Termination of Subsidy Investigation: Sweetened Condensed Milk From Thailand

Because I am satisfied, under section 11 (1) (c) of that Act that, as a result of investigations carried out, the imposition of a countervailing duty in respect of the subject goods would be inconsistent with New Zealand's obligations as a party to the WTO Agreement, I have followed my statutory obligation to terminate the investigation.
