 - (b) Target species and bycatch species are specified by the way of fishstock codes, being Fishstock Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†; and
 - (c) Methods are specified by way of method codes, being Method Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†.
- 3. Offering a lease of quota in lieu of paying deemed value—(1) Subject to this clause, as from the date this notice comes into effect, any commercial fisherman who, but for section 28ZG of the Fisheries Act 1983, could be required under section 28ZD of that Act to pay the deemed value of any fish that is specified as a bycatch species in this notice may, not later than 15 days after the end of the month in which the fish were taken, by notice in writing, offer the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Fisheries a lease or sub-lease of the right to take fish under any quota held or leased by that commercial fisherman that are specified in the Schedule to this notice as a target species in relation to that bycatch species.
- (2) The ratios specified in the Schedule to this notice are the ratios at which a lease or sublease of quota of the target species may be accepted in relation to the amount of the bycatch species for which the offer of quota is made (e.g. if a fisher could be required to pay deemed value for 1 tonne of Gur 1 and wishes to offer a lease of Fla 1, then the amount that can be offered is 1 tonne \times 0.83 = 0.83 tonnes of Fla 1).

- (3) The bycatch species must have been taken while fishing for the target species using the method or any of the methods specified in the Schedule (e.g. in the case of the above example, the Gur 1 bycatch must have been taken using the method of setnetting).

Mūmū Nunatak 77°27′S, 169°04′E. A nunatak in the north part of Kyle Hills, Ross Island. The feature is 3.22

kilometres west south-west of Towle Point and 0.97 kilometres inland from steep cliffs that form the

north-east edge of the island. The name Mūmū meaning boisterous wind.

Palais Bluff 77°19′S, 166°33′E. An ice-free coastal bluff rising to over 400 metres between the terminus of

Dufek Head 77°37′S, 167°42′E. An ice-covered headland 7.08 kilometres north-east of Tyree Head in south Ross

Island. The headland rises to 620 metres the east side of the terminus of Aurora Glacier.

Scanniello Peak 77°31'S, 168°49'E. A peak which rises to 2200 metres and marks the highest and south-western-most

point of Tekapo Ridge in Kyle Hills, Ross Island.

Chuan Peak 77°29′S, 168°21′E. A peak approximately 2200 metres, located 1.61 kilometres north-east of Barker

Peak in the south part of Giggenbach Ridge, Ross Island.

Inner Crater 77°32′S, 167°10′E. The volcanic feature that embraces the crater within the floor of Main Crater, at the

summit of Mount Erebus, Ross Island. Inner Crater contains an active anorthoclase-phonolite

lava lake.

Side Crater 77°32'S, 167°09'E. A nearly circular crater (approximately 3700 metres) situated at the summit of

Mount Erebus on the south-west crater rim.

Western Crater 77°32'S, 167°07'E. A small circular crater at 3561 metres on the western slope of the summit of

summit crater of Mount Erebus, Ross Island. The ridge is defined by a series of fumarolic ice towers.

Bird Saddle 77°23′S, 166°53′E. The feature is one of three prominent snow saddles on Ross Island, this one at

approximately 800 metres between Mount Bird and Mount Erebus.

Terra Nova Saddle 77°31′S, 167°37′E. The feature is one of three prominent snow saddles on Ross Island, this one at

approximately 1400 metres between Mount Erebus and Mount Terra Nova.
