  - reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
  - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

#### **RULES OF ORIGIN - DETERMINATION OF IMPORTED MATERIALS**

#### **NOTICE 1996/1**

In terms of Regulation 70A(1)(b)(iii) of the Customs Regulations 1968, "Goods Wholly Manufactured in Australia", the following materials have been determined:

Polypropylene Homopolymer Film, biaxially oriented, having ALL of the following properties:

- (a) maximum elongation at break NOT exceeding 180% machine direction as measured by ASTM D882;
- (b) corona treated one side to a minimum of 36 dynes as measured by ASTM D2578;
- (c) co efficient of friction of NOT less than 0.4 measured by ASTM D1894;
- (d) width NOT less than 740 mm but NOT exceeding 1500 mm;
- (e) thickness gauges NOT less than 25 micron but NOT exceeding 50 micron; but NOT including film which is:
  - (i) voided;
  - (ii) printed;
  - (iii) coated;
  - (iv) metallised or metalliseable;
  - (v) heat sealable:
  - (vi) containing slip additives;
  - (vii) containing anti static additives.

This determination is effective from 31 January 1996.
