The geographical co-ordinates named are in terms of the WGS84 datum.

- **3. Nomination of Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki**—Ngā Hapū o Waimarama and Ngāti Hawea have nominated Hori Bartlett, Karanema Bartlett, Walter Broadman, Lance Makowharemahihi, Tom Mulligan, Gordon Paku and Ngahiwi Tomoana as Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki.

Employment Relations Act 2000

Amended Code of Good Faith

The Good Faith Code Committee ("the committee") appointed under section 36 of the Employment Relations Act 2000 ("the Act") has recently recommended to me that the Code of Good Faith for Bargaining for Collective Agreement ("the code") be revoked and replaced with a new amended code. The current code came into force on 2 October 2000*.

The committee considered changes that might be required to the code, in light of practices, developments and experiences in applying the duty of good faith and taking into account the amendments in the Employment Relations Amendment Act (No. 2) 2004.

In developing the new code, the committee consulted with individuals, companies, trade unions, representatives from government departments and employer groups.

The committee recommended that I revoke the existing code, under section 38 of the Act, and approve the new code under section 35 (1) of the Act.

I have accepted the committee's recommendations, with the effect that as of 11 August 2005:

- the existing Code of Good Faith for Bargaining for Collective Agreement is revoked under section 38 of the Act; and
- the new Code of Good Faith in Collective Bargaining is approved under section 35 (1) of the Act.

Overseas Investment Act 2005

Publication of Ministerial Directive Letter Under Section 35 of the Overseas Investment Act 2005

1 August 2005 Mr Brendan Boyle Chief Executive Land Information New Zealand Private Box 5501 Wellington Dear Mr Boyle

Ministerial Directive Letter

1. This Ministerial Directive letter is made pursuant to section 34 of the Overseas Investment Act 2005 and directs the regulator about the Government's general policy approach to overseas investment in sensitive New Zealand assets, the asset types and thresholds, and monitoring conditions of consent.

General Policy Approach

- 2. Section 34 (1) of the Act requires the regulator to comply with a Ministerial Directive letter. We wish to convey the following general policy of the Government in relation to the exercise of the regulator's functions, powers and duties.
 - (a) The public policy objectives of the Act are:
 - (i) to encourage foreign investment into New Zealand through reducing compliance costs on businesses and recognising the growth benefits that foreign investment brings;
 - (ii) to provide rules that recognise the importance of attracting foreign direct investment;
 - (iii) to recognise the benefits foreign investors bring in terms of access to markets and technology and ideas;
 - (iv) to assess the benefits received from overseas investment applications on the basis of benefit to the whole of New Zealand;
 - (v) to ensure the value of sensitive New Zealand assets is recognised and enhanced by an overseas owner and that overseas owners are subjected to a screening and monitoring process; and
 - (vi) to ensure appropriate governance arrangements around the overseas investment regime.
 - (b) Operating procedures should be consistent with the Government's intention to facilitate positive investment. Accordingly, the regulator (and as applicable, the regulating department) should:
 - (i) perform its functions and administer the legislation it has responsibility for in a timely, consistent and efficient manner;
 - (ii) seek sufficient information from applicants for it to be assured of the accuracy of the information supplied;
 - (iii) seek sufficient evidence from applicants for it to be able to judge whether the criteria and factors that apply to the relevant category of overseas investment are likely to eventuate (or any other matter the regulator considers relevant);
 - (iv) when it considers it necessary to verify that information or that evidence, seek input from government agencies or others it considers have particular competence in relation to that application;

- (v) seek to recover its operating costs, through fees that must be approved by Cabinet, from persons who use its services;
- (vi) advise Ministers on proposals with the presumption that the investment will be compatible with the foreign direct investment policy of the Government; and
- (vii) monitor compliance with any conditions of approval, consent, permission or exemption granted under the legislation with an approach that seeks a balance between the objectives of ensuring compliance with any conditions and providing the regulator (and the public) with more accurate statistics on investment, and the desire to maintain a welcoming approach to investment.
- 3. The regulator's functions are to compile and keep records relating to applications, compile and make available statistics relating to applications, and provide general information for the benefit of applicants about New Zealand's overseas investment rules. To the extent that existing resources permit, the regulator (and, as applicable, the regulating department), in conjunction with other relevant agencies, should:
 - (a) disseminate information on investment in New Zealand;
 - (b) publicise and explain the nature of our regulatory regime to potential overseas investors and domestically; and
 - (c) compile and make available statistics about overseas investment applications.

Asset Types and Thresholds

- 4. The Act requires an overseas person to seek consent for the following categories of investment:
 - (a) Sensitive land;
 - (b) significant business assets; and
 - (c) fishing quota (refer to the Fisheries Act 1996).
- 5. Sensitive land (and its thresholds) fall into the categories outlined in Schedule 1 of the Act.
- 6. Significant business assets are investments that:
 - (a) acquire securities resulting in a 25% or more ownership (or control interest) or an increase in 25% or more ownership;
 - (b) establish a business in New Zealand; and
 - (c) acquire business assets.
 - The threshold value for significance is NZ\$100 million.
- 7. Fishing quota is an investment that is an interest in fishing quota or involves rights or interests in securities of a person who owns (or controls) an interest in fishing quota.

Criteria for Consent Under the Overseas Investment Act

8. The regulator, in considering any applications under the Overseas Investment Act 2005 pursuant to delegated authority, must take into account the matters provided for under section 17 (2) (g) (other relevant factors set out in the Regulations). The relative balance between the criteria will depend upon the nature of each property.

Criteria for List of Parks, Reserves and Other Sensitive Land Under Section 37 of the Act

9. The criteria required for the list of parks, reserves and other sensitive land under section 37 of the Act is any land in an operative regional plan, a district or proposed district plan that is to be used as a reserve, a public park or for recreation purposes, or as open space for the purposes of:



- (a) protecting natural and physical resources or historic heritage; and
- (b) providing public access to natural and physical resources or historic heritage.
- 10. Any reserve designated under the Resource Management Act for purposes other than those noted above (e.g. a drainage reserve) will be excluded from the list.

Monitoring Conditions of Consent

11. Overseas people wanting to buy sensitive New Zealand assets will all be subject to the screening regime. Monitoring powers under the Act give the regulator the ability to require a person to provide a statutory declaration verifying compliance with conditions of consent (and if the consent holder is in breach of a condition or conditions, a statutory declaration verifying the reason for the breach and the steps to be undertaken to remedy any breach of consent). It is estimated that the regulator will spend up to half a day per consent every year for the first five years after the consent has been granted. It is likely that monitoring will continue until the conditions are met. This may be earlier than five years. The key point is that the level of monitoring is designed to ensure compliance with the conditions of the consent in as effective and efficient way as possible.

Date Letter Takes Effect

This Ministerial Directive letter shall come into effect on and from 25 August 2005.

Notice of Exemptions From Farm Land Offer Criteria Pursuant to Section 20 of the Overseas Investment Act 2005

- 1. Take notice that we, The Honourable Dr Michael Cullen, Minister of Finance, and The Honourable Pete Hodgson, Minister for Land Information, pursuant to section 20 of the Overseas Investment Act 2005 ("the Act"), hereby exempt every person from section 16 (1) (f) of the Act for a transaction to the extent that giving effect to the transaction has any of the following effects:
 - (a) The acquisition by an overseas person of farm land securities that are quoted on a market operated by New Zealand Exchange Limited;
 - (b) the acquisition by an overseas person of farm land securities as a result of subscribing for securities if:
 - (i) the offer of those securities is an offer to the public for which an investment statement or registered prospectus is required under the Securities Act 1978; and
 - (ii) the offer is made in, or accompanied by, an investment statement or registered prospectus;
 - (c) the acquisition by an overseas person of farm land securities if:
 - (i) the takeovers code in force under the Takeovers Act 1993 applies to the acquisition; and
 - (ii) the acquisition is under an offer made to all holders of those securities other than the offeror (whether the offer is for all or some of the farm land securities);
 - (d) the acquisition by an overseas person of farm land securities if the farm land to which the farm land securities relate has, in accordance with a procedure prescribed by regulations made under the Act, been offered for sale or acquisition on the open market to persons who are not overseas persons;

- (e) the acquisition by an overseas person of farm land securities from a person if the overseas person and the other person, immediately before the transfer, do not together have (directly or indirectly):
 - a beneficial entitlement to, or beneficial interest in, 50% or more of the farm land securities of the company or body corporate that owns or controls the farm land; or
 - (ii) the right to exercise or control the exercise of 50% or more of the voting power at a meeting of the company or body corporate that owns or controls the farm land; or
 - (iii) the right to appoint or control the appointment of 50% or more of the board of directors (or other persons or body exercising powers of management, however described) of the company or body corporate that owns or controls the farm land;
- (f) the acquisition of farm land or farm land securities by an overseas person from a family member (whether or not the family member is an overseas person);
- (g) the acquisition of farm land or farm land securities by an overseas person if:
 - (i) the acquisition is from another member of the same group or another partner in the same partnership or another member of the same joint venture as part of a reconstruction or reorganisation of that group, partnership, or joint venture; and
 - (ii) the group is an overseas group or the partnership or joint venture is an overseas person;
- (h) the acquisition of farm land or farm land securities by an overseas person from another overseas person as part of a wider acquisition or merger if:
 - (i) the wider acquisition or merger is being undertaken by other members (relevant persons) of the same overseas groups as those overseas persons; and
 - (ii) the wider acquisition or merger involves the acquisition of the whole or a substantial part of the specified securities in, or the business of, one or more relevant persons in one or more overseas jurisdiction; and
 - (iii) each relevant person is incorporated outside New Zealand; or
- (i) the acquisition of farm land or farm land securities by an overseas person that has applied to be a permanent resident of New Zealand if that application is approved and that person becomes a permanent resident in New Zealand within 12 months after the application is approved.
- 2. In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (a) **family member**, in relation to any person means:
 - (i) a person who is related to that person by blood within the fourth degree of relationship; or
 - (ii) the person's spouse, civil union partner or de facto partner; or
 - (iii) a person who is the spouse, civil union partner or de facto partner of a third party to whom the person is related by blood within the fourth degree of relationship; or
 - (iv) the adopted child of the person; or
 - (v) the adopted child of a third party who is within the third degree of relationship to the person; and

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Amendment of Quota Allocation Mechanisms Following Review—European Union (EU) Sheepmeat and Goatmeat Tariff Rate Quota, EU High Quality Beef Tariff Rate Quota and United States (US) Beef and Veal Tariff Rate Quota

The New Zealand Meat Board has reviewed its existing quota allocation mechanisms under the Meat Board Act 2004, being mechanisms for the EU Sheepmeat and Goatmeat Tariff Rate Quota (TRQ), US Beef and Veal TRQ (both dated 15 September 2004) and EU High Quality Beef TRQ (dated September 2002).

The Board has agreed that various amendments will be made to the existing allocation systems pursuant to section 27 of the Act, including:

- a new definition of "new entrant";
- a restriction on new entrants transferring production history arising during the new entrant period;
- a reduction of the amount of quota set aside as reserve quota allowance to "up to 2% of the TQR"; and
- a requirement that companies transferring quota remain responsible for penalties if that quota remains unused and the transferre is a company against whom penalties cannot be enforced.

The amended mechanisms will come into effect in relation to the Quota Year commencing **1 January 2006** for EU Sheepmeat and Goatmeat TRQ and US Beef and Veal TRQ, and **1 July 2006** for EU High Quality Beef TRQ. Applications in relation to those years are therefore subject to the amended mechanisms.

Applications by New Entrants for Reserved Quota Allowance Allocations are due by 1 September 2005.

The EU Sheepmeat and Goatmeat TRQ applies to 226,700 tonnes carcass weight equivalent and the tariff rate for "in quota" imports is zero.

The EU High Quality Beef TRQ applies to 300 tonnes product weight and the tariff rate for "in quota" imports is 20% ad valorem duty.

The US Beef and Veal TRQ applies to 213,402 tonnes product weight and the tariff rate for "in quota" imports is \$US0.044 per kilogram on most beef products.

Nurses Act 1977

Order of the Nursing Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of Shirley Marilyn Sizemore, **Enrolled Nurse**

Pursuant to sections 42 (1) (a), 42 (2) (a), 42 (3) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("the council"), in a decision dated 26 April 2005, ordered that the name of **Shirley Marilyn Sizemore**, enrolled nurse, be removed from the Register and declined to set a time when she might apply for reinstatement.

The council also ordered that Shirley Marilyn Sizemore pay \$800.00 (being 50%) of the actual costs and expenses of and incidental to the inquiry by the council and that a notice stating the effect of the orders be published in the New Zealand Gazette, Kai Tiaki: Nursing New Zealand, New Zealand Nursing Review and the council's newsletter, and released to accredited members of the media on request.

The council considered that the orders in respect of **Shirley** Marilyn Sizemore should be published in the interests of public safety to provide reassurance that accepted standards of professional practice will be upheld.

Order of the Nursing Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of Rosemary Anne Kennedy, **Registered Nurse**

The council also ordered that Rosemary Anne Kennedy pay \$820.00 (being 50%) of the actual costs and expenses of and incidental to the inquiry by the council, and that a notice stating the effect of the orders be published in the New Zealand Gazette, Kai Tiaki: Nursing New Zealand, Nursing Review and the council's newsletter, and released to accredited members of the media on request.

The council considered that the orders in respect of Rosemary Anne Kennedy should be published in the interests of public safety to provide reassurance that accepted standards of professional practice will be upheld. MARION CLARK, Registrar.

Order of the Nursing Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of a Registered Nurse

Pursuant to sections 42 (2) (ba), 42 (3) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("the council"), in a decision dated 20 June 2005, ordered that a registered nurse must practise subject to conditions.

The council also ordered that the same registered nurse pay \$10,320.00 (being 35%) of the actual costs and expenses of and incidental to the inquiry by the council, and that a notice stating the effect of the orders be published in the New Zealand Gazette, Kai Tiaki: Nursing New Zealand and the council's newsletter, and released to accredited members of the media on request.

The council determined that neither the name of the registered nurse nor any identifying details of this case should be published as this would be an added penalty which would outweigh the degree of seriousness of the conduct and the risk to the public.
