- A. the member is guilty of conduct unbecoming an accountant; and
- B. the member is in breach of the institute's code of ethics, specifically FP1, FP5, EP13 and EP14.

IN THAT

- The member used his then employer's funds for personal expenses, including the purchase of tyres and English pounds.
- The member misapplied money paid by another employee for a vehicle purchased from his then employer, and applied the money towards the payment of a vehicle purchased by himself from his then employer.
- The member transferred funds from his then employer's account to his personal account, as reimbursement for payment he alleged had been made by himself for training courses, when he had neither paid for nor attended such training courses.

The tribunal found the member guilty as charged with the exception of a breach of EP14, and the particulars proven.

*Orders of the Tribunal:*

- (a) Pursuant to Rule 21.31 (c) of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Christopher James King** pay a monetary penalty of \$5,000.00.

- (b) Pursuant to Rule 21.33 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Mathew James Arcus** pay to the institute the sum of \$1,692.00 (inclusive of G.S.T.) in respect of the costs and expenses of the hearing before the disciplinary tribunal and the investigation by the professional conduct committee.

The tribunal considered that the member's conviction for the above offence reflected on his integrity and that it was not in the interests of the public or the institute for him to remain as a member.

In accordance with Rule 21.35 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal directed that the decision be published in *The Dominion Post*, the *New Zealand Gazette* and the *Chartered Accountants Journal of New Zealand* with mention of the member's name and locality.

*Right of Appeal:*

Pursuant to Rule 21.41 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand which were in force at the time of the original notice of complaint, the member may, not later than 14 days after the notification of this tribunal to the member of the exercise of its powers, appeal in writing to the appeals council of the institute against the decision.

No decision, other than the direction as to publicity, shall take effect while the member remains entitled to appeal or while any such appeal by the member awaits determination by the appeals council.

- (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
- (iii) otherwise than at call (not being a special deposit).

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

**3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit (other than an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposit.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate term and dollar range.

#### Commodity Levies (Milksolids) Order

##### Commodity Levies (Milksolids) Order 2003

Below is the commodity levy rate as set by the board of Dairy InSight on 16 April 2003:

1. Dairy farmers and collection agents are advised that the levy rate for the 1 June 2003 to 31 May 2004 season has been set at 3.4 cents per kilogram of milksolids (plus G.S.T.).
2. A “dairy farmer” means:
  - (a) a person whose business is or includes producing milksolids from bovine animals for supply to a dairy company; and
  - (b) includes a dairy farm owner, a dairy farm leaseholder, and a sharemilker.
3. A dairy farmer who produces milksolids is primarily responsible for paying the levy on it.
4. A “collection agent” means:
  - (a) a dairy company whose business is or includes buying milksolids from a dairy farmer; or
  - (b) a person whose business is or includes buying milksolids from a dairy farmer for supply directly or indirectly to a dairy company.
5. A collection agent who buys milksolids from a dairy farmer (except through another collection agent):
  - (a) must pay the levy on the milksolids; and
  - (b) may recover the levy (and any G.S.T. paid in respect of it) from the dairy farmer:
    - (i) by deducting the amount of the levy from the payment made to the dairy farmer for the milksolids; or
    - (ii) by recovering the amount of the levy as a debt due from the dairy farmer.
  - (c) If subclause 5 (b) (i) applies, the collection agent must provide the dairy farmer with information regarding the amount of levy deducted.
