- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

**REMOVAL OF DUTY FROM BARLEY AND OATS
TARIFF CHAPTER 10 : SUB-HEADINGS 10.03 AND 10.04**

You will have noticed in the First Schedule of this *Gazette* an Administrative concession relating to the removal of duty from barley and oats of tariff items 1003.00.00 and 1004.00.00 respectively.

The decision to remove the duty was made by the Minister of Commerce following a period of consultation between the Arable Section of the New Zealand Federated Farmers, Ministry of Commerce and representatives of the New Zealand Feed Manufacturers Association.
