on the Progressive Jackpot by either:
- (i) when the Progressive Jackpot is being operated electronically, the slots provided for such wagers, or
 - (ii) when the Progressive Jackpot is being operated manually, the areas designated for such wagers as shown in Diagram 11.”

2.2 Rule 2.4 of this division is hereby omitted and the following rule substituted:

“2.4 When the Progressive Jackpot is being operated electronically, the Caribbean Stud Poker table shall be fitted with electronic equipment which:

- (a) shall be programmed to record the amounts wagered at the table on the Progressive Jackpot, and the amount of the jackpot prize pool applicable to the table;
- (b) shall be linked to one or more progressive meters, being electronic jackpot displays, which shall display the amount of the jackpot prize pool applicable to the table; and
- (c) shall include a coin indicator light at each Progressive Jackpot slot which shall light up to indicate that a wager on the Progressive Jackpot has been deposited in the slot.

The electronic equipment and the progressive meter(s) shall each be of a type approved by the Authority, contain components necessary for the performance of their respective functions, and comply with the applicable provisions of Division IV of the Rules of Casino Keno and Gaming Machines, as amended from time to time, approved for use in the casino and set out in the Supplement dated Tuesday, 1 November 1994 to the *New Zealand Gazette* of Thursday, 27 October 1994.”

2.3 Rule 2.5 of this division is hereby amended by:

- (a) inserting at the end of sub-paragraph (b), after the words “Diagram 11;”, the word “and”;
- (b) omitting from the end of sub-paragraph (c), after the words “the chips;”, the word “and”; and
- (c) omitting sub-paragraph (d).

3.0 Diagram 11 – Caribbean Stud Poker Table Layout

Diagram 11 of the rules is hereby amended by adding, after the words “PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT SLOT”, the words “/WAGERING AREA”.

4.0 Wagers

4.1 Rule 4.2 of this division is hereby amended by adding, after the words “the slot provided on the table”, the words “or on the designated area in accordance with sub-paragraph (c) of rule 2.3”.

4.2 Rule 4.3 of this division is hereby amended by inserting, before the words “Once a chip”, the words “When the Progressive Jackpot is being operated electronically,”.

4.1 Rule 4.8 of this division is hereby amended by adding, after the words “the slot provided”, the words “or on the designated area in accordance with sub-paragraph (c) of rule 2.3”.

5.0 Betting Round

Rule 8.2 is hereby amended by omitting sub-paragraphs (a) to (e) inclusive and substituting the following:

- “(a) when the Progressive Jackpot is being operated manually, collect the Progressive Jackpot wager if one has been made;
- (b) collect the ante wager;
 - (c) collect the cards dealt to that player;
 - (d) individually spread out the cards, face down;
 - (e) count the number of cards; and
 - (f) place the cards in the discard rack.”

6.0 Final Settlement

6.1 Rule 9.7 of this division is hereby amended by omitting sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting the following:

- “(a) when the Progressive Jackpot is being operated manually, collect the Progressive Jackpot wager, if one has been made, unless the hand qualifies for a Progressive Jackpot;
- (b) collect both the ante and the bet wagers on the hand; and
 - (c) subject to rule 9.3, collect and count the player’s cards as described in rule 8.2.”

6.2 Rule 9.8 of this division is hereby amended by omitting sub-paragraphs (a) to (c) inclusive and substituting the following:

- “(a) when the Progressive Jackpot is being operated manually, collect the Progressive Jackpot wager, if one has been made, unless the hand qualifies for a Progressive Jackpot;
- (b) pay the ante wager at odds of one to one;
 - (c) pay the bet wager at the odds set out in rule 10; and
 - (d) subject to rule 9.3, collect and count the player’s cards as described in rule 8.2.”

7.0 Progressive Jackpot

7.1 Rule 11.4 of this division is hereby amended by inserting, before the words “Players wagering”, the words “When the Progressive Jackpot is being operated electronically,”.

7.2 Rule 11.7 of this division is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:

- “When the Progressive Jackpot is being operated manually, and a hand qualifies for a jackpot payout,

the wager on the jackpot shall be collected after the payout has been made.”

8.0 Progressive Jackpot Payouts

Rule 12.0 of this division is hereby amended by omitting, from sub-paragraphs (a) and (b), the word “displayed”.
