 - (d) GP rural practice bonus and practice nurse subsidies;
 - (e) laboratory tests, other than those described in paragraph (f) below;
 - (f) laboratory tests for: blood lead; blood mercury and other heavy metals; serum cholinesterate; solvent metabolites (set-up charge); solvent metabolites (analysis), pesticides (set-up charge), and pesticides (analysis), all being tests that are not funded or subsidised through the laboratory services benefit schedule ("Seven Non-Schedule Laboratory Tests"); and
 - (g) certificates as set out in the Schedule to the now revoked Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Overseas Visitors Costs and Costs of Certificates) Regulations 1993 ("Certificates");
 - "Acute admission" means an unplanned admission on the day of presentation at the admitting health care facility. Admission may have been from the emergency or outpatient departments of the health care facility or a transfer from another facility;
 - "Acute services" means the following secondary or tertiary services:
 - (a) an acute admission; or
 - (b) unplanned accident and emergency services provided within 24 hours of the person presenting for treatment; or
 - (c) outpatient services associated with services provided under (a) or (b); or
 - (d) outpatient services not associated with services provided under (a) or (b), which are provided within 24 hours of the person being referred for those services by a medical practitioner; or
 - (e) community services associated with (a), (b), (c) or (d);
 - and for the avoidance of doubt does not include disability support services;
 - "Arranged admission" means a planned admission where the admission date is less than 7 days after the

- date the decision was made by a specialist that the admission was necessary;
- "Arranged services" means the following secondary or tertiary services:
 - (a) an arranged admission; or
 - (b) outpatient services associated with an arranged admission; or
 - (c) outpatient services provided less than 7 days after the date the person is referred for those services by a medical practitioner; or
 - (d) Community services associated with (a), (b), or (c);
 - and for the avoidance of doubt does not include disability support services;
- "ARCI Act" means the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992 and includes any regulations made or continued under that Act;
- "Community services" means services (other than disability support services) provided in a community setting outside a health care facility;
- "Disability services" has the same meaning as in section 2 of the H & DS Act;
- "Disability Support Services" include-
 - (a) services which provide information on Disability Support Services to people with disabilities and/or their caregivers in a suitable form; and
 - (b) needs assessment services; and
 - (c) service co-ordination services; and
 - (d) personal care services including assistance with daily activities such as dressing, personal hygiene, assistance with eating, supervising medication, seating, positioning and toileting; and
 - (e) household management services for people with disabilities including assistance with domestic functions such as meal preparation, cooking, cleaning, laundering and shopping; and
 - (f) caregiver support services that provide relief to primary informal care givers; and
 - (g) residential care services that provide short and long-term care; and
 - (h) rehabilitation and habilitation services; and
 - (i) environmental support services which supply people with disabilities with—
 - (i) equipment and aids to meet a range of needs including mobility, household management, communication, personal care needs; and
 - (ii) consumables related to continence, personal care and mobility;
- "Eligibility" means the right to be considered for receipt of publicly funded services, but does not equate to an entitlement to receive those services;
- "Eligibility criteria" means the criteria set out in section 5 of this direction, any of which, as a minimum, must be satisfied before any person may receive any publicly funded service purchased by the HFA;
- "Funding agreement" means an agreement within the meaning of section 21 of the H & DS Act entered into by the HFA;
- "Guardian" has the same meaning as in section 3 of the Guardianship Act 1968;
- "H & DS Act" means the Health and Disability Services Act 1993;
- "Health care facility" means a hospital, or other facility

- for the provision of services operated by a hospital (whether or not located in that hospital);
- "HFA" means the Health Funding Authority established by Order-in-Council under section 32 of the H & DS Act:
- "Minister" means the Minister of Health;
- "New Zealand citizen" means a person who has New Zealand citizenship under the Citizenship Act 1977 or the Citizenship (Western Samoa) Act 1982;
- "Ordinarily resident in New Zealand" means an individual who is lawfully present in New Zealand at the time of seeking services and who—
 - (a) is a New Zealand citizen who, immediately prior to seeking services, has remained in New Zealand for a period that equals or exceeds 2 years, whether or not that person has been temporarily absent from New Zealand; or
 - (b) is a New Zealand citizen who-
 - (i) has his or her usual place of abode in New Zealand; and
 - (ii) can demonstrate an intention, on reasonable grounds, to remain in New Zealand for a period that, together with the time that person has already been in New Zealand immediately prior to seeking the services, equals or exceeds 2 years; or
 - (c) holds a residence permit issued under the Immigration Act 1987, and
 - (i) holds a current returning resident's visa issued under the Immigration Act 1987; or
 - (ii) immediately prior to seeking services, has remained in New Zealand for a period that equals or exceeds 2 years; or
 - (d) is a person exempted, by virtue of being a citizen of the Commonwealth of Australia or by virtue of holding a current resident return visa issued by the Government of Australia, from holding a residence visa issued under the Immigration Act 1987, and can demonstrate an intention, on reasonable grounds, to remain in New Zealand for a period that, together with the time that person has already been in New Zealand immediately prior to seeking the services, equals or exceeds 2 years; or
 - (e) holds a student permit issued under section 26 of the Immigration Act 1987:
 - (i) entitling that person to remain in New Zealand for a period that equals or exceeds 2 years; or
 - (ii) entitling that person to remain in New Zealand for a period of not less than 12 months, where that individual can demonstrate a reasonable expectation of having a further student permit issued for that period which will (together with the duration of the first permit) allow that person to remain in New Zealand continuously for a period that equals or exceeds 2 years; or
 - (iii) entitling that person to remain in New Zealand for a specified period of time which, together with the period of time that person has already been lawfully in New Zealand immediately prior to obtaining the permit, equals or exceeds 2 years, or
 - (f) holds a visitor's or work permit issued under section 26 of the Immigration Act 1987:
 - (i) entitling that person to remain in New Zealand for a period that equals or exceeds 2 years; or

- (ii) entitling that person to remain in New Zealand for a specified period of time which, together with the period of time that person has already been lawfully in New Zealand immediately prior to obtaining the permit, equals or exceeds 2 years; or
- (g) is an individual under the age of 2 years who was born in New Zealand and has remained in New Zealand since birth, whether or not that person has been temporarily absent from New Zealand;
- "Outpatient services" means personal health services (including treatment, therapy, advice, diagnostic or investigatory procedures or pre-admission assessment) provided in a health care facility to a person who is not admitted to that facility at the time of receiving those services;

"Partner" means-

- (a) where the parties are legally married, either the husband or the wife, as the case requires;
- (b) where the parties (whether of the same or opposite gender) are not legally married but are living together in a relationship in the nature of marriage, either of the parties, as the case requires;
- "Personal health services" has the same meaning as in section 2 of the H & DS Act;
- "Prison" includes a Gazetted police jail, or corrective training institution;
- "Publicly funded services" means personal health and disability services purchased by the HFA using funds provided by the Crown under a funding agreement, and does not include services purchased by the HFA using funds provided by any person or agency other than the Crown, whether or not the purchasing of those services results in a part charge to the person receiving the services;
- "Services" means personal health services or disability services or both;
- "Specified injuries" means all and any personal injuries:
 - (a) that are motor-vehicle related;
 - (b) that are work-related (including subsequent work-related personal injuries);
 - (c) to earners (within the meaning of the ARCI Act) that are of any type of personal injury;
 - (d) that are referred to in paragraphs (a), (b) or (c) above and are suffered by persons who are not "ordinarily resident in New Zealand" within the meaning of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Ordinary Residence Definition) Regulations 1992;
- (2) Words importing the singular include the plural and vice versa.

3. Disputes and payments—

If any question or dispute arises as to whether or not-

- (1) Any person satisfies any of the eligibility criteria for receipt of a service; or
- (2) Any other criteria or any terms or conditions, set out in a funding agreement, for receipt of a service, are satisfied;

that question or dispute shall be determined by the Minister.

4. Amendment, revocation and term of direction-

(1) The Minister may from time to time, by notice under section 25 of the H & DS Act, amend or revoke this direction.

- (2) The Health and Disability Services Eligibility Direction 1997 is hereby revoked.
- (3) This direction (together with any amendments to it made under clause (1) of this section), shall remain in force until it is revoked by the Minister.

5. Eligibility Criteria-

A person shall be eligible for publicly funded services if he or she is in New Zealand at the time of seeking services and—

- (1) Is ordinarily resident in New Zealand; or
- (2) Is a New Zealand citizen who is temporarily resident in New Zealand and who has at some time had his or her usual place of abode in New Zealand for a period that equalled or exceeded 2 years whether or not that person has been temporarily absent from New Zealand during that period; or
- (3) Is a New Zealand citizen whose usual place of abode is in the Cook Islands, Niue, or Tokelau, and who for the time being is temporarily resident in New Zealand; or
- (4) Has refugee status in New Zealand or is in the process of applying for such status; or
- (5) Is a student receiving funding under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade Official Development Assistance Programme, or is the partner, or child under the age of 18 years of such student; or
- (6) Is a participant in the Ministry of Education's Foreign Language Teaching Assistantship Scheme; or
- (7) Is---
- (a) a person having their usual place of abode (other than unlawfully) in a country or territory from time to time specified by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*, being a country or territory where in the opinion of the Minister individuals who are citizens of New Zealand or ordinarily resident in New Zealand are or will be, while in that country or territory, eligible for services that substantially correspond to services that the HFA is obliged by its funding agreement to purchase in respect of those individuals; and
- (b) not of a class of persons specified by the Minister in that notice as being individuals who may not receive services purchased by the HFA; or
- (8) Is a resident of Australia who is in New Zealand on a temporary basis (in respect of services required to be provided for that individual while in New Zealand by the agreement set out in the Schedule to the Health Benefits (Reciprocity with Australia) Act 1986) or any enactment which replaces, amends, supplants, or consolidates that Act: or
- (9) Is recognised by the Government of the United Kingdom as a national, and has his or her usual place of abode in the United Kingdom, and is in New Zealand on a temporary basis (in respect of services required to be provided for that individual while in New Zealand by the agreement set out in the Schedule to the Health Benefits (Reciprocity with the United Kingdom) Act 1982 or any enactment which replaces, amends, supplants, or consolidates that Act; or
- (10) Is a child (who is not otherwise eligible) under the age of 16 years who is lawfully in New Zealand and is for the time being in the care and control of:
- (a) his or her guardian, and his or her guardian meets any of the eligibility criteria specified in clauses 1, 2, or 3; or
- (b) a person who is in the process of legally adopting that child and that person meets any of the eligibility criteria specified in clauses 1, 2, or 3, or

- (11) Is an individual receiving compulsory services under the Tuberculosis Act 1948, the Health Act 1956, the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Act 1966, the Mental Health (Compulsory Assessment and Treatment) Act 1992, or any regulations made under such legislation, in respect only of services under those enactments, provided that any such individual may be considered for eligibility for those services only in terms of this clause 11; or
- (12) Is a prison inmate, including an individual on remand in prison custody, in respect only of services not available through the prison health services, provided that any such individual may be considered for eligibility for those services only in terms of this clause 12; or
- (13) (a) is an individual who, in respect only of eligibility for accident-related personal health services required by that person for a specified injury for which that person has cover and entitlement¹ under the ARCI Act—
- (i) is "ordinarily resident in New Zealand" within the meaning of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance (Ordinary Residence Definition) Regulations 1992, and has any type of specified injury; or
- (ii) is not "ordinarily resident in New Zealand" in terms of clause 13 (a) (i), and the specified injury is a work injury or motor vehicle injury within the meaning of the ARCI Act; or
- (iii) is not "ordinarily resident in New Zealand" in terms of clause 13 (a) (i), and is an earner (within the meaning of the ARCI Act), and has any type of specified injury;
- (b) is an individual who, in respect only of eligibility for disability support services, requires those services for a personal injury for which the person has cover under the ARCI Act, but no entitlement to those services pursuant to regulations made, or a contract entered into, under that Act, and who (were it not for the proviso (c) to this clause 13) would satisfy any of the criteria in clauses 1–10 of this section 5 in respect of such services;

(c) provided that:

- (i) any individual with cover and entitlement under the ARCI Act may be considered for eligibility for publicly funded services in respect of a specified injury, only in terms of this clause 13; and
- (ii) Nothing in this clause 13 shall require the HFA to purchase Accident-Related Personal Health Services for persons who have cover and entitlement under the ARCI Act but who are not "ordinarily resident in New Zealand" within the meaning of the Accident Compensation (Ordinary Residence Definition) Regulations 1992, and:
 - (I) are not earners; or
 - (II) have not had a work-related or motor-vehicle related personal injury.

6. General

- (1) Eligibility according to the eligibility criteria is to be assessed at the time the service is sought.
- (2) A person may, unless otherwise stated, be eligible under one or more of the eligibility criteria.
- (3) No payment shall be made by the HFA in respect of the receipt of a service by an eligible person who was not within New Zealand at the time of that receipt, unless such payment is authorised in a funding agreement.



Herd Testing Regulations 1958

"NEW ZEALAND DAIRY BOARD

At its meeting on 23 June 1998, the Dairy Board resolved (Board Resolution No: 10936) to approve the Terms and Conditions of Herd Testing Licences issued by the New Zealand Dairy Board pursuant to the Herd Testing Regulations 1958 as set out below, to take effect on the issue of any new licences.

Terms and Conditions of Herd Testing Licences Issued by New Zealand Dairy Board

Pursuant to its powers under the Dairy Board Act 1961 and the Herd Testing Regulations 1958, the New Zealand Dairy Board ("NZDB") sets the following terms and conditions ("Conditions") to apply to all herd testing licences issued by the NZDB. The purpose of these Conditions is the ensure the integrity of data supplied to or held in the National Dairy Herd Improvement Database ("Database") by:

- (a) setting and maintaining uniform standards for the accurate collection and processing of all herd testing data; and
- (b) ensuring that all herd testing in New Zealand is conducted in a consistent and uniform manner nationwide.

The integrity of herd testing data is essential in order to optimise milk quality and the rate of genetic gain in the national dairy herd to the benefit of the New Zealand dairy industry.

Licence Holder to Supply All Herd Testing Data

- 1.1 The Licence Holder shall faithfully and accurately collect and supply to the Database Manager all herd testing data relating to its herd testing activities and such other data as may be required from time to time by the Database Manager. All data shall be provided strictly in accordance with any time limits prescribed by these Conditions or by the Database Manager, or where no time is specified, forthwith as soon as reasonably possible. In default of the Licence Holder supplying such data, the Database Manager may obtain these.
- 1.2 The Licence Holder shall supply to the Database Manager, within 7 days of the data coming under its control, a copy of the RDIPM for every animal for which information is received or recorded by the Licence Holder.
- 1.3 The Licence Holder shall supply to the Database Manager before 31 July in each year such data as will enable the Database Manager to provide NZDB with a summary of its herd testing operations showing all herds, cows and samples tested and test results for the previous 12 month season for which the licence has been granted.
- 1.4 All data collected by the Licence Holder pursuant to a herd testing licence shall be supplied to the Database Manager and not to any other person, except as is otherwise permitted in accordance with the Access Code.

Integrity of Information

- 2.1 The Licence Holder shall ensure that all data it supplies are valid, accurate and complete in accordance with the Database Manager's requirements.
- 2.2 The Licence Holder shall take out or maintain adequate insurance against any failure, breach or default of these Conditions, by the Licence Holder and hereby indemnifies the NZDB in respect of all damages, costs, claims or expenses (including legal fees) incurred by or awarded or made against the NZDB and arising out of or in connection with such failure, default or breach.
- 2.3 The Licence Holder shall comply with all methods or systems of identification of farms, farmers, herds, animals, locations and stored genetic material and with all quality control procedures and record formats that may from time to time be required by the Database Manager.
- 2.4 The Licence Holder shall on request (but no more frequently than annually) demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Database Manager or the NZDB that it operates quality control procedures to ensure as far as it is practicable, that the animal details, the location details for the herd, and the herd testing results it has reported for each animal, are suitable for use in animal evaluation and for research, in that:
- (a) Up-to-date, complete and accurate date of birth, identification, mating and birth details for each animal that has been in the herd during the period that the herd test service has been provided by the licence holder are recorded on the database.
- (b) the lactation identification and test day production detail information associated with each animal can be field verified to the specific cow;
- (c) the cows tested are not treated in any way so as to cause the herd test results for the period they are reported to represent to be other than representative of the normal production for the cow for that period;
- (d) Where a cow or a group of cows from a herd are separated from the rest of the herd and/or receive different treatment or management such separation or differing treatment is advised to the database manager;
- (e) the milk tested or the sample taken to determine composition has not been modified in any way to cause the results of the composition analysis to be other than an accurate reflection of the production from the cow; and
- (f) any abnormalities associated with the production of an individual cow or the quality / treatment of samples used for milk analysis are indicated by use of the appropriate codes:
- 2.5 The Licence Holder shall ensure that the equipment and methods used for the purposes of sampling, measuring and analysing milk meet the required operating and accuracy specifications as approved for the purpose from time to time by the Database Manager and published in the New Zealand Gazette or as described in Appendix I.

Use of Information

- 3.1 The Database Manager shall not be obliged to enter any data into the Database unless it is satisfied that the data or the manner in which it has been supplied complies with these Conditions.
- 3.2 The NZDB or the Database Manager, acting on its behalf, shall be entitled to use any data supplied by a Licence Holder in any manner at any time as it sees fit provided that such use complies with the Access Code.

Licensed Territory

4.0 Each Licence Holder shall offer its service to all farmers within the boundaries fixed by the NZDB and

annexed to its herd testing licence. If no boundaries are defined, the district shall be the whole of New Zealand.

Variations

5.0 The NZDB may, from time to time, change or revoke these Conditions or part of them provided that 60 days written notice of such changes or revocation has been given to each Licence Holder. Any revocation will be subject to clause 6 of these Conditions.

Cancellation

- 6.0 The NZDB may at any time cancel any herd testing licence if:
- (a) the Licence Holder fails to remedy, within 30 days of having received a written notice requesting it to remedy, any non-compliance with the general intent of, or any default on any of its specific obligations under, these Conditions, including a failure to comply with any requirement in any Appendix; or
- (b) after having given the Licence Holder 30 days notice to answer any allegations, the NZDB is of the opinion that any claim made or implied by the Licence Holder about the value or quality of the information is either false or materially misleading.

Dispute Resolution

- 7.1 In the event of any dispute or difference arising between the Licence Holder, the NZDB, or the Database Manager as to any matter concerning herd testing, either from these Conditions or otherwise, the parties to the dispute or difference shall in the first instance use their best efforts to resolve their dispute or difference by negotiation, but if the dispute or difference is not resolved within 7 days they shall refer it to the Dairy Herd Improvement Tribunal ("Tribunal") which may then either refer it to conciliation or decide the issue in accordance with its own procedures as a submission to arbitration under the Arbitration Act 1908 and its amendments.
- 7.2 If the Tribunal refers any dispute or difference to conciliation and that process is terminated without agreement having been reached then the Tribunal shall decide the issue by arbitration as described in the preceding paragraph.
- 7.3 Pending a reference to the Tribunal and its decision being made known, the Licence Holder shall at the option of the NZDB continue to perform all its obligations under these Conditions without prejudice.
- 7.4 The Tribunal's decision whether as a result of the conciliation or the arbitration procedure shall be final and binding on all parties.

Definitions

Unless the context otherwise requires:—

"Access Code":

means the code developed by the Dairy Herd Improvement Tribunal to govern that Tribunal and the conditions of access to the National Dairy Herd Improvement Database.

"Appendix" or "Appendices":

means the appendices relating to record formats, technical specifications or to other aspects of herd testing activities, annexed to and forming part of these Conditions.

"AB code identification":

means for every animal identified by this method the unique code issued by the Database Manager for identification of bull semen used in New Zealand.

"birth details":

means in each herd for each calf born at a calving, the

cow number and if known the birth identification of the dam, together with sequence number, sex, fate, and if known birth identification, sire (AB code identification, or herdbook identification, or birth identification), and if recorded for the calf a comment code.

"birth identification":

means for each animal identified by this method a participant identification, year digits and sequence number.

"calving details":

means in each herd for every cow calving, the cow number and if known the birth identification of the cow, together with the date, number born, and if known, the assistance given.

"conciliation":

means the following procedure whereby the Tribunal refers a dispute or difference to a conciliator. In the event of a referral to conciliation under clause 7 of these Conditions, the conciliator shall forthwith assist the parties in an independent and impartial manner to reconcile their views on the dispute or difference to reach an amicable settlement or solution.

If they are unable to reach such an agreement or solution the conciliator may formulate the terms of its determination or proposal for a settlement or solution. Such determination or proposal shall be binding on both parties unless within 5 days one party notifies the other that it rejects the conciliators determination or proposal.

The conciliation procedure shall be deemed to have terminated:

- (i) by the signing of a settlement agreement by the parties; or
- (ii) by a written declaration of one party to the other and to the conciliator that the conciliation is terminated; or
- (iii) by a written declaration by the conciliator to the parties that further efforts at conciliation are no longer justified; or
- (iv) by the parties not objecting to the conciliator's determination or proposal within 5 days.

"Dairy Herd Improvement Tribunal":

means the tribunal established by the New Zealand Dairy Board on the recommendation of the Macdonald Committee Report 1992 to develop among other things guidelines, and to mediate on any issues, relating to access to the Database.

"data":

means any data, information or records, whether in electronic or manual form, which is obtained or provided pursuant to either a herd testing licence or service.

"Database Manager":

means the entity appointed by the New Zealand Dairy Board to operate and manage the National Dairy Herd Improvement Database.

"farm and herd identification":

means for a herd the map reference, herd number, and participant identification of the herd owner. These will be issued by the Database Manager for each herd each season.

"herdbook identification":

means (where applicable) for every animal identified by this method the Breed Society, sex, and herdbook number.

"herd testing":

means the operation of testing milch cows in any two or more herds the property of different persons for the purpose of recording the milk production, milk composition and milk quality of individual cows within those herds in respect of milk volume and milk solids or characteristics, or any of them.

"lactation identification":

means for each herd for every cow with a lactation the test number of the animal together with calving date, condition at calving if known, the drying off date at the end of the lactation if recorded.

"Licence Holder":

means those persons or entities who have been granted a herd testing licence by the New Zealand Dairy Board, pursuant to the Herd Testing Regulations 1958.

"LIA identification":

means (where applicable) for each animal identified by this method a region number, herd number, year number, and sequence number.

"location identification":

means the cow number (or birth identification) of the animal together with the map reference, herd number, date in, and if the animal is no longer at this location, the date out, fate, and cause code.

"mating detail":

means for each location the cow number or birth identification of the animal together with the following details for each recorded mating—

- either for single matings;
 - date of mating, mating type, and
 - if the mating is by artificial insemination, the AB code of the semen, participant code of the inseminator, and if known, the semen batch number, or
 - if the mating is natural, the birth identification, or herdbook number, or AB code of the bull.
- or for animals run with a bull;
 - date bull starts to run with animal, and
 - birth identification, or herdbook identification of the bull, and
 - date bull stops running with the animal.

"participant identification":

means for every legal entity involved in herd ownership in New Zealand, the unique participant code issued by the Database Manager.

"RDIPM":

means the record of details of identification, production and mating being a schedule, provided on electronic media of a type agreed from time to time with the Database Manager, with the following information recorded:

- farm and herd identifications,
- location identifications,
- birth identifications,
- calving details,
- birth details,
- lactation details,
- test day production details, and
- mating details.

Detailed formats, default values and codes are those approved for the purpose from time to time by the Database Manager and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* or as described in Appendix II.

"season"

means the period of 12 months ending with the 31st day of May in any year.

"test day production detail":

means for each herd the cow number of the animal together with the following details for each test—

- the date of test, abnormal code, and
- the milk volume for each milking carried out over the period of the test, and a calculated 24 hour milk volume equivalent, and
- based on a representative sample of the 24 hour milk production, the fat %, protein %, and the somatic cell concentration, and/or
- any other characteristics of milk that may have been determined or be required.

Notice No. 2948 in the *Gazette* dated 21 April 1994, No.36 p.1401 is hereby revoked.

APPENDIX I

TECHNICAL SPECIFICIATIONS

The following specifications shall generally be required to be met for equipment to be considered for approval for use and inclusion to the schedule of approved equipment.

1. Milk Meters

Target Accuracy for Total Yield (in litres to one decimal point) for each animal shall be:

When herd test determinations are carried out less frequently than at every milking

95% of milk yield measurements to be within \pm 7.5%

99% of milk yield measurements to be within $\pm 10\%$

The first requirement has been interpreted as \pm 7.5% where the true volume is 4.0 litres or more, and \pm 300 grams where the true volume is less than 4.0 litres.

When herd test determinations are carried out at every milking

95% of milk yield measurements to be within \pm 15%

99% of milk yield measurements to be within \pm 20%

The first requirement has been interpreted as \pm 15% where the true volume is 4.0 litres or more, and \pm 600 grams where the true volume is less than 4.0 litres.

The target accuracy shall be maintained under the following conditions:

- (i) flow rates between 0.5 litres/min and 9.0 litres/min, that exist for at least two minutes.
 - (ii) air pipeline vacuum levels between 36 and 56 kPa.
- (iii) air admission rates between 4 and 12 litres/min, with a milk flow rate of 3 litres/min and air pipeline vacuum level of 50 kPa.
- (iv) meter tilt of \pm 5 degrees in forward, back, left and right directions, with a milk flow of 3 litres/min.
- (v) the meter should perform to requirement on all types of installations when fitted in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Yield Range

The measuring range for total yield shall not be less than 0-20 litres.

Hygiene Requirements

Surfaces of the meter which come in to contact with milk and wash water/chemicals shall be of materials which conform with the requirements of MAFQAL hygiene specifications.

The materials used for the meter shall be capable of repeatedly sustaining a continuous temperature of 95 degrees C for a period of three minutes, without affecting accuracy during subsequent milkings or causing visible deteroiration of materials.

2. Component Sampling Accuracy

Target accuracy for subsample measurement shall be:

- (i) within \pm 0.1% for milkfat and/or protein units of the reference sample for 95% of all measurements.
- (ii) within \pm 0.2% milkfat and/or protein units of the reference sample for 99% of all measurements.
- (iii) subsampler bias less than \pm 0.1% for miklfat and/or protein units compared with the reference sample.
- (iv) standard deviation for subsampler errors less than 0.05% units.

3. Component Analysis Accuracy
