Disciplinary Tribunal of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand—Notice of Decision (Member Guilty of Conduct Unbecoming an Accountant and Breaching the Code of Ethics)

At a hearing of the Disciplinary Tribunal of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand held on the 8th and 9th days of October 2003, at which the member was present and represented by counsel, the tribunal recorded that **Terry Gerard Spekreijse**, chartered accountant of Christchurch, pleaded not guilty to the following charges and did not admit the following particulars:

THAT in terms of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand Act 1996 and the Rules made thereunder, and in particular Rule 21.30, **Terry Gerard Spekreijse** has been guilty of:

- misconduct in a professional capacity; and/or
- conduct unbecoming an accountant; and/or
- breach of the institute's code of ethics, specifically Fundamental Principles 1 and 5 and Ethical Provisions 13 and 43.

IN THAT

- In the course of his practice as a chartered accountant, **Terry Gerard Spekreijse**:
 - (a) retained accounting fees belonging to his firm to the value of \$108,720.00;
 - (b) falsified invoices on his firm's letterhead directing his firm's clients to pay him directly for his own personal gain;
 - (c) transferred client funds from his firm's trust account without authority to do so, including payments to an overseas bank account, on account of another person of \$77,694.00;
 - (d) made six payments via his firm's trust account from a client ledger either to himself via cheques or to another person;
 - (e) retained for his own personal use fees for the audit of a client for the years 2000-2002 when the audit report was signed on behalf of his firm;
 - (f) subsequently substituted the audit reports referred to above with replacements signed in his name, when his firm was the appointed auditor; and

- (g) misled his firm's clients and misused client funds.

The tribunal found all the particulars to be proven, subject to the following amendments and exceptions:

- With regard to particular (a), the tribunal found that the member retained fees to the value of approximately \$128,000.00.
- With regard to particular (c), the tribunal found that the member did not have the authority of his partners, but did not find it proven that he did not have client authority.
- With regard to particular (e), the tribunal found the particular proven in relation to the years 2000-2001 but not proven in relation to the year 2002.
- With regard to particular (g), the tribunal found that the member misled his firm's clients, but did not find that he misused client funds.

Having regard to the proven particulars, the tribunal found **Terry Gerard Spekreijse** guilty as charged, with the exception of misconduct in a professional capacity and breach of Ethical Provision 43.

Orders of the Tribunal

Following consideration of evidence and submissions, the tribunal made the following orders:

- (a) Pursuant to Rule 21.31 (b) of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Terry Gerard Spekreijse** be suspended from the institute for a period of two years.
- (b) Pursuant to Rule 21.31 (d) of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Terry Gerard Spekreijse**'s certificate of public practice be suspended for a period of two years.
- (c) Pursuant to Rule 21.31 (g) of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Terry Gerard Spekreijse** engage an advisor or tutor at his own expense.
- (d) Pursuant to Rule 21.33 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal ordered that **Terry Gerard**

Spekreijse pay to the institute the sum of \$30,000.00 (plus G.S.T.) in respect of the costs and expenses of the hearing before the disciplinary tribunal and the investigation by the professional conduct committee.

In accordance with Rule 21.35 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand, the disciplinary tribunal directed that the decision be published in *The Press*, the *New Zealand Gazette* and the *Chartered Accountants Journal of New Zealand* with mention of the member's name and locality.

In reaching its decision, the tribunal considered that the penalties must fit with its findings of fact and determination of guilt, however the tribunal noted it was mindful of the professional environment of the member's former firm and the contribution this had made to his offending.

Right of Appeal

Pursuant to Rule 21.41 of the Rules of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of New Zealand which were in force at the time of the original notice of complaint, the member may, not later than 14 days after the notification of this tribunal to him of the exercise of its powers, appeal in writing to the appeals council of the institute against the decision.

No decision other than the direction as to publicity shall take effect while the member remains entitled to appeal or while any such appeal by the member awaits determination by the appeals council.

ACC Board Levy Recommendations for 2004/05 Following Consultation

The ACC Board has recommended to the Minister for ACC a number of changes to the levy rates for the 2004/05 levy year. The recommended rates reflect:

- submissions received as part of the public consultation process;
- the latest claims experience; and
- recent cost trends in each scheme.

The ACC Board's recommendations are not binding on the Minister, who will obtain further advice from officials and actuaries before making recommendations to Cabinet.

Cabinet is expected to finalise the 2004/05 levy rates by December 2003.

The ACC Board levy recommendations are summarised as follows (G.S.T. exclusive) for every \$100.00 of earnings (except Motor Vehicle, which is an average levy per vehicle):

- that the 130 levy risk classification groups are retained for the employer and self-employed levies and the 41 levy risk groups are retained for the residual levy.
- that a small number of levy classifications be moved or their description amended to better reflect recent claims experience and appropriate classification of employers.
- that the petrol levy remains unchanged at 5.08 cents per litre.

- that the composite average motor vehicle levy collected from **petrol powered** vehicles through the annual vehicle licence fee decreases from \$141.18 to \$126.24 per petrol powered vehicle.
- that the levy for non-petrol powered goods vans/truck/utility vehicles increases in its relativity to standard non-petrol powered vehicles, from 116% to 121%.

Revocation of Notice to Pharmacists in the Southern Region given by the Southern Division of the Transitional Health Authority on 1 December 1997 (a notice originally given under section 51 of the Health and Disability Services Act 1993, which set out the terms and conditions upon which the Transitional Health Authority would make payment to pharmacists in that region), continued by section 112 (3) of the New Zealand Public Health and Disability Act 2000 as a notice issued under section 88 of that Act.

Notice

1. Background—From 1 October 1998, the former Health Funding Authority made payments to pharmacists in the Northern, Midland and Central Regions pursuant to a notice issued under section 51 of the Health and Disability Services Act 1993. From 1 December 1997, the former Transitional Health Authority made payments to pharmacists in the Southern Region pursuant to a notice issued under section 51 of the Health and Disability Services Act 1993 (hereafter referred to as “the principal notices”).

The principal notices set out the terms and conditions on which the Health Funding Authority and/or the Transitional Health Authority would make payment to pharmacists in the relevant region for their services.

When the Health and Disability Services Act 1993 was repealed, the principal notices were continued as section 88 notices under section 112 (3) of the New Zealand Public Health and Disability Act 2000.

The Ministry of Health’s obligations were transferred under the principal notice to District Health Boards by means of the Health Sector Transfers (Provider Arrangements) Order 2001 (S.R. 2001/135).

No claims for payment for services are currently made by pharmacists in the regions under the principal notices. In order to implement a new section 88 notice for community pharmacy services, the principal notices need to be revoked.

The Director-General of Health, acting as agent of the District Health Boards, with the written approval of the Minister of Health, issues this revocation to the principal notices.

2. Commencement—This notice comes into force on 31 December 2003.

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on a deposit (other than an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposit.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on an investment deposit repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate term and dollar range.
