#### An overview of reviewing the levies

Each year, ACC reviews the levies it charges.

From October – early November	The ACC Board invites the public to make submissions on levy rate proposals and options.
	The ACC Board considers the submissions.
November-December	The ACC Board makes recommendations to Government, via the Minister for ACC, about any changes to the levy rates for the following levy year.
1 April	The regulations and new levy rates come into effect (except the motor vehicle levy).
1 July	The regulations and new motor vehicle levy rate come into effect.

#### Why do levies change?

ACC meets the ongoing cost of claims from the levies it collects each year and the interest it earns by investing any unspent levies or reserves.

There are a number of factors that affect levy rates. These include the forecast trends in injury and death rates, the duration and cost of claimants' rehabilitation or compensation, and economic factors such as inflation and interest rates. Rising interest rates increase the future earnings expected from ACC's investments and decrease ACC's liability for past injuries and, as a result, reduce the levy rates. The opposite is true when interest rates reduce.

#### Proposals for each group of levy payers

#### **Employers**

Employer levies are based on their employee payroll. Employers pay:

- a levy for cover on work-related injuries to their employees in 2006/2007, and
- a levy to pay for injury claims prior to 1999.

#### ACC proposes:

- maintaining the combined levy rate for employers at an average of \$1.21 per \$100.00 of payroll by:
  - $\circ~$  decreasing the levy rate on cover for 2006/2007 work claims from \$0.88 to \$0.86
  - o increasing the levy rate for injury claims prior to 1999 from \$0.33 to \$0.35

- moving five individual classifications to different risk groups (or pricing pools)
- reducing the number of risk groups for cover on 2006/2007 work injuries to 127, and maintaining the existing 41 risk groups for claims prior to 1999
- introducing a levy discount scheme for small employers in five industry sectors with the highest number of work injuries.

#### Self-employed

Self-employed levies are based on their earnings.

Self-employed pay:

- a levy for cover on their work-related injuries in 2006/2007, and
- a levy to pay injury claims prior to 1999
- a levy on their cover for non-work injuries in 2006/2007.

#### ACC proposes:

- increasing the combined levy rate for self-employed to an average of \$3.57 per \$100.00 of earnings by:
  - o increasing the levy rate on cover for 2006/2007 work claims from \$1.82 to \$2.06
  - o increasing the levy rate for injury claims prior to 1999 from \$0.33 to \$0.35
  - increasing the levy rate on cover for 2006/2007 non-work claims from \$1.07 to \$1.16
- moving five individual classifications to different risk groups (or pricing pools)
- reducing the number of risk groups for cover on 2006/2007 work injuries to 127, and maintaining the existing 41 risk groups for claims prior to 1999
- introducing a levy discount scheme for self-employed in five industry sectors with the highest number of work injuries.

#### **Earners**

Earner levies are based on the earnings of employees and self-employed people, and pay for cover on their non-work injuries. ACC proposes:

• increasing the levy rate on cover for 2006/2007 non-work claims from \$1.07 to \$1.16 per \$100.00 of earnings.

#### **Motorists**

Motorists pay for all injuries involving motor vehicles on public roads, through a combination of:

- a levy paid by motor vehicle owners through their annual vehicle licensing fee (the levy is based on the type of vehicle)
- a levy on petrol sales paid by drivers.

#### ACC proposes:

- reducing the levy paid by motor vehicle owners to an average of \$190.00 per vehicle
- maintaining the petrol levy at the current rate of 5.78 cents per litre

- (a) racecourse, racing rules, racing code and racing betting each has the same meaning ascribed to it in section 5 of the Racing Act 2003;
- (b) **bookmaker** has the same meaning ascribed to it in section 4 of the Gambling Act 2003;
- (c) **Exemptions Committee** means a committee comprising of the chief executive or general manager of each racing code and a chairman appointed by the racing codes;
- (d) references to any Act include references to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of it.
- **2. Prohibited persons**—For the purpose of maintaining public confidence in the conduct of racing and the integrity of racing betting:
- (a) persons (other than eligible individuals under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004 and those persons to which 2 (b) applies) of the classes described in Category 1 are excluded absolutely from entering any racecourse to which section 34 of the Racing Act 2003 applies;
- (b) persons (other than eligible individuals under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004) of the classes described in Category 2 are excluded for a period of 2 years from the date of conviction from entering any racecourse to which section 34 of the Racing Act 2003 applies.

#### 3. Exemptions—

- (a) Any person excluded under rule 2 hereof from entering a racecourse may apply in writing to the Exemptions Committee to be exempted wholly or in part from that prohibition.
- (b) The Exemptions Committee may grant an exemption in whole or in part if it is satisfied that, having regard to the exceptional circumstances of the particular individual, doing so will not compromise the maintenance of public confidence in the conduct of racing and the integrity of racing betting.

#### Category 1

Classes of person excluded absolutely from entering any racecourse under rule 2(a) Lexis Nexis

#### Racing Disqualifications

- (a) Disqualified persons under the racing rules made by racing codes;
- (b) Persons who are disqualified or prohibited by racing authorities in any country outside New Zealand having reciprocal agreements with one or more of the racing codes;

#### Bookmaking, Betting and Racing

- (c) Bookmakers and persons acting as bookmakers agents but not persons lawfully acting as bookmakers or bookmakers agents in any country outside New Zealand;
- (d) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) of any offence or infringement offence under the Gambling Act 2003, the Gaming Act 1908 or under Part II of the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1977;
- (e) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) of any offence under the Racing Act 2003 or the Racing Act 1971;

#### Offences

- (f) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) of the following offences:
  - (i) endangering safety under section 12 or 13 of the Summary Offences Act 1981;
  - (ii) possession of weapons, firearms or imitation firearms in a public place; or
  - (iii) any offence under the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1977 (other than Part II which relates to Bookmakers and Betting);

#### Crimes

- (g) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) of any of the following crimes or offences, or of being a party to any such crime or offence, or of conspiring or attempting to commit any such crime or offence:
  - (i) crimes or offences involving dishonesty, fraud, forgery, bribery, corruption or deceit;
  - (ii) violent crimes or offences, sexual crimes or offences; indecent acts or arson;
  - (iii) crimes involving importing, manufacturing, cultivation or dealing in a controlled drug (as defined in the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975);
  - (iv) burglary, receiving, robbery or conversion; or
  - (v) participation in an organised criminal group under section 98A of the Crimes Act 1961;

#### Overseas Convictions

(h) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) in countries outside New Zealand of offences or crimes corresponding to those mentioned in paragraphs (d), (e), (f) and (g) of these rules.

#### Category 2

Classes of person excluded from entering any racecourse for the period referred to in Rule 2(b):

(a) Persons convicted (whether before or after the commencement of these rules) of assault except those persons whose sentence or cumulative sentence (in the case of multiple convictions) in any such case is a fine

of less than \$1,000 or community work of less than 100 hours and those persons on whom no sentence was imposed.

- (b) Persons belonging to any one or more of the classes referred to in paragraphs (f) and (g) of Category 1 on whom no sentence was imposed or whose sentence:
  - (i) did not include a custodial sentence (as defined in section 4 of the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004); and
  - (ii) did not include a fine of \$1,000 or more or a term of community work of 100 hours or more or supervision."
