C. Was guilty of unprofessional conduct.

Acting under section 24 (3) (c) of the New Zealand Society of Accountants Act 1958, the Disciplinary Committee ordered that **Peter Edward Eliot-Cotton** pay a penalty of \$200, and pursuant to section 24 (3) (c) of the New Zealand Society of Accountants Act 1958, that **Peter Edward Eliot-Cotton** be censured.

Peter Edward Eliot-Cotton was also ordered to pay to the society the sum of \$4,176.00 in respect of the costs and expenses relating to the inquiry by the Disciplinary Committee and the investigation by the Investigation Committee.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that its decision be published in the *Chartered Accountant's Journal of New Zealand* and the *New Zealand Gazette* with mention of the member's name and locality.
