Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the amendment and has been included to explain its general effect.

The New Zealand (Maximum Residue Limits of Agricultural Compounds) Mandatory Food Standard 1999 ("the MRL Standard 1999") was intended to replace provisions for pesticides and animal remedies contained within Regulation 257 of the Food Regulations 1984. It came into effect on 13 May 1999.

Regulation 257 was not revoked, but if any inconsistency arises between this standard and Regulation 257, the MRL Standard will prevail.

Amendment No. 6 to the MRL Standard 1999 updates provisions for agricultural compounds contained within the MRL Standard 1999.

Amendment No. 6 corrects drafting errors that occurred when amendment No. 5 was issued. As a result, no additional consultation has occurred on this amendment, because the changes it makes were already subject to consultation when Amendment No. 5 was made.

Amendment No. 6 comes into effect 28 days after it is gazetted.

In July 1996, New Zealand and Australia signed an agreement named *The Agreement Between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of Australia Establishing a System for the Establishment of Joint Food Standards*. Most food standards under the agreement apply in Australia and New Zealand.

However, maximum residue limits (MRL) of agricultural compounds are excluded under Article 3 (3) of the agreement due to the different pests and growing conditions between the two countries.

Therefore, this standard applies only to food produced for sale in New Zealand. Conversely, MRL contained within the Australian Food Standards Code apply in Australia only and not in New Zealand.

However, the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Agreement 1996 allows for food produced in New Zealand that complies with New Zealand's legislative requirements to be sold in Australia.

Food standards subject to Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989

Food standards, including this amendment, are subject to the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989. Any person has the right to make a complaint about a food standard to the Regulations Review Committee.

to be officers of the Government of the Dependency while they act as Senior New Zealand Representatives at Scott Base during the period beginning with this appointment and ending with the close of 30 June 2006:

I confer on Michael Patrick Mahon and Kevin Richard Rigarlsford, while they hold office as officers of the Government of the Dependency, all the powers exercisable in New Zealand by a Justice of the Peace, and also the powers exercisable in New Zealand by a Coroner:

Michael Patrick Mahon and Kevin Richard Rigarlsford are to exercise their functions at such places within the Dependency as may be directed by an officer of the Government of the Dependency who has the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws in force in the Dependency.



Approval of Flashing or Revolving Amber Beacons

Pursuant to Regulation 67 (8) of the Traffic Regulations 1976, I, John Andrew Justice, Principal Engineer, Land Transport Safety Authority, hereby approve the fitting of not more than 2 flashing or revolving amber beacons to the vehicles specified in Schedule 1 of this notice, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2.

Definition

For the purpose of this notice, a beacon is a warning lamp comprising one light source, emitting a flashing or revolving amber beam of light. A beacon may also comprise additional light sources for purposes other than emitting a flashing or revolving amber beam of light. Any such additional light sources are not covered by this approval and must therefore comply with all applicable requirements of the Traffic Regulations 1976 and the Transport (Vehicle Standards) Regulations 1990.

Schedule 1

Approved vehicles:

Vehicles operated by Works Infrastructure Limited that are configured in such a way as to prevent a single flashing or revolving amber light from being visible to all road users in all directions.

Schedule 2

Conditions:

- (i) The beacon(s) must be fitted to the vehicle so as to ensure maximum visibility to other road users.
- (ii) The beacon(s) must be fitted so that the direction of the light emitted is approximately parallel to the ground.
- (iii) The beacon(s) must emit a consistent cycle of amber light with a frequency of 2 to 4 Hertz.
- (iv) The beacon(s) must have incandescent light sources and the maximum wattage of each light source must not exceed 70 Watts.
- (v) The beacon(s) may be operated only while the vehicle and the vehicle's operator are in performance of their duties, and only for the purpose of indicating to other road users the presence of a potential hazard relevant to the operation of the vehicle.
- (vi) The beacon(s) must be switched off as soon as the vehicle and the vehicle's operator have finished performing their duties, or as soon as the hazard for the operator or other road users is no longer present.

- (vii) Unless traffic is under the control of a police officer, adequate warning signs shall be erected as soon as practicable in advance of any hazard indicated by the beacon(s).
- (viii) A copy of this notice must be carried in the vehicle at all times and must be readily available for inspection.
