 - the grounds on which objection is made (including reasons why the local product is a suitable alternative);
 - present and potential output;
 - details of factory cost in terms of materials, labour, overheads, including the proportion of domestic and imported content.
- 3 All submissions objecting to a request for the withdrawal of a concession should include:
- reasons why the local product on which protection is sought is not a suitable alternative;
 - full technical details of the goods against which tariff protection is sought.
- 4 Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the Ministry of Commerce quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Notice of Review of Need for Continued Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty on Men's Sports Casual Shoes and Boots from China, Indonesia and Thailand

I hereby give notice that, pursuant to section 14 (8) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, I have initiated a review of the need for the continued imposition of anti-dumping duty on the goods described in the Schedule to this notice. The duty was imposed by the Minister of Commerce in a notice dated 11 September 1992, published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 17 September 1992, and amended in a notice given by the Minister of Commerce, dated 30 July 1996, published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 1 August 1996.

China, Indonesia and Thailand

Description of Goods

Men's sports casual shoes and boots, which for anti-dumping duty purposes fall within the following categories of footwear:

- sports shoes with leather uppers;

- sports boots with leather uppers;
- sports shoes with uppers of rubber or plastics;
- sports boots with uppers of rubber or plastics;
- textile sports shoes and boots.
