- (vi) Before any building or structure is erected or any earthworks are carried out on the fill area, the owner shall submit plans and specifications in respect of same in commercial confidence to Transit New Zealand for its approval, such approval not to be unreasonably or arbitrarily withheld where:

*Notes to the Consolidated Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 2002***1. Statement of Accounting Policies****1.1 Reporting Entity**

Eastern and Central Community Trust Inc. is a charitable trust incorporated in accordance with the provisions of the Community Trusts Act 1999.

The trust has a wholly owned company – Eastern & Central Community Trust Charities Limited – which is registered under the Companies Act 1993.

The consolidated financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993.

1.2 Measurement Base

The measurement base applied is that of historical cost adjusted for the market valuation of investments.

1.3 Specific Accounting Policies

The following are the particular accounting policies which have a material effect on the measurement of results and financial position.

1.3.1 Basis of Consolidation

The consolidated financial statements include the trust and its wholly owned company accounted for using the purchase method. All significant inter-entity transactions are eliminated on consolidation. Both entities have a common balance date of 31 March.

1.3.2 Investment Income is accounted for on an accruals basis recognising both realised and unrealised gains or losses in value.

1.3.3 Foreign Currency balances are converted to NZD at the year end rate of exchange unless covered by a forward exchange contract. Where such contracts are in place, the contracted rate is adopted. Transactions completed during the year are converted at the rate applying at the approximate date of the transaction. Foreign exchange gains and losses are included within the statement of financial performance.

1.3.4 Investments are recorded at market value at year-end.

1.3.5 Cash comprises cash at bank, call deposits and short-term deposits but does not include cash held by fund managers.

1.3.6 Donations are recognised as a liability of the trust when they are approved by trustees and notified to applicants notwithstanding that the applicants may still have to fulfil some conditions.

1.3.7 Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

1.3.8 Depreciation is provided on a straight line basis on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to allocate the assets' cost less estimated residual value over their estimated useful lives.

The depreciation periods are:

Computer equipment	three years
Fixtures and fittings	nine years
Furniture	ten years
Office equipment	five years

1.3.9 Income tax expense recognises the obligation payable to the Inland Revenue Department.

1.3.10 G.S.T. inclusive accounting has been adopted, as the trust is not registered for G.S.T.

1.4 Changes in Accounting Policies

Taxation has been provided for the first time this year. The provision of \$193,770 has increased the net deficit for the year and increased current liabilities. There have been no other changes in accounting policies. All policies have been consistently applied.

1.5 Changes in Presentation

The reporting of donations has been reclassified as a distribution from equity and disclosed in the statement of movements in equity. Previously the donations were recorded in the statement of financial performance. Comparative figures have also been reclassified to enable proper comparison.

Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 2002**1. Statement of Accounting Policies****General Accounting Policies**

The following general accounting policies have been adopted in the preparation of the financial statements.

- (i) The Community Trust was incorporated as a charitable trust in accordance with the provisions of Community Trusts Act 1999. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable financial reporting standards.
- (ii) Community Trust Charities Limited is a charitable company incorporated under the Companies Act 1993 and is a reporting entity for the purposes of the Financial Reporting Act 1993. The financial reports of Community Trust Charities Limited have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993.
- (iii) Canterbury Trust House Limited was incorporated on 18 December 1995 under the Companies Act 1993. Canterbury Trust House Limited is a reporting entity for the purposes of the Financial Reporting Act 1993. The financial statements of Canterbury Trust House Limited have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993.
- (iv) The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost, except for the revaluation of investments. Reliance is placed on the fact that the trust is a going concern.
- (v) The matching of revenue earned and expenses incurred using accrual accounting concepts.

Specific Accounting Policies**Depreciation**

Depreciation has been charged in the financial statements using rates allowed by the Inland Revenue Department which will write off the cost of assets less their estimated residual value over their estimated economic lives.

The depreciation rates used are:

Office equipment	6-60% c.p.
Furniture and fittings	14-40% d.v.
Computer	28-48% d.v

Fixed Assets and Investment Property

Fixed assets and investment property are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Investments

Investments are shown at market value. Net income including realised and unrealised gains or losses from holding or trading these investments is recorded in the statement of financial performance.

Donations

Donations are accounted for on a cash basis.

Dividend Income

Dividend income is included in the statement of financial performance when it is received.

Income Tax

Income tax expense is recognised on the surplus available for distribution before taxation, adjusting for differences between taxable and accounting income.

Goods and Services Tax

The subsidiary of Community Trust Charities Limited, Canterbury Trust House Limited, is registered for G.S.T. Accordingly, its financial performance and financial position have been consolidated within the accounts on a G.S.T. exclusive basis.

Subject to the above, the trust is not registered for G.S.T. purposes and therefore, the financial statements have been prepared on a G.S.T. inclusive basis.

Financial Instruments

Foreign currency transactions are translated to New Zealand currency at the exchange rate ruling at the dates of the transactions. Amounts receivable and payable in foreign currencies at balance date are translated at the exchange rate at that date. Exchange differences arising from the translation of amounts payable and receivable in foreign currencies are recognised in the statement of financial performance.

Off-balance sheet financial instruments that are designated as hedges are recognised on the same basis as the underlying hedged item. Off-balance sheet transactions that do not constitute specific hedges are stated at market value and any resultant gain or loss is recognised in the statement of financial performance.

Cash

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash comprises WestpacTrust balances only. Cash excludes bank deposits not used as part of the trust's day-to-day cash management.

Basis of Consolidation

The Community Trust, Community Trust Charities Limited and its subsidiaries, Canterbury Trust House Limited, Amateur Game or Sport Promoter Limited and District Improvement Organisation Limited, have been consolidated using the purchase method of consolidation.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used last year.

Statement of Notes to the Accounts

1. Statement of Accounting Policies

Reporting Entity

TSB Community Trust is a charitable trust formed by a trust deed dated 30 May 1988. A new trust deed was adopted by the trust on 8 February 2001. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with this deed and the Community Trusts Act 1999.

Measurement Base

The measurement base is that of historical cost.

Specific Accounting Policies

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and financial position have been applied.

Specific Accounting Policies

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value.

Investments

The TSB Bank Limited shares are stated at the value when gifted: 20,000,000 fully paid shares at 50 cents each, representing \$10,000,000. The net asset backing at 31 March 2002 was \$5.63 per share.

Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are recorded at cost, office equipment will be depreciated on a straight line basis over four years.

Income Tax

The income tax expense charged to the statement of income includes both the current year's provision and the income tax effects of timing differences calculated using the liability method.

Tax effect accounting is applied on a comprehensive basis to all timing differences. A debit balance in the deferred tax account, arising from timing differences or income tax benefits from income tax losses, is only recognised if there is virtual certainty of realisation.

Financial Instruments

The financial instruments are recorded at their carrying value which is also the fair value of each of the classes of financial instruments consisting of cash, accounts payable, and accounts.

Cashflows

For the purpose of the statement of cashflow, cash includes cash on hand and deposits held on call with banks.

Goods and Services Tax

The financial statements have been prepared on a G.S.T. inclusive basis.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in the previous years.

2. Dividend

The dividend includes \$2,800,000 relating to the final instalment received from the bank for year ended 31 March 2001 and \$785,000 interim dividend for the year ended 31 March 2002.

3. Financial Instruments

Financial instruments that potentially have credit risk are cash, accrued interest and accrued charges.

The maximum credit risk exposure at balance date is the carrying value of bank, accrued interest and accrued charges. This is also the fair value.

4. Income Tax

The company has income tax losses of \$309,077 (2001 – \$263,880) available to be carried forward and set off against future assessable income.

5. Commitments and Contingent Liabilities

At balance date, \$523,800 has been approved for donations in the 2002/2003 financial year (2001 – \$764,800).
