"Part 6A

Special assistance to affected residents of Waihi

18A.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Part is to assist affected people in Waihi to move from their homes because of identified high or medium risk that the homes are at risk of land subsidence.

18A.2 Interpretation

In this Part, unless the context otherwise requires,—

"home", in relation to a person, means a unit of residential accommodation, including a caravan, in which that person normally or habitually lives, whether or not the person has any estate or interest in the land on which that unit is located.

"report" means the report of the Waihi Underground Mine Workings Technical Working Party to the Hauraki District Council dated 22 August 2002 on the subject of Risk Assessment Report on Ground Collapse Events above abandoned mine workings in the Town of Waihi, Hauraki District.

18A.3 Grants for relocation assistance

- (1) Subclause (2) applies to an applicant—
 - (a) whose home is located in the Town of Waihi in any of the areas identified in the report as high or medium hazard zones within the Royal and Empire Lode areas; and
 - (b) who has decided, or in respect of whom a decision has been made, or who is required by law, to move from that home to accommodation located elsewhere, in reliance on the advice in the report.

- (2) The chief executive may make one or more grants to an applicant to whom this subclause applies for any of the following purposes:
 - (a) The cost of temporary accommodation immediately after the applicant moves from the home:
 - (b) The cost of moving and storing on a temporary basis, the household effects and personal possessions of the applicant:
 - (c) The reasonable costs (including any bond, rent in advance, and connection fees and deposits required for services such as electricity, gas, telephone, and water supply) incurred by the applicant of moving into permanent rental or other accommodation:
 - (d) Counselling services.
- (3) The amount of any grant under subclause (2) is at the discretion of the chief executive, but the maximum amount of grants that may be made to an applicant under that subclause is \$1,500.00, unless the chief executive considers that exceptional circumstances exist.
- (4) If an applicant receives a grant of special assistance under any other provision of this programme, or under any other welfare programme approved under section 124 (1) (d) of the Act, the maximum amount in subclause (3) must be reduced by the amount of that special assistance if—
 - (a) that grant was made for any of the purposes for which grants may be made under subclause (2); and
 - (b) the chief executive is satisfied that the event that gave rise to that grant was the event referred to in subclause (1) (b).
- (5) A grant under subclause (2) is non-recoverable."

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the amendment, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This amendment allows non-recoverable special needs grants for relocation assistance to be made to residents of Waihi who move from homes that have been identified as being at high or medium risk of land subsidence.

Insurance Companies (Ratings and Inspections) Act 1994

Change of Rating—Royal & SunAlliance Group

Pursuant to clause 8 (1) of the Insurance Companies (Ratings and Inspections) Act 1994, ratings agency Standard & Poor's has changed the international Royal & SunAlliance Group's ("the Group") "financial strength" rating to "A" on 20 August 2002.

This is one rung lower than its previous rating of "A+", and moves the company from the top of the "strong" range to the middle of the "strong" range.

This new rating applies to each of Royal & Sun Alliance Insurance (New Zealand) Limited, Royal & Sun Alliance Liability Insurance Limited, and Royal & Sun Alliance Accident Insurance Limited.

This action follows the re-grading of United Kingdom-based Royal & SunAlliance Group PLC following a decline in their capital levels which reflects the recent upheavals in the investment markets.

Standard & Poor's states, in relation to our parent company, that "an accumulation of pressures over the past three years has reduced capital adequacy to adequate levels in 2002, from very strong levels in 1999.

Royal & SunAlliance has made good progress toward its internal target of raising £800 million (\$1.22 billion) of capital, but weak investment markets during 2002 have hindered the capital-rebuilding program.

Royal & SunAlliance is, however, continuing to pursue a number of alternative sources of capital in order to be in a position to fully leverage its competitive market position."

In the Standard & Poor's report, it was noted that an accelerated improvement in reported earnings is expected during the second half of 2002 and that Royal & SunAlliance's rating reflects the Group's excellent global market position in general insurance and an improving earnings outlook.

Nurses Act 1977

Order of the Nursing Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of a Registered Compehensive Nurse

After due inquiry and in exercise of powers under sections 42 (1) (b), 42 (2) (b) (a), 42 (3) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("the council"),

in a decision dated 24 June 2002, found registered comprehensive nurse **Graeme Bramwell Pollock** guilty of professional misconduct on the grounds that **Graeme Bramwell Pollock**'s conduct brings or is likely to bring discredit on the nursing profession.

The council ordered that **Graeme Bramwell Pollock** only practise under supervision for a period of one full year from the date he recommences working as a registered comprehensive nurse and that he pay \$6,320.00

(being 40%) towards the actual costs and expenses of and incidental to the investigation and prosecution by the preliminary proceedings committee and inquiry by the council. It also ordered that a notice stating the effect of these orders be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, *Kai Tiaki: Nursing New Zealand* and the nursing council's newsletter.

Statement of Significant Accounting Policies for the Year Ended 31 March 2002

A. Basis of Preparation

The Community Trust of Southland was formed under the Trustee Banks Restructuring Act 1988 and is incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957. The financial statements presented are those for The Community Trust of Southland Group ("the group"). The group consists of The Community Trust of Southland ("the trust"), its wholly owned subsidiary company Southland Community Trust Charities Limited and the trust's interests in associates.

The financial statements comply with the Financial Reporting Act 1993 and the Community Trusts Act 1999. They comprise statements of the following: significant accounting policies, financial performance, movements in trust funds, financial position, cash flows, as well as notes to these statements.

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost except that investment assets are stated at valuation.

B. Consolidation Method

The financial statements of the trust's wholly owned company Southland Community Trust Charities Limited are included in the financial statements using the purchase method of consolidation.

C. Associates

Associates are entities in which the group has significant influence, but not control over the operating and financial policies. The financial statements include the group's share of the net surplus of associates on an equity accounted basis.

D. Trust Capital

Following the sale of the group's shares in Trust Bank New Zealand Limited in April 1996 for \$158,460,000, the trustees agreed that the value of the trust at that time should be maintained for the benefit of current and future generations living in the region. For this purpose, the trustees agreed that \$158,460,000 would be considered as the "trust capital" value of the group and that this value would be maintained.

E. Capital Maintenance Reserve

The capital maintenance reserve represents the additional amount necessary to preserve the real value of the trust capital allowing for inflation as measured by the Consumers Price Index (all groups) and payments of grants out of capital.

F. Grants Maintenance Reserve

While the trustees have adopted a long-term investment strategy, they accept that annual returns from investments are likely to fluctuate from year to year. In recognition of this, a grants maintenance reserve is maintained. In years when net income from investments is higher than the grant levels, surplus income will be transferred to this reserve. In years when there is insufficient income to sustain the level of grants, an appropriate amount will be transferred from the grants maintenance reserve to income.

G. Basis of Recognising Components of the Financial Statements

The following general accounting policies are adopted:

Assets

A transaction results in an asset being recognised in the statement of financial position when it will probably give rise to ongoing benefits for the group and those benefits can be measured with reliability.

Liabilities

A transaction results in a liability being recognised in the statement of financial position when it will probably give rise to the need for the group to sacrifice assets in the future and those sacrifices can be measured with reliability.

Revenue

Revenue is recognised in the statement of financial performance when a transaction gives rise to an increase in the value of the group's net assets and that increase can be measured with reliability.

Expenses

An expense is recognised in the statement of financial performance when a transaction results in a decrease in the value of the group's net assets and that decrease can be measured with reliability.

Classification of Assets and Liabilities Between Current and Non-current

An amount is classified as current when it is expected to be settled or extinguished within one year of the date of the financial statements. All other amounts are classified as non-current.

H Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are initially stated at cost and then depreciated on a straight line basis. The estimated useful lives of fixed assets are as follows:

I. Investments

Investments are stated at market value and report realised and unrealised gains or losses on holding these investments in the statement of financial performance. These gains or losses are shown in the statement of financial performance as income from revaluation of investments.

J. Accounts Receivable

Accounts receivable are stated at expected realisable value.

K. Grants

Grants are recognised when they are approved by the trustees. Unpaid grants are recorded as a liability.

L. Goods and Services Tax

The group is not registered for goods and services tax. The financial statements are prepared using G.S.T. inclusive accounting.

M. Income Taxation

The group provides for income tax on its net income after adjusting for tax accounting differences and any beneficiaries' income determinations made pursuant to section OB1 (226) of the Income Tax Act 1994.

N. Statement of Cash Flows

Operating cash flows includes interest and dividends paid or credited to investment funds under management and any upward or downward revaluation of funds during the period. Cash movements in funds invested are recognised in investing activities.

O. Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies have been consistently applied by the group and are consistent with those of the previous year.

14. Financial Instruments

General

The group states its investments at balance date at estimated market value. The trustees consider that the fair value of the financial assets is identical to the value in the statement of financial position.

Concentration of Credit Risk

The group, from time to time, has significant funds in trading bank deposits. The group limits risk by spreading the deposits over several trading banks. The group has not required collateral or other security to support its financial statements.

The group further limits risk through its policy of placing investment funds with five separate fund managers, with each fund manager having an investment mandate which requires that they diversify their investments on the group's behalf. The group has sought and obtained the advice of professional financial advisers prior to making its investment allocation and placement decisions.

Interest Rate Risk

The bank deposits are sensitive to changes in interest rates, as are a proportion of the funds managed by the fund managers, and the loans to Topoclimate South Trust and the Southland Outdoor Stadium Trust.

15. Capital Commitments

Commitments of \$5,443,724 exist for grants which will be distributed from either capital or future income sources in future years. These grants have not been recorded in either the statements of financial performance or financial position. Specific commitments are as follows:
