Accident Insurance Act 1998

Recommendations From Consultation on the Residual Claims Levy Regulations 1999

The Residual Claims Account pays for the immediate and ongoing costs of treating and rehabilitating people who were injured in the workplace before 30 June 1999 and suffered non-work injuries prior to 1 July 1992. This Account is funded by a residual claims levy which is paid by all employers and self-employed based on their levy classification unit.

As required by section 409 of the Act, A.C.C. has completed consultation with levy payers, and has recommended changes to the residual claims levy to the Minister for Accident Insurance.

A.C.C. has recommended that from 1 April 2000 a 41.8 percent reduction in the average residual claims levy from the current rate of \$0.67 to \$0.39 (G.S.T. exclusive) for every \$100 of liable earnings. The individual classification levies would range from \$0.19 for low-risk activity sectors to \$1.74 for high-risk activity sectors.

Recommendations From Consultation on Earner Premium and Earner Levy Regulations 1999

The Earners' Account pays for the treatment of non-work injuries sustained from 1 July 1992 by New Zealanders in paid employment (except self employed who have chosen to insure with a private insurer from 1 July 1999).

The Earners' Account is funded in two ways:

- An earner premium for non-work injuries which occur on or after 1 July 1999; and
- An earner levy for those prior non-work claims, which occurred since 1 July 1992, but before 1 July 1999. This is paid by all earners including those self-employed who have chosen to insure with a private insurer from 1 July 1999.

As required by section 409 of the Accident Insurance Act 1998, A.C.C. has completed consultation with premium payers, and has recommended changes to the earner premium and earner levy to the Minister for Accident Insurance.

A.C.C. has recommended that from 1 April 1999:

- (a) A reduction in earner premium from the current rate of \$1.0756 to \$0.9967 for every \$100 of liable earnings, G.S.T. exclusive; and
- (b) A reduction in earner levy from the current rate of \$0.1689 to \$0.0700 for every \$100 of liable earnings, G.S.T. exclusive.

This results in a 14.3 percent reduction in the total earner premium rate from \$1.40 to \$1.20, G.S.T. inclusive.

 - (b) Over-the-counter poultices.
- 4. Over-the-counter topical anti-inflammatory preparations for the treatment of minor skin irritations, excluding preparations used on the teats of lactating animals used for production of human food products or pharmaceuticals.
- Topically applied non-absorbable insect repellants applied to prevent infestations.

Special Needs Grants Amendment (No. 3)

Pursuant to section 124 (1) (d) of the Social Security Act 1964, I, Roger Morrison Sowry, Minister of Social Services, Work and Income, approve the following amendments to the Special Needs Grant welfare programme (as established and approved by me on 18 December 1998), which are to be read with and considered part of the programme.

Dated the 9th day of September 1999.

HON. ROGER SOWRY, Minister of Social Services, Work and Income.

Amendments

1. Special Assistance for Emergency Relocation Costs

- 1.1 The programme is amended by inserting, after clause 15.4.2, the following clauses:
 - 15.5 Emergency Relocation Costs
 - 15.5.1 Eligibility: This clause applies to an Applicant—
 - (a) whose safety is under an ongoing threat of severe violence from another person; and
 - (b) who has exhausted all other options of relocating within New Zealand to avoid the threat; and
 - (c) who intends to reside in Australia until the threat is averted; and
 - (d) whose application for a Grant is supported by a referral by the Commissioner of Police, or a senior officer of the New Zealand Police with the delegated authority of the Commissioner for the purpose, which confirms the matters set out in paragraphs (a) to (c), and that it is necessary for the Applicant's safety that the Applicant relocate outside New Zealand.
 - 15.5.1 Travel, Set-up, and Living Expenses Grants: Where clause 15.5.1 applies to an Applicant, the chief executive may, subject to clauses 15.5.3, 15.5.8, 15.5.10, and 15.5.11 make the following types of Grants to the Applicant?
 - (a) a non-recoverable Travel Grant to pay for the following costs of relocating the Applicant to Australia:
 - (i) passport fees, as necessary;
 - (ii) New Zealand departure taxes;
 - (iii) economy class airfares for the Applicant;
 - (iv) economy class airfares for any Accompanying Persons:
 - (b) a non-recoverable Set-up Grant up to a maximum of \$5,000.00 for the reasonable set up costs in Australia of the Applicant and any Accompanying Persons, for furniture, rent bonds, and deposits or initial payments for essential services:
 - (c) non-recoverable Living Expenses Grants for the living expenses in Australia of the Applicant and any Accompanying Persons.
 - 15.5.3 Ineligibility for Travel and Set-up Grants:

 Where the Applicant is currently on the New Zealand Witness Protection Programme

- (administered by the New Zealand Police), the Applicant is not eligible for a Travel Grant or a Set-up Grant.
- 15.5.4 Cash Assets not to prevent Grants: Despite clause 8.1, where clause 15.5.1 applies to an Applicant and the Applicant's Cash Assets exceed the appropriate amount in clause 8.3, the chief executive may make Grants in respect of the Applicant under clause 15.5.2.
- 15.5.5 Cash Assets may reduce Grants: Where clause 15.5.4 applies, any Grants under clause 15.5.2 must be reduced by the amount the Applicant's Cash Assets exceed the appropriate Cash Assets limit in clause 8.3.
- 15.5.6 Amount of Living Expenses Grants: The amount of any Living Expenses Grant may be no more than the amount of the Parent Benefit and accommodation supplement that would be payable under the Act in New Zealand to the Applicant and Accompanying Spouse (if any) in respect of the relevant period.
- 15.5.7 Amount of accommodation supplement: For the purpose of calculating the amount of any Living Expenses Grant, the weekly amount of accommodation supplement that would be payable in New Zealand is the amount in paragraph (a) of whichever of clauses 1 to 3 of Part II of the Eighteenth Schedule of the Act is appropriate to the circumstances of the Applicant (other than the Applicant's type of accommodation).
- 15.5.8 Beginning of Living Expenses Grants: No Living Expenses Grant may be made until after the end of any entitlement the Applicant and Accompanying Spouse (if any) have under section 77 of the Act or section 17A of the Social Welfare (Transitional Provisions) Act 1990 to continue to be paid a benefit during his, her, or their absence from New Zealand.
- 15.5.9 Ending of Living Expenses Grants: Living Expenses Grants may be made until the earliest of the following events:
 - (a) the end of the Australian Waiting Period:
 - (b) when the Applicant no longer fulfils the eligibility requirements for the Parent Benefit:
 - (c) if the Applicant leaves Australia.
- 15.5.10 Grants may be recoverable: A Grant made under clause 15.5.2 is recoverable to the extent the chief executive determines that the Grant has not been used for the purpose for which it was made.
- 15.5.11 Acknowledgment required: Before the chief executive makes a Grant under clause 15.5.2, the Applicant must sign a statement acknowledging that he or she understands that—
 - (a) any benefit the Applicant and Accompanying Spouse (if any) is receiving will be cancelled; and
 - (b) the Grant is intended to cover the specific purposes referred to in clause 15.5.2 and no other payments under this programme will be made in respect of the same period or circumstances; and
 - (c) the Travel Grant and Set-up Grant are to enable the Applicant and any Accompanying Persons to travel to and set up in Australia, to avert the threats to the Applicant's safety; and
 - (d) the Applicant is expected to use the Living Expenses Grants for living expenses in Australia

- of the Applicant and any Accompanying Persons, during the period that each Grant covers; and
- (e) any child accompanying the Applicant must be an Eligible Child; and
- (f) a Grant may be recovered from the Applicant if the Grant is not used for the purpose for which it is made; and
- (g) the Applicant and Accompanying Spouse (if any) must notify the chief executive of any change in circumstances that might affect the Applicant's eligibility for the Living Expenses Grants or to the amount of any such Grants.
- 15.5.12 Provisions applying where Applicant is dependent child: If the Applicant is a dependent child,—
 - (a) references to the Applicant in clauses 15.5.6 to 15.5.9, and 15.5.11, and in the definitions "Australian Waiting Period", "Eligible Child", and "Parent Benefit" in clause 15.5.13, are references to the Applicant's Parent (being a Parent who is an Accompanying Person), except where the context otherwise requires; and
 - (b) references to a dependent child include reference to the Applicant, except where the context otherwise requires.
- 15.5.13 Interpretation: For the purposes of clause 15.5—
 - "Accompanying Person" means any of the following persons whom the chief executive is satisfied is accompanying the Applicant to Australia and intends to reside in Australia with the Applicant until the threat to the Applicant's safety is averted, namely—
 - (a) the Applicant's spouse;
 - (b) the Applicant's Eligible Child or children;
 - (c) where the Applicant is a dependent child, the Applicant's Immediate Family,—
 - and "Accompanying Spouse" has a corresponding meaning:
 - "Australian Waiting Period" means the minimum period of time the Applicant must be resident in Australia to be eligible under Australian social security legislation for the allowance, parenting payment, or pension appropriate to the Applicant's circumstances:
 - "Eligible Child", in relation to an Applicant, means a dependent child of the Applicant, whom the Applicant is legally entitled to remove from New Zealand for a period of not less than the period the Applicant intends to remain in Australia:
 - "Living Expenses Grant" means a Grant under clause 15.5.2 (c):
 - "Parent Benefit", in relation to an Applicant,—
 - (a) means the income-tested benefit or non-income-tested New Zealand superannuation or veteran's pension to which the Applicant and Accompanying Spouse (if any) would be entitled if the Applicant were living in New Zealand; and
 - (b) includes any orphan's benefit or unsupported childs benefit that would be payable under the Act in New Zealand in respect of an Eligible Child who is the Applicant or an Accompanying Person:

- "Set-up Grant" means a Grant under clause 15.5.2 (b):
- "Travel Grant" means a Grant under clause 15.5.2 (a).

Definitions benefit, chief executive, child, dependent child, income-tested benefit, spouse, Social Security Act 1964, s. 3.

2. Other Amendments

- 2.1 Clause 3.1 of the programme is amended by:
 - (a) omitting paragraph (c) of the definition of the term "Cash Assets", and substituting the following paragraph:
 - (c) money invested with or lent to any bank or other financial institution, or other person;
 - (b) omitting the definition of the term "Health Agency", and substituting the following definition: "Health Agency" means any of—
 - (a) the Minister of Health;
 - (b) the Ministry of Health;
 - (c) a funder within the meaning of the Health and Disability Services Act 1993;
 - (d) a Hospital and Health Service within the meaning of that Act;
 - (e) the Accident Compensation Corporation;
 - (f) an insurer within the meaning of the Accident Insurance Act 1998; or
 - (g) the Secretary of War Pensions in respect of grants or subsidies for Disability Services made under the War Pensions Act 1954 or regulations made under that Act:
- 2.2 The programme is amended by omitting clauses 8.2 and 8.3, and substituting the following clauses:
 - 8.2 An Applicant's Cash Assets include the Cash Assets of his or her Parent if the Applicant is a dependent child.
 - 8.3 The Cash Assets limits referred to in 8.1 are—
 - (a) in the case of an unmarried person, a value equivalent to 4 times the maximum weekly rate of an invalid's benefit under the Act for an unmarried person without a dependent child; and
 - (b) in the case of a married person or a sole parent, a value equivalent to 4 times the maximum weekly rate of an invalid's benefit under the Act for a married couple without a dependent child.

Programme

1. Title and commencement

- 1.1. This programme is called the Special Needs Grant (Citizenship Fees) Programme, and every Grant made under it is called a special needs grant.
- 1.2. This programme comes into effect on 1 September 1999.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1. In this programme, unless the context otherwise requires,—
 - "Act" means the Social Security Act 1964:
 - "Applicant" means a person applying for a Grant under this programme, or, as the case may require, a person on whose behalf an application for a Grant is made:
 - "Chief Executive" means the chief executive of the Department:
 - "Department" means the department for the time being responsible for administration of the Act:
 - "Grant" means a special needs grant under this programme, being the special assistance under it:
 - "Immigrant Child" means any child who, before attaining the age of 18 years, came to New Zealand from Great Britain between 1 January 1949 and 31 December 1954 in accordance with an arrangement between the Government of New Zealand and his or her parents or guardian that the child would live in New Zealand subject to the provisions of Part I of the Child Welfare Amendment Act 1948, but does not include any person who came to New Zealand accompanied by and in the charge of his or her parent or any of his or her relatives:
 - "Ordinarily Resident" has the same meaning as in section 3 of the Act:
 - "Refugee Child" means any child who came to New Zealand as an immigrant pursuant to an arrangement made for that purpose between the Government of New Zealand and the International Refugee Organisation.

3. Objective

3.1. The objective of this programme is to provide assistance to meet the costs of applying for New

Zealand citizenship for persons who immigrated to New Zealand as "Flock House boys" and are ineligible for a waiver of citizenship fees under regulation 14A of the Citizenship Regulations 1978.

4. Application of Social Security Act

- 4.1. Sections 12, 62, 74A, and 84 of the Act apply, with any necessary modifications, to this programme as if a Grant under this programme were a benefit.
- 4.2. Nothing in clause 4.1 limits any other provision of the Act.

5. Eligibility

- 5.1. The Chief Executive may make a Grant to any Applicant who can show, to the satisfaction of the Chief Executive, that—
- 5.1.1. He or she is Ordinarily Resident in New Zealand; and
- 5.1.2. Before attaining the age of 18 years, the Applicant came to New Zealand from Great Britain between 1 January 1949 and 31 December 1954; and
- 5.1.3. The Applicant did so in accordance with an arrangement between the Government of New Zealand and his or her parents or guardian that the child would live in New Zealand; and
- 5.1.4. The arrangement included the transfer of guardianship or full control of the Applicant to the trustees of the Sheep Owners Acknowledgment of Debt to British Seamen Fund in New Zealand; and
- 5.1.5. The Applicant is making an application to be granted New Zealand citizenship under the Citizenship Act 1977.

5.2. No Grant may be made to any person who-

- 5.2.1. Came to New Zealand accompanied by and in the charge of his or her parent or any of his or her relatives; or
- 5.2.2. Was an Immigrant Child or a Refugee Child; or
- 5.2.3. Is not required to pay a fee to apply for citizenship under the Citizenship Regulations 1978.

6. Amount of Grant

6.1. The amount of a Grant is the fee for the time being payable under the Citizenship Regulations 1978 on application for a grant of citizenship under the Citizenship Act 1977.

7. Administration

- 7.1. Every application for a Grant is to be made to the Department of Internal Affairs on a form provided by the Department (as defined in clause 2.1).
- 7.2. Every Grant is to be paid to the Department of Internal Affairs to the credit of the Applicant.

Commodity Levies (Winemaking Grapes) Order

The Commodity Levies (Winemaking Grapes) Order 1998

- 1. It was resolved at the annual general meeting of the New Zealand Grape Growers Council in Auckland on 26 August 1999 that the levy for 2000 vintage remain at 0.75 percent plus G.S.T.
- 2. In accordance with the above order all growers and buyers are advised that the calculation of the levy will be on the following basis:
 - (a) In the case of grapes processed into grape juice or grape juice concentrate before sale, on the basis of a notional price to be determined by the council as per clause 4 (2) of the order. The notional price for the year 2000 vintage is the 75 percent quartile price for the region and variety concerned:
 - (b) In the case of grapes exported from New Zealand by or on behalf of their grower, on the basis of their f.o.b. value (exclusive of G.S.T., if any, and before deduction of any costs or charges):
 - (c) In the case of grapes sold in New Zealand, on the basis of their farm-gate price (exclusive of G.S.T., if any, and before deduction of any costs or charges).

Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 1999

1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

General

The financial statements presented here are for the reporting entity the Community Trust of Southland Group (the group). The group consists of the Community Trust of Southland (the trust), its wholly owned company Southland Community Trust Charities Limited, and the trust's interests in associates. The Community Trust of Southland was formed under the Trustee Banks Restructuring Act 1988, and is incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957.

The financial statements are presented in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993.

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost except that investment assets are stated at valuation.

The accounting policies for trust funds have been modified this year, however as they impact only on the treatment of funds within total trust funds it has no impact on the financial position of the trust. All other policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in the prior year.

Consolidation

The financial statements of the trust's wholly owned company Southland Community Trust Charities Limited are included in the financial statements using the purchase method of consolidation.

Associates

Associates are entities in which the group has significant influence, but not control, over the operating and financial policies. The financial statements include the group's share of the net surplus of associates on an equity accounted basis.

Initial Trust Capital

Following the sale of the group's shares in Trust Bank New Zealand Limited in April 1996 the trustees agreed that the value of the trust at that time should be maintained for the benefit of current and future generations living in the region. For this purpose the trustees agreed that \$158,460,000 would be considered as the "Initial Trust Capital" value of the group, and that this value would be maintained.

Capital Maintenance Reserve

The capital maintenance reserve represents the additional amount necessary to preserve the real value of the initial trust capital allowing for inflation as measured by the consumers price index (all groups).

Grants Maintenance Reserve

While the trustees have adopted a long-term investment strategy, they accept that annual returns from investments are likely to fluctuate from year to year. In recognition of this a grants maintenance reserve has been established. In years when net

income from investments is higher than the level of grants, surplus income will be transferred to this reserve. In years when there is insufficient income to sustain the level of grants, an appropriate amount will be transferred from the grants maintenance reserve to income.

Investments

The group states its equity in investments at market value, and reports realised and unrealised gains or losses on holding these investments in the statement of financial performance. These gains or losses are shown in the statement of financial performance as income from revaluation of investments. The group intends to hold bank deposits until maturity and states these investments at cost.

Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are initially stated at cost and then depreciated on a straight line basis to allocate the cost of an asset, less any residual value, over its useful life. The estimated useful lives of fixed assets are as follows:

Accounts Receivable

The group states these at expected realisable value.

Grants

The group brings these to account when approved by trustees. Unpaid grants are recorded as a liability.

Income Tax

The group provides for income tax on its net income after adjusting for tax accounting differences and any beneficiaries income determinations made pursuant to section OB1 (226) of the Income Tax Act.

Goods and Services Tax

The group is not registered for goods and services tax. The financial statements are prepared so that all components are stated inclusive of G.S.T.

Exposure to currency, interest rate and credit risk arises in the normal course of the fund managers' management of the group's investments. A range of hedging policies are in place whereby the fund managers use derivative financial instruments as a means of managing exposure to fluctuations in foreign exchange rates and interest rates. While these financial instruments are subject to the risk of market rates changing subsequent to acquisition, such changes would generally be offset by opposite effects on the items being hedged.

10. Financial Instruments

General

The group states its investments at balance date at estimated market value. The trustees consider that the fair value of the financial assets is identical to the value in the statement of financial position.

Concentration of Credit Risk

The group has significant funds in trading bank deposits, and in TeNZ Fund units. The group limits risk by spreading the deposits over several trading banks, and the TeNZ Fund's policy of selecting 10 investments in its portfolio also limits the risk. The group has not required collateral or other security to support its financial statements. The group further limits risk through its policy of placing investment funds with 4 separate fund managers, with each fund manager having an investment mandate which requires that they diversify their investments on the group's behalf. The group has sought and obtained the advice of a professional financial adviser prior to making its investment allocation and placement decisions.

Interest Rate Risk

The bank deposits are sensitive to changes in interest rates, as are a proportion of the funds managed by the fund managers. Loans and advances do not carry interest, and therefore do not hold any interest rate risk.
