Notifying Issue of Writs, Date of Polling, etc.

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General, dated the 10th day of September 1996 directed to the Clerk of the Writs, I have this day issued writs to all Returning Officers authorising them to proceed to the election of members of Parliament for all electoral districts within New Zealand and have fixed Wednesday, the 18th day of September 1996, as the last day for the nomination of candidates, Saturday, the 12th day of October 1996, as the day upon which the poll for such elections shall (if necessary) be taken, and Friday, the 1st day of November 1996, as the day on or before which the said writs shall be returnable to me.
