The following notice is given pursuant to sections 50 (1) and 50 (5) of the Public Trust Act 2001 ("the Act").

**Notice**

**1. Title and commencement**—This notice may be cited as the Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 25 July 2002.

(2) The determinations and revocation notified in this notice take effect from and including 22 July 2002.

**2. Interpretation**—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires:

"agency deposit" means a deposit (not being an investment deposit) held as agent or attorney;

"call deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a special deposit or a trust deposit) held in the ordinary course of administration, and determined by Public Trust to be held at call;

"deposit" means a sum of money held by Public Trust belonging to any estate, which money for the time being forms part of the Common Fund;

"investment deposit" means a deposit held at call or otherwise as an investment under section 51 of the Act;

"special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;

"trust deposit" means a deposit held on trust:

- (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
- (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
- (iii) otherwise than at call (not being a special deposit).

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

**3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit (other than an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposit.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate term and dollar range.

(3) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.

(4) Despite subparagraph (1), in particular cases or classes of case, Public Trust and the depositor may agree on a rate of interest payable on a special deposit that is different from the rate specified in Schedule 1 and the agreed rate then applies.

**4. Revocation of notice and transitional provisions**—(1) The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 11 July 2002 is revoked.

(2) The rates of interest specified in Schedule 1 to this notice do not apply to any period that ends with 21 July 2002 but otherwise operate as from 22 July 2002.

(3) The rates of interest specified in Schedule 2 to this notice:

- (i) do not apply to investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term that commenced prior to 22 July 2002; but

- (ii) do apply to investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term that commenced on or after 22 July 2002.

4. 5. The council shall have full power and authority to lay, construct, alter, cleanse, extend, repair, maintain, remove and replace any drains, pipes, concrete or other conduits, manholes, valves, surface boxes or other plant and water systems (“the works”) to enable it to perform the easements provided that the council shall at all times ensure that the works in place are adequate to cater for its drainage requirements from time to time and provided that the works relating to the water and drainage easements shall be laid underground.

6. The council shall have full power and authority for itself, its surveyors, engineers, workmen, agents and servants with or without any drain diggers, vehicles and machinery from time to time and at all times to enter and remain on the land for any purpose necessary to carry out the terms of the easement.

7. The council may from time to time dig up to any depth and again fill in the soil of the right of way line, the drainage line and the water line to enable it to complete the works.

8. (a) Maintenance and the cost of maintenance in respect to the “Right of Way” easement shall be determined in accordance with the Ninth Schedule of the Property Law Act 1952.

- The council shall, together with any other users of the water and water drainage easements, share the repair and maintenance of the works and water and water drainage. The cost of carrying out any repair and maintenance shall be borne by the users of the easements according to their share of usage, provided that the council will maintain at its cost any works solely for its purposes.

In carrying out any works or repairs and maintenance, the council will cause as little disturbance to the surface of the right of way line, the drainage line and the water line as reasonably possible and will immediately upon completion of any such work restore the surface of the right of way line, the drainage line and water line as nearly as possible to its original condition.

9. The council will repair any damage to fences, drains or other improvements in the vicinity of the land caused by the council carrying out the works.

10. The owner shall not place any buildings, erect fences or other permanent structures on the right of way line, the drainage line and the water line without prior consent of the council, and will not at any time commit or suffer any acts whereby the rights, powers, licences and liberties hereby granted may be interfered with or affected.

11. Nothing contained or implied by this easement shall be deemed to compel the council to drain or convey water along the drainage line or water line.

12. Any rights, powers or remedies which the council may have or be entitled to by virtue of statute or at common

law shall not be affected by the easements and the council may exercise any such other powers vested in it at common law or by statute independently of these grants of easement.

13. If a party has a dispute with the other party in connection with these easements, that party will promptly give full written particulars of the dispute to the other. If the dispute is not resolved within 14 days of written particulars being given (or any longer agreement agreed to by the parties), the dispute shall be referred to arbitration which shall be conducted in accordance with the rules in Schedules 1 and 2 of the Arbitration Act 1996.

14. The council indemnifies the registered proprietor of the land from time to time against all losses or damages arising from any acts or omissions of the council, its contractors, workmen, employees and other agents in carrying out the terms of these easements except to the extent caused or contributed to be the registered proprietors of the land or its agents, employees or invitees.

**Notes to the Consolidated Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 2002****Basis of Preparation**

These are the consolidated financial statements of The Community Trust of Otago, Otago Community Trust Charities Limited, The Community Trust Amateur Sports Co Limited, The Community Trust District Improvement Co Limited and Fillmor House Limited. The Community Trust of Otago was incorporated as a charitable trust in accordance with the provisions of the Community Trusts Act 1999.

The financial statements have been prepared to comply with the Financial Reporting Act 1993 and comprise consolidated statements of the following: Financial performance, movement in trust funds, financial position, cashflows, as well as notes to these financial statements.

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost, except for the revaluation of managed funds.

**Specific Accounting Policies****Income**

Income from managed funds includes both realised and unrealised income and is recorded gross of fund management expenses.

Interest is recognised on an accrual basis.

**Donations**

Donations are accounted for as they are distributed.

**Foreign Currencies**

All amounts denominated in foreign currencies are converted to New Zealand dollars at balance date. All realised and unrealised gains and losses are recognised in the statement of financial performance.

**Taxation**

Income tax is recognised on the surplus after distribution, adjusting for differences between taxable and accounting income.

Future tax benefits are not recognised unless realisation of the asset is virtually certain.

**Fixed Assets**

Fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

**Depreciation**

Depreciation has been charged to the financial statement using rates which will write off the cost of assets less their estimated residual value over their estimated economic lives. The depreciation rates used are:

Buildings	4%
Office furniture and equipment	12-48%

**G.S.T.**

Subsidiaries of The Community Trust of Otago, Fillmor House Limited and The Community Trust District Improvement Company Limited are registered for G.S.T.

Accordingly, their financial performance and financial position have been consolidated within the accounts on a G.S.T. exclusive basis.

Subject to the above, the trust is not registered for G.S.T. purposes and, therefore, the financial statements have been prepared on a G.S.T. inclusive basis.

**Basis of Consolidation**

The Community Trust of Otago, Otago Community Trust Charities Limited, Fillmor House Limited, The District Improvement Company Limited and The Community Trust Amateur Sports Company Limited have been consolidated using the purchase method of consolidation.

**Capital Maintenance Reserve**

The capital maintenance reserve represents the additional amount necessary to preserve the real value of the capital allowing for inflation as measured by the Consumers' Price Index (C.P.I.).

**Investments**

Investments are valued at year end market value. All realised and unrealised gains and losses are recognised in the statement of financial performance.

**Hedging Instruments**

The trust through its investment managers enters into hedging instruments such as futures, options and forward exchange contracts. These are converted to the New Zealand dollar rate at balance date with all realised and unrealised gains and losses being recognised in the statement of financial performance as income from managed funds.

**Statement of Cashflows**

Cash comprises cash at bank and call deposits but does not include cash or deposits held by the fund managers.

**Financial Instruments**

Financial instruments all relate to cash, accounts receivable and accounts payable, and all revenues and expenses relating to these are recognised in the statement of financial performance in the period that any gain or loss becomes certain.

Cash and investments are stated at cost. Receivables are stated at net realisable value.

Payables are stated at amounts owed to those entities at balance date.

The maximum exposure to credit risk is represented by the carrying value of each of the financial assets and liabilities in the statement of financial position.

**Income Tax**

Income tax expense is recognised on the surplus available for distribution before taxation, adjusting for differences between taxable and accounting income.

**Changes in Accounting Policies**

There have been no changes in accounting policies during this accounting period.

**Changes in Comparative Figures**

Where applicable, certain comparatives have been restated to comply with the accounting presentation adopted for the current period.
