1955, as they were sent out more than one month after the latest date fixed by section 47 of that Act for the calling of nominations: And whereas it is desirable to validate the holding of the election after the time required by Part III of the Maori Trust Boards Act 1955 and the sending out of the ballot papers and the accompanying declaration forms after the time required by section 51 of that Act:
