Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Anti-Dumping Duties: Notice That Anti-Dumping Duties on Lead Acid Batteries From the Philippines are to Cease to Apply

Subject to section 14 (9) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (the Act), anti-dumping duties imposed on lead acid batteries from the Philippines* cease to apply to those goods on 2 February 1997 unless, at that date, the goods are subject to review under section 14 (8) of the Act.

Any interested party who might request the Secretary of Commerce to initiate a review before the termination date referred to above, should be aware that positive evidence justifying the need for a review must be provided to the Secretary.

If an application is received which provides positive evidence justifying the need for a review, the Secretary must undertake a review investigation and report to the Minister of Commerce within 180 days on whether the anti-dumping duties should continue to be applied. Positive evidence justifying the need for a review would need to provide reasons for believing that the expiration of antidumping duties would see the recurrence of dumping of lead acid batteries from the Philippines and for believing that such dumping would cause material injury to the New Zealand industry producing lead acid batteries. The reasons should be supported by evidence and not based on mere allegations or assertions.

Notice of Initiation of a Duty Reassessment for Plasterboard From Thailand

Pursuant to section 14(6) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 ("the Act"), and under

delegated authority from the Secretary of Commerce, I hereby give notice that I have initiated a reassessment of the amount of anti-dumping duty in respect of imports into New Zealand of the goods described in the Schedule imported from Thailand.

Anti-dumping duty was imposed on plasterboard of nominal dimensions of 9 mm or 9.5 mm thickness by 1200 mm width by 2400 mm to 3600 mm in length, in a notice dated 26 February 1996 and published in the *New* Zealand Gazette on 7 March 1996, and a new anti-dumping duty was imposed on plasterboard having nominal dimensions of 9 mm or 9.5 mm thickness and lengths of either less than 2400 mm or greater than 3600 mm, in a notice dated 29 March 1996 and published in the *New* Zealand Gazette on 4 April 1996.

The purpose of the reassessment is to ensure that any changes in the elements between the non-injurious market price and the non-injurious f.o.b. price which may have occurred, are incorporated into the current anti-dumping remedy.
