In the exercise of your power under section 70 (1) of the Social Security Act 1964 to reduce the rate of a benefit payable under that Act or the Social Welfare (Transitional Provisions) Act 1990 by the amount of any overseas benefit, pension, or periodical allowance the beneficiary is entitled to receive or receives, you shall apply the following matters in calculating the amount of the overseas benefit,

pension, or periodical allowance by which the benefit is to be reduced.

1. Definitions

1.1 In this direction, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Act” means the Social Security Act 1964,

“Cross rate” means a currency exchange rate between the New Zealand dollar and the currency of a country paying an overseas pension in New Zealand computed from time to time by pricing the New Zealand dollar and the currency of that country against the United States of America dollar,

“Cross rate calculation period” means a period—

(a) beginning at the commencement of the 16th day of one month, and

(b) ending at the close of the 15th day of the following month,

“Instalment period” means a period—

(a) beginning at the commencement of a pay day for a benefit; and

(b) ending at the close of the day before the next pay day for the benefit,

“New Zealand bank” means a bank in New Zealand to which an overseas bank transfers funds from an overseas country for the payment of that country’s overseas pensions in New Zealand,

“Nominated bank” means a bank for the time being nominated by you,

“Overseas bank” means an overseas bank used by the competent authority of an overseas country to transfer funds to a New Zealand bank for payment of that country’s overseas pensions in New Zealand,

“Overseas pension”—

(a) means an overseas benefit, pension, or periodical allowance of a kind described in section 70 (1) of the Act, but

(b) does not include an overseas benefit, pension, or periodical allowance of a kind referred to in the proviso to section 70 (1) of the Act,

“Overseas pensioner” means a person entitled to receive or receiving an overseas pension.

1.2 Expressions otherwise defined in section 3 (1) of the Act have the meanings so defined.

2. Average cross rate for purposes of calculating amount of reduction

2.1 For the purposes of the calculation required by clause 4 (b), the term “average cross rate” means—

(a) if you know which overseas bank and which New Zealand bank are used by the competent authority of the country paying the overseas pension, a figure that is the average of the transacted rates at which the overseas bank transferred to the New Zealand bank the funds for payment of that country’s overseas pensions in New Zealand, during the cross rate calculation period immediately preceding the month in which the calculation is made, or

(b) in any other case, a figure specified by the nominated bank to you, being a figure that is the average of the cross rates quoted by the nominated bank to buyers of the currency of the country paying the overseas pension, during the cross rate calculation period immediately preceding the month in which the calculation is made.

2.2 Clause 2.1 is subject to clauses 2.3 and 2.4.

2.3 If, on the last day on which you are required by the Department of Social Welfare computer system to enter the average cross rate for a particular cross rate calculation period, you ascertain that the cross rate quoted by the nominated bank on that day to buyers of the currency of the

country paying the overseas pension is significantly different to the average cross rate as calculated under clause 2.1, then you shall use as the average cross rate, the cross rate quoted by that bank on that day.

2.4 In clause 2.3, the term "significantly different" means a difference of not less than 25 percent.

3. Bank fee for purposes of calculating amount of reduction

For the purposes of the calculation required by clause 4 (b), the term "bank fee" means—

(a) if you know which overseas bank and which New Zealand bank are used by the competent authority of the overseas country to pay its overseas pensions,—

(i) the total in New Zealand currency of any bank fees charged between those banks to pay the overseas pension in New Zealand, if you know that total, or

(ii) in any other case, an amount in New Zealand currency that you set for the time being to compensate for any such bank fees,

(b) if the competent authority of the country paying the overseas pension pays that pension directly to the overseas pensioner by cheque, an amount in New Zealand currency set by you for the time being to compensate for the bank fee for negotiation of the cheque.

4. Rate of reduction

Where section 70 (1) of the Act requires a benefit to be reduced,—

(a) each instalment of the benefit shall be reduced, and

(b) the amount by which each instalment is reduced shall be calculated according to the formula—

$$(a \times b) - c$$

where

a is the amount of the overseas pension, in the currency of the country paying the pension, payable to the overseas pensioner during the instalment period,

b is the average cross rate, as defined in clause 2,

c is the bank fee, as defined in clause 3.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the direction but indicates its effect.

This direction, given by the Minister of Social Welfare under section 5 (2) of the Social Security Act 1964, governs the way in which the amount of an overseas

benefit, pension, or periodical allowance is calculated for the purposes of reducing the amount of a New Zealand benefit, under section 70 (1) of the Social Security Act. The direction requires the Director-General to calculate the amount using the average exchange rate ("average cross rate") between the currencies of the overseas country and New Zealand during the preceding month ending on the 15th of that month, unless on the last day for entering the amount in the computer system there is a significant difference of not less than 25% between the average cross rate and the cross rate on that day. The cross rate on that day is used if there is such a difference.
