Requirements for the Retention of Evidence

Section 164C (1) of the Land Transfer Act 1952 requires any person who is giving a certification under the Act to retain evidence showing the truth of that certification. That evidence must be held for the period prescribed in Regulations made under the Land Transfer Act. Section 164C (2) allows the Registrar-General of Land to specify the requirements that will satisfy the obligation imposed under section 164C (1). Without limiting what may be considered adequate to show the truth of the certifications given, the Registrar-General of Land considers that the person giving a certification may satisfy the obligation under section 164C by keeping:

- written confirmation from the party specified in the Regulations in relation to each instrument that the person giving the certification is authorised to act for them.
- documentation to show how the person giving the certification ascertained that the person who gave the authority to act had the legal capacity to give that authority. This means that the person giving the certification must take reasonable steps to assess that the person giving authority was not a minor and was of sound mind, and document the basis for that assessment. The nature of this assessment is similar to that required of an attesting witness to a paper transaction where further proof of execution is required under Regulation 16 of the Land Transfer Regulations 2002. If the person giving authority was a corporate, then the person giving the certification must be satisfied that the relevant constitution or rules have been complied with.
- documentation showing how the person giving the certification confirmed the identity of the person who gave the authority to act.
- documentation to show that the specified statutory requirements were considered and where necessary, documentation is held to show that applicable statutory requirements have been complied with.

The New Zealand Law Society Guidelines and associated form(s) are accepted by the Registrar-General of Land as being an adequate means of satisfying these requirements.

ACC Board Levy Recommendations for 2003/04 Following Consultation

The ACC Board has recommended to the Minister for ACC a number of changes to the levy rates for the 2003/04 levy year. The recommended rates reflect:

- the latest claims experience;
- recent cost trends in each scheme; and
- submissions received as part of the public consultation process.

The ACC Board's recommendations are not binding on the Minister, who will obtain further advice from officials and actuaries. She may accept, reject or modify the Corporation's recommendations.

All ACC Board recommendations noted below are excluding G.S.T. except where indicated. The ACC Board recommendations for levy payer groups can be summarised as follows:

Employers'

The employers' composite average levy rate decreases 4% from \$1.20 to \$1.15 per \$100 of payroll, comprising of:

- the average employers (workers compensation) levy rate reduces from \$0.85 to \$0.84 per \$100 of payroll and the 550 levy classification units are grouped into 130 risk groups.
- the average residual claims (injuries prior to July 1999) levy rate reduces from \$0.35 to \$0.31 per \$100 of payroll and the 550 levy classification units are grouped into 41 risk groups.

Self-employed

The self-employed composite average levy rates decreases 1% from \$3.17 to \$3.13 per \$100 of liable earnings, comprising of:

- the average self-employed (workers compensation) levy rate remains unchanged at \$1.75 per \$100 of liable earnings and the 550 levy classification units are grouped into 130 risk groups.
- the average residual claims (injuries prior to July 1999) levy rate reduces from \$0.35 to \$0.31 per \$100 of liable earnings and the 550 levy classification units are grouped into 41 risk groups.
- the self-employed earners (non-work injuries) levy rate remains unchanged at \$1.20 (G.S.T. inclusive) per \$100 of earnings.

Earners' (non-work injuries)

That the levy rate remains unchanged at \$1.20 (G.S.T. inclusive) per \$100 of earnings.

Motor Vehicle (injuries involving motor vehicles)

That the composite average levy rate (including the petrol excise duty) increases by 25% from the current \$169.67 to \$211.95 per vehicle.

That the ACC portion of the annual motor vehicle licence fee remains unchanged at \$141.10 per standard petrol-powered vehicle.

That the petrol excise duty increases from 2.3 cents per litre to 5.08 cents per litre.

That the motor vehicle classification system is retained with the following changes:

- That the motor cycle levy differential increases from 150% to 200% of the rate for standard vehicles. At the 200% differential, motor cycle owners would only be funding approximately 18% of the full funded costs of injuries to motor cyclists and/or their passengers.
- That each trade plate type be included in the classification which matches the vehicle type covered.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit (other than an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposit.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate term and dollar range.

(3) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.
